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## The Solari Report Learning to Walkabout with Harry Blazer

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**C. Austin Fitts:** Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to The Solari Report. Today is October 7<sup>th</sup>. I'm sitting here in Hickory Valley, Tennessee with my long-time co-conspirator and ally, Harry Blazer. Harry, welcome to The Solari Report.

**Harry Blazer:** Thank you so much, Miss Tennessee.

**Fitts:** For many months I've wanted to have a conversation with Harry, and for many months we have evolved the conversation that we wanted to have. We both have a serious belief that we are coming into a time of great change, and we need to talk about what that change is and what it means to each of us and how we adapt and rock-n-roll in that change.

It's interesting, Harry, because this conversation has evolved over many months. Something new happens, and then we morph it, so it has taken us a while to get together.

I sat down this morning and I said, "What have we covered on The Solari Report that relates to this conversation?"



If you go back to the archives, we've done a tremendous amount on shadow work, we've done a tremendous amount on Control 101, on targeting, on spiritual warfare, on AI, and big data. You did a great interview with Hugo de Garis.

I finally realized that there is so much that I'll just put the links up for this interview, and we won't go through it.

It's not like we haven't been having this conversation all along, but the speed is as though we are coming into an s-curve and we are going up the s-curve. If you haven't grocked this already and you haven't made that adjustment, I think that we feel an urgency that you can't afford not to get this now. Does that make sense?

**Blazer:** Not only that, but you've got a bunch of s-curves working at the same time which I feel are very, very critical.

**Fitts:** I just finished recording the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Wrap Up: News, Trends & Stories Part II. One of the things that we were talking about was the fact that we have not seen this kind of change for 500 years since the Reformation. But even if you go back then, given what the technology is now, this is something that the human race has never gone through. This is unprecedented.

So let's talk about what is new and what is different. First, we know that whatever is going on, the political winds have changed, and there are many indications after both this election and the Presidential election – depending on what happens in the election – that we are in for a significant turnover in leadership. Some people are calling it 'the purge'.



**Blazer:** It's not so much that the President is going to be different, but it's going to be that the people who make government work are going to be different.

**Fitts:** Right. So we have a couple of things happening at once. We have turnover in Federal leadership, we have turnover in business leadership, media leadership, state and local leadership, and we know across the country that there is an unprecedented number of indictments under seal. We know that we have an executive order for military tribunals. And we've seen a whole lot of people retiring. You have a feeling that they are going with the indictment, saying, "Mr. Smith, you can be indicted, or you can resign. Which would you prefer?"

**Blazer:** Or you can rat.

**Fitts:** It does look like some people are ratting. Of course, the more they rat, the more interesting the purge gets.

Here is the question that we don't know the answer to: Is this a purge of the swamp? Is one faction purging another? Or are we just clearing out the people who engineered the financial coup and globalization who we don't need anymore? Do we need to bring in a new team for a fresh face?

**Blazer:** I would say that they are getting rid of the liabilities.

**Fitts:** So anybody who has a memory of what went on during the financial coup and those who are the money, we just get rid of them.

**Blazer:** Right. You need to wipe the slate clean for a whole new episode of criminality.



**Fitts:** I, for one, don't think that the swamp will be drained. I just think that the swamp is ready to call the herd and move on to the next phase, but I don't know. I'm open. I'm willing for this to work out well, although there are certainly a lot of people with criminal liability.

I don't think that we know. All that we know is that we are in for significant turnover, and when you get that kind of significant turnover, you get into a very wild kind of environment. Everybody listening to this, we have all lived someplace. How that purge is going to come down is going to affect everybody differently but it is going to impact our lives.

**Blazer:** If I'm silent, that means that I am agreeing, or I'm just in awe – one of the two.

**Fitts:** Something else that is new is that we have seen building for many years, but it's coming to a whole fruition of the ability of the leadership to mind-control – not just to attack the population – but mind-control the population and literally turn the general population into a weapon.

**Blazer:** At a minimal level, it's kind of a stimulus response approach, but we think that it is even deeper than that.

**Fitts:** We just saw in the Kavanaugh hearings an embracing by a significant number of people in the population to throw out due process and agree to treat somebody based on the fact that they are a metaphor and not an individual. So it's no longer Brett Kavanaugh; it's a metaphor for this thing, whatever this 'thing' is. It could be privileged people, privileged men, and on and on. But he is a metaphor, and you've got to treat the metaphor. Whatever happens to Brett is determined by how you feel about the metaphor as opposed to the facts that relate to him and his individual case in history.



**Blazer:** “I’m prepared to throw out the Constitution as long as I’m treated decently. And this guy doesn’t treat people decently. Therefore, we should get rid of due process and innocent before proven guilty,” and on and on.

**Fitts:** One of the things that scared me about the Q-Anon phenomena is that I see a whole world of people who are frustrated and angry about the corruption being prepared to attack whoever Q says is a bad guy. That population can be used to attack innocent people.

You know I got into a squabble with one group of people who said that the deep state is the SES system, which is a joke. But that population is being prepared to attack the SES system not to drain the swamp, but to make sure that the oligarchs can privatize everything that they want because the SES are standing in the way of that.

**Blazer:** The bureaucracy is not the deep state. There may be members of the bureaucracy that facilitate the deep state, but bureaucracy itself is not deep state. That is not what we talk about.

**Fitts:** We’ve been living in a world for a long time now where the general population is dealing with regular assaults that impact our health or our coherence. The most important one, I think, is the deterioration of the food supply. Of course, that is why I asked you to do the Food Series, and that is why I so appreciate it. You understand the extent to which you can destroy a human being by feeding them rotten food, and you see it all over the country.

There are GMOs, there are vaccines, there is fluoride, and there is media. So the environmental warfare weakens us, but the media and these other things cause us to go into a state of incoherence.



**Blazer:** Junk food for the mind.

**Fitts:** Right. One of the things that we know is: Whatever is happening, it is so important to remain coherent. You have to be coherent.

I don't know if you ever read the review that we did on pornography. You and I were talking about pornography yesterday and the extent to which that is used to manipulate people. We also talked about 5G, which is going to accelerate the mind control and the EMF radiation.

So everyone who is living in the developed world is now in a position of managing these multiple assaults, and they are going to keep coming. (You can't hear him say 'yes', but Harry is nodding his head.)

**Blazer:** I told you that when I'm not talking, I am either agreeing or I'm in awe.

**Fitts:** One of the things that I am particularly worried about is the healthcare system. I think that navigating the healthcare system calls for a lot of awareness and risk management because I think that it can literally be dangerous to your health.

So what is new? These assaults have been going on, and they are going to continue. But let's talk about what is new. We are facing multiple tsunamis of change that are coming all at the same time. It's not like mom and dad are planning for things to go right.



One is the rise of Asia. We just did the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Wrap Up on The Rise of Asia. The second is the reshoring of capital to the United States and a shift to a multipolar world. We talk a lot about that on The Solari Report. Another, I believe, is you are seeing a real move in the United States to privatize. There are a tremendous amount of government operations. All the corporations that helped create the negative return on investment are going to double down on the negative return on investment.

The biggest tsunami is the one that you have done the most work on on The Solari Report, and that is AI. Deep learning AI is rolling out at high speed in multiple systems across the society, and I don't think that anybody is ready for it; I know I'm not ready for it. I'm just trying to understand it.

You and I called it the 'AI Invasion', and I think that every aspect of our life is going to be invaded by AI. We can't fathom what this change is going to be like.

**Blazer:** The other thing is that of all of the things that are on the s-curve, which is the curve that is an upward trajectory, and it's not linear but exponential, AI is the thing that can move the fastest.

**Fitts:** Right. With space, you have to build rockets. The rise of Asia, people take time, so that is ten to twenty years out. AI can go at lightning speed.



**Blazer:** Right. It's a product of processing power, the amount of data that you can collect, and then the clever algorithms and methods that you come up with for discovering those patterns, and also the whole point of deep learning is that the machine teaches itself, increasingly better all the time by comparing results to goals. Then, of course, there is a whole other form of AI which is general intelligence, and some people are seriously pursuing this as the ultimate goal. That is basically where the intelligence is indistinguishable from human intelligence, but with a computation speed that is astonishingly better than ours.

**Fitts:** I just reviewed Kai-Fu Lee's book, *AI Superpowers*, on the website. We talked a little bit about it in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Wrap Up. One of the things that Kai-Fu Lee's book helps you to understand is this insatiable hunger for data.

**Blazer:** It's a prerequisite.

**Fitts:** Right. The more data you have, the smarter your AI is.

**Blazer:** And the faster it can get smarter.

**Fitts:** It's interesting. He thinks that makes China the winner because he is looking at the overt economy and saying, "China has more people, so we have more data."

**Blazer:** And they have more people supposedly working on this stuff.

**Fitts:** He's not looking at the ionization of the sky.



**Blazer:** He also is not looking at the ability to get other people's data, at which we are probably be the best. Although the Chinese recently tried to put that little chip on the board (to spy on users). They're learning from us.

**Fitts:** Right, and the Midianite thing is rising.

There is this incredible hunger for data, and if you are an individual walking around in the developed world, you literally feel like prey because everybody is trying to get your data.

I walked into the Apple store to deal with a repair, and this guy was trying to talk me out of what I wanted and trying to talk me into the Apple cloud. I explained to him that I wasn't doing that, and before you know it, we are back around and he is trying to sell me on the cloud again. It took three cycles before I could convince him that the answer was no.

**Blazer:** Not only that, but the applications that have been around a long time, like design applications and so on, any new version that you get is on the cloud; there is no opportunity to just run it on your own computer anymore. So it's turning into a leasing model, which is what we believe a lot of the world is going to – a 'service for fee' model – where you end up owning relatively little, and the assets are concentrated in the hands of very few, and you get to use their stuff. Not only that, but because it is so potent and so many people are using it, you end up at a disadvantage if you don't use it.

**Fitts:** And yet it is your data that is making them wealthy.



**Blazer:** Right, and you don't have a choice about giving into it because everything that you do is basically recorded. That is the other reason why when you go online now, you have Windows pop up and say, "We have this suggested content for you," or you go onto Amazon and they say, "These are the books that we think you might also be interested in."

Well, that is AI at work, and everybody is trying to do it. The goal right now is to increase sales. But what if there are other goals that are potentially not as innocuous?

**Fitts:** If you look at deep learning rolling out in all these different parts of the world, and I want to run through the different parts with you, you are going to be the target of AI that has been designed to do what is good for that organization, not you. It's not coming from a framework of making your life wonderful; it's coming from a framework of making this business money or that intelligence agency smart or whatever.

**Blazer:** But they are going to convince you that it's for your own good.

**Fitts:** Right, but you are going to be subject to 20,000 different AIs coming at you, all of which are trying to harvest you.

**Blazer:** By the same token, we talked about a natural monopolistic trend because the AI that is the best – the AI that computes the fastest – ends up being superior AI that basically ends up gobbling up all of the other ones, which is also what this gentleman talked about in his book (Kai-Fu Lee's book, *AI Superpowers*).



It actually ends up reducing options, reducing competitiveness, and concentrating wealth and power at unheard of rates. I mean, we have the first trillion-dollar company. The question is: When is the first trillion-dollar person?

There are probably trillion-dollar persons who don't make the Forbes list, but when will we see the first trillion-dollar person to make the Forbes list?

**Fitts:** One of the phenomena I've struggled with, which is very important to me, is to find a way to help subscribers emotionally integrate. It could literally be the difference between succeeding in this environment and really getting drowned by the tsunami. I'll pick on Franklin Sanders because he and I would always struggle with this.

He would say, "Look, even with all of their money and power, they can only track and do surveillance on maybe 25,000 people."

I said, "Franklin, with relational databases and software and AI, they can track and manage individually 325 million people. Are you crazy?"

And he couldn't fathom that. It was like he couldn't fathom that the CIA could have an AI program operating for every American and basically track and manage and manipulate everyone very efficiently.

**Blazer:** But they are admitting that they collect all of the data that there is to collect 'for future use'.

**Fitts:** How do we help somebody understand the extent to which it's like you have an intelligent AI bodyguard tracking them, following them around, and manipulating them?



**Blazer:** When you are online and a banner comes up with suggestions of content for you, that is proof. What else do you want to know?

**Fitts:** When I was going through with my assistant the audit from the Tennessee Finance Division, I was reading through the section on cybersecurity software. I had forgotten to ask my assistant to leave her phone in the car, so she had her phone with her. Within 30 minutes, I had three proposals from software firms in the Silicon Valley. There you go.

**Blazer:** That is just a coincidence, my dear!

**Fitts:** I can say on the phone that I have a headache, and within 30 minutes, I am continually getting headache remedies. I never really get headaches, but it's quite remarkable what they can do.

I want to talk about some of the different ways that this AI invasion is going to come in. I think that one of the most important things to me is there is an old saying in America, "A man's home is his castle."

There are all sorts of precedents in law that somebody should have privacy and sovereignty within their home with the fundamental power of property rights. What we are watching through utility access to the home is a complete destruction of individual sovereignty, property rights, and access.

Through the smart meters and the electricity and through the internet access and the phone access, I've probably talked too much on The Solari Report about how I get tortured by AT&T and phone stuff, but it is extraordinary the games that they play.



It's almost like we have a society through the utilities where if you play ball, you can go really fast in your phones and your internet, and your computer and your electricity all work. I'll never forget I recorded Jon Rappoport. I was in a hotel room. I had three different sources of phones and electricity, and every one of them went out. Luckily they didn't all go out at the same time, so I just kept having to move it while he was talking, and he never noticed. It was great, and I was so proud.

**Blazer:** The whole idea of what a legal search is now is being questioned because New York is putting in technology that allows them to look at somebody - basically using AI - and they are able to determine if the person is carrying a concealed weapon.

There are technologies where you can be on the outside, and you can scan the electronics that are in the inside of a building to find out if there might be stolen property. You can use technology to look inside of a building that doesn't have windows, but through walls.

**Fitts:** So we are talking about zero privacy. I think that the TVs are two-way.

**Blazer:** We've known that, and Alexa, of course, is there to know everything about you and on and on. So we are letting these things into our home. Then you have all of the 'smart' technologies and so on.



The question that nobody has addressed, not even the Supreme Court, is this: What is a legal search? By the fact that you are allowing these things in your house, if somebody decides to use it, you have a licensing agreement that nobody ever reads with every one of these devices. So do they now have the right search your home in any way that they want to?

**Fitts:** During the litigation they would break into my home constantly. They would break into my home, and I was told that they had video cameras in my home, although I couldn't prove it.

I tried to hire a PI firm. I interviewed three firms, and then each one said, "We've checked you out, and it's too dangerous. We can't have anything to do with you."

The last guy took pity on me. He was the bio-warfare expert. He said, "Watch out for holes." He said, "I have two messages for you: Watch out for holes, and buy birds?"

I said, "Buy birds?"

He said, "If the birds die, get out of the house."

I said, "What about the holes?"

He said, "They are going to drill holes in the wall, and they are going to inject low-grade biological warfare," which is exactly what happened. I was on the treadmill once, working out. I turned and I looked. I had brick walls on the first floor – all brick – and somebody had drilled a hole in the wall. I couldn't believe it.



**Blazer:** Now they have a different approach. It's called 'chemtrails'.

**Fitts:** Right, but here was the thing that was amazing. There was nothing that I could do. They reserved the right to come in and out of my home whenever they wanted, they used the reserve to use electromagnetic weapons whenever they wanted to poison me, to follow me on the street, and they would follow my houseguests and try to scare them off. They could do whatever they wanted, and there was nothing that I could do.

**Blazer:** It was illegal, but you could never pin it on them. But what we are talking about now is a legal foundation for doing this stuff, and it's more pervasive than all of the things that you just talked about.

**Fitts:** Right. One of the scariest moments of the year – and this has happened to me twice – was where a subscriber was talking to me about the Alexa machine and referred to their Alexa as 'she'. I said, "It's not a 'she'; it's an 'it'."

They got upset and said, "No, it's a 'she'."

I said, "No, it's a machine. It is an 'it'."

There was a tense moment, and I realized that whatever 'it' is – and this is where it gets back to entrainment – it creates an affectionate relationship. In other words, people have more affection for their Alexa machine than for some people.

**Blazer:** They have more affection for their Alexa than for someone who is homeless. That is for sure.



**Fitts:** Right, and that is scary. First of all, why would you bring a machine into your home that harms you? Second of all, why would you have affection for it?

**Blazer:** It talks to you, it listens to you, it responds to your requests, and it will play you your music. That is what friends do, isn't it?

So now you're getting an idea of the seduction of the technology. The technology is being introduced into a life with all of these data collection tools, and we are welcoming them into our lives.

**Fitts:** What I love is to be in a state of coherence. When I bring something into my life that doesn't have integrity, it makes me incoherent.

**Blazer:** But for these people, it makes them more coherent. That is what they think. And one of the things that you are trying to do for people over the many sessions that you conduct is to define what coherence looks like.

**Fitts:** Right. And to a certain extent, everybody is different, but you have to understand that with technology right now, the planet is an entire experiment. We are taking digital technology and we are taking biological and material science and saying, "Let's just slap it out there and try it."

**Blazer:** It's a giant biological, chemical, and physical experiment – the three major sciences.



**Fitts:** We are the guinea pigs. And as you know, I believe that the leadership is prototyping, “Here is a human, here is a robot, and here are all of the gradations in the middle. How do we play with these different things – all of these different gradations in the middle – to get the best labor for us?”

**Blazer:** This leads to another issue which we might as well bring up now if it’s okay, which is: One of the major predictions about AI is that it is going to replace a lot of humans in the work force.

**Fitts:** Right, so I keep talking about the venture capitalist at the Aspen Institute – and thank God you were there with me – who looked me dead in the eye and said, “Look, we can replace every employee in America with AI and robotics and software, and that is what we are going to do, and there is nothing that you can do about it.”

**Blazer:** People talk about 10% of the work force is particularly vulnerable and 40-50% is fairly vulnerable, and all of this within a relatively short period of time – ten to fifteen years. If that happens, then what is the plan for the people who are out of work?

A couple of plans come up. One is the guaranteed income. The other is retraining. But you can’t retrain that many people fast enough to go into other jobs that are also diminishing at fairly exponential rates. And how do you afford to pay that many people to sit on the sidelines or work halftime?

**Fitts:** We are now. If you look at the numbers of who is living based on a check from the Federal government, it is extraordinary.



**Blazer:** And our debt is extraordinary. So even the debt doesn't mean what it is supposed to mean. Money's role and the ability for money to function in different ways is changing. Our ability to mine asteroids is on a balance sheet somewhere for the future that is going to give us a return that is not looked at right now. Or there is a plan for depopulation. And maybe all of them are in play.

If you take a look at what I would call the 'middle class' and take a look at their health, I am actually astonished at how poor the medical health and dental health of the middle class is. Some of them, even in their 50's, it's hard for them to even be mobile. They have huge guts, skin color that reflects multiple layers of problems, you have a lot of abuse problems, and you have a lot of addiction problems.

**Fitts:** There is something else. With a significant percentage of the population, they have an inability to learn a new way. In other words, you could show them how to very economically get healthy and stay healthy in a way that would save them a lot of money, and they would be much healthier, but they won't listen.

**Blazer:** So part of it is a paradigm that won't let them listen, and the other is just a learning metabolism that makes it hard to learn. We've been training people not to learn very successfully – whether it's church or state or whether it's school.



I worry that if AI happens the way everybody is talking about it, and our humans just go off and play in the fields and enjoy life, then all the while AI produces all this wealth that is then distributed by very generous oligarchs that have amassed huge amounts of wealth that was unimaginable before - nothing makes sense to me about that. Somebody is going to be left out.

If you take a look at the homeless that are on the street – a lot of veterans and other people who actually contributed at some point – these people have been cast aside. But there are also lots of other people who have been cast aside who live in communities.

**Fitts:** Here is the frightening thing about it: If you track the cash flows the way that I have since the 1990's, what you know is that they haven't been cast aside because they are unproductive; they are cast aside because somebody was better at rigging the government money. They were cast aside because they were honest while people who were criminals were rigging the government money.

**Blazer:** So who is going to be in charge of the AI? That is the question that I asked de Garis. I said, "This isn't just for everyone."

**Fitts:** I have a theory on this. I think that a lot of companies are going to use deep learning to just get better at food delivery, and they are just going to be sincerely just trying to do a better job of food delivery. But I think that the AI is air cover for the oligarchs. I think that the oligarchs are going to want to go in a certain direction, and they can say, "It wasn't us; it was the AI."

In other words, you can blame it on the machine.



**Blazer:** The biggest danger that everybody talks about, which is the other thing that I wanted to bring up, so thank you for reminding me, is that ultimately AI will optimize for itself. General intelligence and sophisticated AI will optimize for itself.

**Fitts:** Right. So you are either dealing with AI that will optimize with a limited agenda, or – what I think is really important – you are one human being, you are dealing with 50 different systems like utilities, phones, and all of these different systems, and all of them have AI that is optimizing for its limited thing that has nothing to do with the whole thing making sense. It has the potential to basically drive you insane because it's so incoherent.

**Blazer:** But there will be coherence because, as some point, that data will be collected more centrally – whether it's for a fusion center, whether it's for Amazon or Google who end up with it.

**Fitts:** Right, but it is going to optimize for whatever its organization is, or for itself.

**Blazer:** It will eventually be concentrated within the hands of a few.

**Fitts:** But it's not going to try to optimize your situation. It's a little bit like lying in a hospital and 20 different groups come to see you. The anesthesiologists come, the kidney guy, the heart guy, but nobody is in charge of making sure that you are okay. Nobody is integrating any of it. That is what this is going to be like.

You are going to be facing 20, 30, 40, 50, or thousands of AI agendas, none of which are trying to optimize your situation.



**Blazer:** I think that is a phase, and then there will be a level of integration. That is when the really scary shit happens.

**Fitts:** You think that the incoherence of the first phase is bad, but wait until you see the second phase.

**Blazer:** It will be coherent all right, but it will turn us into slaves.

**Fitts:** Maybe.

**Blazer:** That would be the end result that is actually planned.

**Fitts:** You are talking about total lockdown.

**Blazer:** There is a reengineering. There is a belief that the engineers can do a better job than even nature does.

**Fitts:** My sense is that this is how Mr. Global squeezes the most out, but Mr. Global is still in charge. The big debate is: Who will be in charge – Mr. Global or the AI?

I think that the AI is air cover for Mr. Global and allows Mr. Global to go way deeper and be much more invasive, and this reinstitutes slavery. I think that Mr. Global's goal is slavery, and this is a great slavery because it's totally invasive and people don't even know that they are a slave because they are so mind-controlled.



**Blazer:** They are embracing it, and it is giving them benefits from their perspective along the way. It's a seduction process. So it's not the Gulag or the FEMA camps; this is another way of enslaving you while those other guys are talking about that.

**Fitts:** It's really funny. Whenever I talk with somebody who really believes that this is all really going to end up with FEMA prison camps, those are the moments when I just don't even know what to say.

**Blazer:** It's the same as: Why does anybody need to be chipped anymore when they have a cell phone?

**Fitts:** With the spraying you are breathing in particles, and your whole body is a chip.

**Blazer:** Right, and you don't even have to go there. The bottom line is that all of the things that you would want a chip for are: "Where are you, what are you saying, what are you thinking, and who are you talking to?" - your cell phone tells you all of that.

**Fitts:** One of the reasons why I don't necessarily think that it is going to end up in a bad place is because I think that the Midianite thing is going to happen.

For the people who are new subscribers, in the story of Gideon in the Bible, Gideon is asked by an Angel of the Lord to throw the Midianites out of Israel. The short story is that the way that Gideon does it is he raises the vibration level and brings light to the situation, and the Midianites kill each other.



So you are going to have all of these very powerful people and forces and governments – whether it is business or governments – all with AI capacity, all competing with each other and fighting with each other.

We just had the United States pass a new policy that they can hack offensively, and we know that the Chinese are hacking like crazy.

**Blazer:** Yes. They learned that from us.

**Fitts:** So you have two AI superpowers who are going to go to war digitally – with satellites. That is why I say that the company that is going to make the most money in the next 20 years is the guy who turns out to be the leader in cleaning up space debris.

So the two AI superpowers are going to go to war on the systems, and the Midianite thing is going to happen. I'm going to turn my AI loose to fight your AI. I just think that the unintended consequences are going to be unbelievable.

Richard Maybury just put out a new newsletter which is quite charming. He basically says, "Look, the internet is going to go down for weeks at a time because these guys are going to blow it up fighting with each other."

Maybe that is true, maybe it is not. But I think that the chances of the Midianite thing happening here are just off the charts.

You take China and the US warring with derivatives as interest rates are going up with AI, and do you know what could go wrong?



**Blazer:** Because of the speed that it moves and because it tends to monopolize and because the guy with the most powerful AI, which is a combination of programming and computation power, he will win. This is one game where the guy with the most wins.

I think that there will definitely be a phase where the Midianite thing is happening. It is happening now. It is happening on many fronts now. I think that is what we are experiencing a lot of that in the political arena. The Kavanaugh hearings are a good example in one dimension, but ultimately you are going to end up with a concentration of data and processing power. There will be a winner, and then that person will have unlimited control of persons or agencies or whatever there is, and that is the danger of this.

Then when AI starts optimizing for itself and that type of power has been unleashed, you lose control of everything. You are made irrelevant.

It's not me saying that. That is what the guys who are concerned about this are saying, but they have confidence that they can keep it under a leash and they can keep it in control.

**Fitts:** How are they going to keep it under a leash?

**Blazer:** I don't believe it. I mean, you can't control the pollen that comes off of a GM crop, regardless of the representations that they made, which were false to begin with. The pollen ended up being 1,000 miles away in Mexico from where the corn was planted.



When you unleash a GM fish into the ocean, you have no idea of what the consequences are going to be. You have 150,000 new chemicals that were invented in the last 120 years that have been put into our ecosystem. We have very little understanding of what each individual chemical does, never mind the combination of that.

So now imagine that you have an AI that could understand the ramifications of a biological system of those chemicals and now can manipulate those chemicals to optimize the situation for itself. That is kind of the scale that we are talking about - something that is absolutely incomprehensible to us from a situation that we created.

**Fitts:** The AI will think it is logical. The logic won't make any sense to us.

**Blazer:** They will have the ability to handle a model with that many variables, look for patterns, test hypothesis, and create a goal that they can then optimize the system to achieve.

**Fitts:** I want to throw into this regulatory warfare. I come back to my shock whenever anybody says, "There is a purge, so we are all going to get put into FEMA camps."

If you have ever been targeted with regulatory warfare, what you need to understand is that the governments have the ability to command 150% of your time, and they can keep you busy from now until the end of your life with compliance.

**Blazer:** Which is why people plead out. "Let me plead to something so I can get you off my back."



**Fitts:** I always told the story of how I ended 11 years of litigation. I settled and got a whole bunch of money, and I proceeded to have to pay my taxes. It took three and a half years. I spent \$150,000 on accountants and lawyers, and I owed zero dollars in taxes. It was regulatory warfare. It was an amazing experience, and I've seen that kind of situation many times.

If you are dealing with the AI and the AI is doing these various things with you, you also are going to be dealing with Federal, state, and local government anywhere in the developed world. That could make you a target of regulatory warfare at any time.

**Blazer:** I also look at there being two classes developed, which is the classes that are part of a system that is enhanced by all of these wonderful features and one that is not. "You didn't behave, so you don't get to check out at the supermarket."

What are you going to be able to do? You are not going to be able to do hardly anything if everything is digitized and we know everywhere that you are and your car is run by AI. You can't go anywhere, you can't do anything, and you can't buy anything because you didn't play the game.

**Fitts:** It's the 'mark of the beast'. That is one of the questions: How do you navigate this so that you don't get turned off?

**Blazer:** The bigger conclusion that we came to is that the planning tools that you have been using and the planning mindset that you have been using are not going to really work for you that well because things are so complex and so unpredictable.



**Fitts:** I didn't watch them all, but one of the funniest things about the Kavanaugh hearings was here is a guy who has grown up in the system, and he has always been protected by the law. The law always works for him. He has no idea what it's like to live to be a poor black guy in a neighborhood where they beatdown is coming and due process doesn't apply.

I lived from 1996 on in a world that is out of control, and there is a game, and the law does not necessarily apply to you. You have to be prepared to deal with that.

So you are watching Brett Kavanaugh, and it's kind of funny because he couldn't compute it. He couldn't compute that the due process didn't apply. He couldn't compute that facts didn't matter. He couldn't compute that the Democrats didn't care what the truth was; they were just out to get him.

At one point I looked at him, and he only had the Democrats after him whereas I had the White House, the Republicans and the Democrats, and the bureaucracy all trying to get me. I was saying, "Pal, you don't know what trouble is."

Really my concern was: Do we really want somebody on the Supreme Court who doesn't understand what it's like for most Americans to live outside the law? He is so protected. Do we really want a baby on the Supreme Court?

So now he knows what it's like.



**Blazer:** We wanted to give people a sense of the tsunami that is coming – the potential rate of change. In addition to these ‘people’ kind of changes that are involved, there is a digital change that is happening in our life that can move incredibly fast and will be coming from many different directions. It will have effects on your life that are yet to be determined.

**Fitts:** One of the reasons that I wanted to do this discussion with you now is because with 5G coming, the ability to take the mind control up in combination with AI is very significant. I don’t think that it is very difficult to see it, grapple with it, or understand it unless you have lived in it. I have the unique advantage of having come to it and lived with it and dealt with it early.

We are in an environment where literally the population can be weaponized. I got everybody on The Solari Report to go look at the Chuck E. Cheese videos because I wanted them to understand that if they were in a place where one of those fights broke out to turn off their phones and get the hell out of there. There is nothing that you can do because it’s not natural.

**Blazer:** What are other ways that they weaponize us? This whole gender thing is a weaponization.

**Fitts:** Right. The way to keep everybody from gathering to figure out what is going on and do something about it is to play the ‘divide and conquer’ game. The number one divide and conquer game is men versus women. The beauty of the divide and conquer that they are running is this: You want to create a world where you can implement robotics really fast. The way to do that, I think, is to slip the robotics right into the human systems – the payroll systems and the human taxation systems – because then you don’t have to create a new parallel system; you can just slip them right in.



But in order to do that, I need a robot to be a citizen, and I need the robot to have a ‘gender x’. So how do you create gender x? Well, you get into the human rights and the transgender rights and, “These people deserve rights,” and the next thing you know, you’ve got women running around screaming for the right to kill their unborn babies – talk about not-human – and then you’ve got all of these other people screaming for the right to be gender x. They are all working for you. Do you see what I mean?

**Blazer:** So we are redefining what it is to be human, and then we are making things that are not human *human* – whether it’s a corporation or Sophia in Saudi Arabia. And everybody says, “This is wonderful. This is progress.”

**Fitts:** They always try to stack functions. So you want to engineer the divide and conquer. That is what I always said to everybody. “If you guys could just collaborate about the money, you could hate each other rich instead of hating each other poor.”

You want to get the divide and conquer going in a way that gets you legally, regulatory, and politically what you want. We saw in the Kavanaugh hearings a weaponization of the population. You got a whole significant amount of the population, particularly Democratic women, to support you in overriding due process.

“Survivors should be believed,” which means that Dr. Ford should be able to destroy this person because she said so. That is the basis. That is permission. That is allowing spectral evidence to be introduced as authentic evidence. That is how you get witch trials. That is how you get the Inquisition. That is how you make the sky green and the grass blue.



Traditionally the Democrats were the people who fought for the rights of people. So now you've got the Democratic women weaponized through empathy with other women for destroying due process. It's quite clever.

**Blazer:** So we have all of this stuff coming at us in many different forms and ways, and a lot of the paradigms and tools that we used in the past to plan, to protect ourselves, to protect our families may not apply. So what is our advice? What do we do?

**Fitts:** Let's talk about what we can do. The first thing is: We are going into a change that is so new and so unusual. It never happened before, but nobody knows what is going to happen. You don't know what is going to happen. I don't know what is going to happen. The people listening to this don't know what is going to happen. All we know is that it is going to be tumultuous.

The other thing is that once upon a time I was a person who had a 20-year plan, a 10-year plan, a five-year plan, and a one-year plan. Everything was planned out.

Then I went into a world that was like this where nothing is fair, there is no law, it is out of control, and I got down to: What is my plan for the day? Sometimes it was just my plan for the next hour. If you read *Deep Survival*, they have plans for the next five seconds.

You have to be like a bobble doll. You have to be able to keep bouncing back, and you have to be able to operate with significant uncertainty.

One of the things that I've struggled with on The Solari Report is I keep having subscribers who are trying to get me to give them certainty. There is a lot of fear porn and hope porn that gives people certainty; it's just not true. It's just wrong.



**Blazer:** But they feel good.

**Fitts:** Right. It's the simplification and the dumbing down. Here is this ideology that makes everything simple, "The stock market is going to crash, and everything will fall apart, and then we will be okay because we will be back to normal."

You can't oversimplify it. The other thing is that you have to operate with a level of uncertainty that you have never operated with before. You grew up in a world where information doubled every 100 years to a world where it doubles every day.

**Blazer:** And how do we keep our bearings?

**Fitts:** How I keep my bearing is spiritually. I told you this story, and I'll tell it again, of when Hamilton Securities was destroyed. I'm the type of person who thinks it is very important to understand what your goals are.

Every day when I got up I would say, "My three goals are..." and I would write down three goals. Then I would say, "No, that's not it."

**Blazer:** This was post-attack.

**Fitts:** Correct. This is after they stole the software and everything. Finally I went to church one day, and the co-pastor gave a sermon. She was shaking her hand at us, and she said, "Honey, you don't need a car. You don't need a man. You don't need a house. You need to get in right relationship with the Lord." I said, "Oh, that is what I need to do. That is my goal."



In other words, I can't have a goal that is material. I have to have a goal of basically staying coherent and staying in alignment with divine intelligence, and that is the pathway. The pathway will be unveiled. It's like going on a trip and not knowing where you are going to end up.

It's not like I am going to California; I am going for a Walkabout. It's just like what the Aborigines do; you go for a walkabout, and you are lead and the pathway unfolds.

So we are all on a walkabout. We don't have a set destination. You can have a vision. I have a really clear vision of where I want Solari to go and what I want it to be, but it's an energetic vision; it's a spiritual vision. Every month, every week, every year it changes.

It's not that we don't have budgets; we have budgets.

**Blazer:** How do you maintain this alignment with 'the light' as I would describe it?

**Fitts:** To me, the number one thing is integrity. You do your best to have integrity, and you do your best to only associate with other people who have integrity.

**Blazer:** What is number two? Food? Don't eat GMOs.

**Fitts:** It goes back to what we talked about when we first met: Eat fresh food, buy local, and shut off your TV.

You have to have your health. So you cannot put crap in your body – whether it's your food, your water, or pharmaceuticals.



**Blazer:** And electromagnetic radiation.

**Fitts:** Right. I used to get really upset when I first started to work as an investment advisor because I would have people who were millionaires telling me that they couldn't afford organic food. Basically they had been trained to strip their life of all capital and put it into the Military-Industrial Complex while they were destroying and poisoning their body. It made no sense.

**Blazer:** Don't poison yourself. That is the first rule. Stay coherent and aligned.

**Fitts:** Right. So number one is: Stay in integrity. Number two is: Be healthy.

**Blazer:** Don't poison yourself.

**Fitts:** The third thing is totally unique to everybody, and that is: What is it that you need to maintain coherency? You cannot plan, you cannot act, and you cannot do anything in this environment unless you stay coherent.

**Blazer:** That was the question: How do we stay coherent? The first two things are: Act with integrity and associate with people who act with integrity, and don't poison yourself. Is there one other thing?

I guess that I would say that you've got to learn how to listen. You've got to learn how to perceive in a different way.

Another key thing is to be aware of what is happening.



That awareness at least gives you the ability to see what is coming at you so that you are not surprised or totally taken off guard. Awareness always is a precursor to understanding.

There are information sources out there, and that is what we are saying by ‘aligning with divine intelligence’ or ‘aligning with the light’. There are information sources out there that you have to figure out how to be open to during this walkabout.

If you are walking about with dark glasses on, earplugs in, listening to music, and so on, you are not going to hear or be able to perceive to receive the information that is out there.

**Fitts:** Right. There are two kinds of information. One is positive, and one is negative. About 60% of our subscribers are Americans. Americans have grown up in a world that is very sheltered. We are all a little bit like Brett Kavanaugh. As a result, when you are targeted covertly, we don’t see it coming.

I just described a couple of situations that I have had in Memphis with covert targeting. I saw it coming, and I was able to react in time.

We have to understand that now at the local level these things could come. There is significant organized crime in the mix, and we have to be awake and see it coming. But there are also lots of friends and allies out there, and we have to be open to them.

Part of the drill here is: How can you stay conscious enough and see the negative coming but stay open – not stay closed or live in fear – to the opportunities? They are both there.



I'm always struck because The Solari Report subscribers say, "There is nobody around me like me." I say, "There are tons of people like you around you, but you have to go find them, and you have to be open to finding them."

**Blazer:** I like this idea of the walkabout.

**Fitts:** It's just like the Aborigines do it. If you look at how they do walkabouts, there is a great book called *Mutant Message* about how to do it.

**Blazer:** That is going to be on the reading list associated with this, right?

**Fitts:** Yes.

**Blazer:** So have we accomplished what we wanted to with this talk, or is there something else that you wanted to discuss?

**Fitts:** There are a couple of other things that I wanted to say about what to do. There are three rules of thumb that I always have, and I use them constantly when I am in a situation. If you haven't watched *Wave Genome*, it is really an excellent Solari Report to watch. It's the 2<sup>nd</sup> episode on the future science by Ulrike Granögger.

One of the rules of thumb that I always use is an expression from scripture, "Faith is the substance of things hoped for but not yet seen." You hear this a lot when you listen to the interviews that we have done with Jon Rappoport. The building block of reality is created from a cement called 'faith'. Many of us are trained to believe that we have to understand where the world is going and align ourselves to match it – align with the primary trends, which is fine. But the reality is that our world is created through our faith.



I've told you many stories about where I was told that it was hopeless and I had to go along, and I said, "I'm not going along. Kill me, but I'm not going along."

You stand on faith. Faith is the building block of reality. It's our faith, and you have to operate by faith.

If you spend a lot of time in rural America, what you discover is that Americans really operate on faith. "Oh, it will all work out," not because that is the clever thing or the smart thing, but they operate on faith.

I love my mayor. We were just over seeing the Hickory Valley cotton gin. Every Sunday he would open up church with a bible reading and say, "Just remember something good is going to happen to you today." That is the pluck of the American spirit. That is faith.

What I see with a lot of the attacks on the general population is that they are trying to take away your faith. They can't because faith is the substance that you produce that creates your future. You can't let someone take away your ability to create – what Jon Rappoport calls 'imagination'. He does his imagination exercises where he is trying to teach you how to invent your own reality.

If there are three things that you have to protect, they are: Your faith, your hope, and your love. Those are the ingredients that you use to create your future. Part of this is a battle between the AI and your faith-creating abilities. The AI can't take that away from you; only you can shut that down. You have to nurture your faith and your ability to create the building blocks of your reality.



**Blazer:** Also, those are three qualities that AI doesn't have. Those are distinctly human qualities. So what we are looking at is really an 'other' and a human. So this is a way that we can protect humans and assure that they have a place in the future.

**Fitts:** Right. So what we are trying to do is find a way for my faith, hope, and love to connect and nurture your faith, hope, and love, and vice-versa. One of the reasons why you have to take this down to people of integrity is that you can only do that with people of integrity or it becomes dangerous.

The second rule of thumb is from the Finnish health officer who did so much great work on mind control and targeting individuals, and she was targeted and basically assassinated. Her last three words were, "Love is the answer."

**Blazer:** That is four words.

**Fitts:** You are right. Her last four words were, "Love is the answer."

**Blazer:** AI would have figured that out right away and not made that mistake.

**Fitts:** I would have tricked AI! "Love is the answer."

In my different writings, I always say 'LIA' for 'Love is the answer'. It gets back to the faith, hope, and love thing. Love is the answer. So you have to come at solutions with love. Sometimes that means loving the people who are trying to kill you. When you love somebody, you understand. You get inside their head.



**Blazer:** Can you love them with a .375 Lapua?

**Fitts:** Yes. Actually, you can. You can.

The third thing is one that I used a lot in periods that have the most danger and tension, particularly because we are all going to go through a re-sorting of who we live with, who we associate with, who we love. There is a re-sort. If somebody wants to turn into a zombie or a weaponized population, you have to get them out of your life.

There is a re-sort that goes on in who your networks and who your friends are. The first two lines in *A Course in Miracles* is, “Nothing real can be lost. Nothing unreal is real.”

If all of the people in my life would fall away, first I would feel bad because I had lost that person. Then I would realize, “Oh, that wasn’t real.”

It’s like a sculpture, and the universe is sculpting out everything that is not real. It is taking me down to what is real. From there, I build what is real.

You have to understand that maybe something was real last year, but in the world that we are going into, that can’t come on the walkabout. Every one of us is going on a walkabout. Each walkabout will be unique. Each one will be different. How you do it is different than how I do it, but not everyone can come on our walkabout. The only things that can come on your walkabout are real.

**Blazer:** What are the three things again?



**Fitts:** First is: Faith is the substance of things hoped for but not yet seen. Second is: Love is the answer. The third is: Nothing unreal is real.

Do you have three?

**Blazer:** No, I don't have three. What I would say is that I have never understood why good people need religion to help them be good.

**Fitts:** They don't; they need divine intelligence.

**Blazer:** We kind of know what the right thing to do is. If we can align with the stuff that gives you that knowledge and that power, that is where the certainty is. Then you can feel very confident in the other uncertainty of the everyday, and you can approach it with confidence because things will work out.

**Fitts:** This is why I get back to the state of amusement. If you are aligned and plugged into the divine intelligence, you can maintain a state of amusement. It's a beautiful feeling.

When you are in that state of right relationship, you feel great no matter what is going on, and you really can stay in a state of amusement. And you have to laugh.

**Blazer:** No one religion owns this. I want to make that clear from my perspective. This is not about one religion that has a better insight into this than others. This supersedes religion and it supersedes our human condition to a certain extent, but we have the ability to align and perceive and to receive this information that allows us to then make choices – almost at an intuitive level.



**Fitts:** Right. You will make brilliant choices that you receive intuitively that to an AI will make no sense.

**Blazer:** It's not a channel that AI can tap into. To me, that is where the real power is for us humans.

**Fitts:** If you will, this is a battle of those who want to resonate with life because this is about living with intelligence. Divine intelligence is part of living intelligence. We are talking about resonating with the cows and the trees and all of creation versus resonating with machines.

Slavery will be instituted by getting you and me to resonate with the machines instead of with life. So do we resonate with life and with each other, or do we resonate with a machine?

**Blazer:** I may have to sell my Apple stock (if I owned any).

**Fitts:** You might! We are coming to a world where you are going to have to pick day to day to day, hour to hour to hour. You are going to be dealing with people who are resonating with machines, and you can't trust them. You can love them, but you can't trust them in certain ways. You are going to have to navigate that, and you are going to have to build as much as possible. You are going to have to be a person who can resonate with life. You are going to have to find and identify and work with people who can do it, too, under very tumultuous circumstances.

**Blazer:** That is basically the message that you wanted to deliver, right?



**Fitts:** Right. The message that I want to deliver is what I said with the Space-Based Economy and what I said in *The Rise of the Asian Consumer* and I said it when I introduced your interview on AI: I want each person listening to this to take the time to understand that we have multiple tsunamis coming at us. They are invisible to us. It's not like we see a wave 1,000 feet high coming at us, but they are coming. We need to have a new way of moving around in our life. We need to mentally prepare.

First and foremost, this is spiritual and mental. The question is: Who controls your mind? Is it a whole bunch of AI, or is it you? Is your mind unbeatable or not? Are you prepared to deal with this level of spiritual warfare?

Each person has to find that place within themselves. Each person has to anticipate and get ready to rock-n-roll. The leadership is about to move us into a whole new phase, and we are moving into that phase – whether we like it or not. They will do their purge, and we have to figure out how we do our purge.

**Blazer:** A key here is to know what clarity feels like in your body – emotionally, psychologically, and physically. That feeling can be a guide that you are maintaining that state and that alignment. Then you can do your walkabout, and then you can be open to the potential that is there.

**Fitts:** Right. I can't tell you how to do it, and you can't tell me how to do it. All we can tell someone with this conversation is that you need to take the time to figure out how you are going to do it because the purge is about to begin.



**Blazer:** Let the purge begin.

**Fitts:** Harry, it is always a pleasure. Ladies and gentlemen, thank you for joining us on The Solari Report. Do you have anything to say before we close, Harry?

**Blazer:** Yes. Do you want to go for a walkabout?

**Fitts:** Yes, let's go for a walk.
