



**Catherine Austin Fitts:** Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to *The Solari Report*. This is Catherine Austin Fitts and Dr. Joseph P. Farrell, and this is *Part II: News Trends & Stories*. Last week was *Part I*, and I strongly recommend you listen to or read that one first.

Don't forget there is also a web presentation. If you go to the web presentation, under the *News Trends & Stories* section, you can go through the *Trends* and the *Top Stories for Part II*. For *Part II*, we will also deep dive into the **Unanswered Questions** and **Take Action** and **Inspiration**.

This quarter we are saying goodbye to the **Trump Report Card**. Joseph, I am sure that you are happy about that.

**Dr. Joseph Farrell:** Immensely. As I said, if we were doing report cards on 'Bidenenko', you could write me down as an 'F' across the board for however many months he has actually been 'in office'. (Make sure you put quotations around 'in office'.)

**Fitts:** On the last **Report Card**, you went from an F to a G to an H. You were inventing new grades at high speeds.

For *News Trends & Stories Part II*, we do four categories. First, we look at **Culture, Science & Technology**, then **Space**, and finally, **Food & Health**. So there are four categories, and then we dive into **Unanswered Questions**.

We start with one of your favorite topics, and the one where you had revolutionized *The Solari Report* because when you said, "We've got to save the culture," I didn't understand what you meant, being an investment banker and hugely focused on financial issues. So, I started to dig in and try to understand what you were saying, and it has changed everything. It's quite remarkable.

The first thing that I said to you was, "What's my action? What do I do?"

You have *The Solari* network and the Giza Death Star network and everybody running around trying to preserve the culture. It's had some remarkable impacts.

Let's start with **Culture**:

## Story #11: Has the War on God Accelerated?

**Farrell:** Before I answer that, I want to reference a poem that you alluded to by William Butler Yeats. You mentioned it in connection to a line from his poem called *The Second Coming*, “And anarchy being loosed upon the world.”

I want to put as a header to my comments and answer to that question by reading the context of that remark that you pulled from the poem:

Things fall apart; the center cannot hold;  
Mere anarchy is loosed upon the world,  
The blood-dimmed tide is loosed, and everywhere  
The ceremony of innocence is drowned;  
The best lack all conviction, while the worst  
Are full of passionate intensity.

That rather well sums up culturally what we are dealing with. So I am prefacing this under the header, “The ceremony of innocence is drowned’ because ‘Mr. Globaloney’ – lacking culture, lacking morality, and lacking virtue – is really all about drowning the ceremony of innocence. It’s an interesting and telling line because ceremony or ritual, whether we like it or not, is part of most spiritual traditions to some degree.

During these COVID lock-ups, what I thought was very interesting and not accidental was this mad rush to shut down non-essential activities like synagogues, churches, mosques, Buddhist temples, and what have you because they cannot stand any transcendence. Transcendence of any sort, and particularly the Christian sort, is what they don’t want. That gives people a frame of reference for action and thought that lies outside of their control, and that has a claim to universality they want to put their own counterfeit substitute in place of.

I do think that, yes, they are at war with anything that could or claims to represent God. It doesn’t matter what tradition it’s from; they don’t want any of it.

**Fitts:** If you look at some of the most frightening reports about the impact of the injections, they literally lose their spark.

**Farrell:** I was going to mention that. There was a case of the lady in the U.K. I think it was when the AstraZeneca vaccine was being tested; it was the Oxford University vaccines that were being tested. There was a report of a lady who had taken the shot, and she said, “They’ve killed God.”

There is that strange thing on YouTube that people were posting during the early period of the COVID plan/ ‘scamdemic’. I don’t know whether this is true or not, but the real point is who was making it. Reportedly Bill Gates, making a presentation to the CIA, talked about creating a vaccine that would ‘turn off’ the God gene.

I don’t care if it was Bill Gates or whoever; it’s the concept itself. The concept is an interesting admission in its own way that humanity is ‘hardwired’ for God, and they had to find some way to turn that element off.

**Fitts:** Tim Keller is one of my favorite ministers or preachers; I love his sermons. He has this long series on Proverbs, and he said, “God threaded wisdom throughout the universe.”

It’s as though they are trying to disconnect us from that wisdom.

**Farrell:** It’s even more pronounced in a group of early church followers called the Apologists. There is a statement in St. Justin Martyr that the human physical form itself is made in the image of God. To them, that meant that we are made in the image of Christ in his incarnate life. It’s a very, very interesting statement. It goes back to this more general idea that we are somehow hardwired for that.

I think ultimately, no technology could ever turn it off completely. What they are really trying to do is substitute something else in its place.

**Fitts:** They are trying to substitute the AI machine.

**Farrell:** We are back to the distractions and the collective as God. Think Marxism. We are back to some abstraction rather than something that you live

and deal with on a daily basis.

I think that this is behind everything else, and I believe there is a full-scale war on God because these globalists either hate him, or worse, they have so turned themselves off to anything good, beautiful, or true that they don't want to see any of it around. They don't want to be reminded of it because it's reminding them of something that's not a presence in their life.

**Fitts:** The way that I say it is simplistic: I think they want us to resonate with a machine and to basically be hooked up to the cloud. Part of that is teaching the robots and the drones how to do everything. Once we finish teaching the robots and the drones how to do everything, what is the utility?

**Farrell:** This is 'Mr. Globaloney's' philosophy. Everything is material and utilitarianism, and you can't build a human civilization, even if you are 'Mr. Globaloney'.

In other words, I think they will be caught in the ineluctable logic of their own philosophic commitments.

**Fitts:** But they seem to believe that AI can make people smarter. In other words, if you hook everybody up to the cloud and you hook them up to AI, then you can use the centralized intelligence to get them to be more intelligent than they are on their terms – not on ours.

**Farrell:** That is a reduction of reason to mere ratiocination. That's not reason. Read Aristotle or the Stoics. That's not what they are talking about, or that is a small part of what they are talking about when they speak about reason. For them, passion and emotions are part of human intelligence. As a result of what they are doing – resonating with machines – is just resonating with the grand abstractions. I believe this is a fundamental philosophical error that they are making.

**Fitts:** There is a problem if you want to keep everything secret. If we live in a transparent world, then the crowd will be intelligent. They might not think long-term enough for you, but they will be intelligent. If you keep everything secret and make up all of these lies about what is really going on, then they get stupider

and stupider, and you get more and more frustrated managing them. So if you're going to keep tremendous amounts secret, they think it's easier to put us all on remote control.

**Farrell:** That is what I am arguing. They are caught in their philosophical presuppositions, and eventually – if they are successful, and I don't think they will be in putting into place everything they want to put into place – they will themselves be caught in that machine and wake up too late.

They are trying to get rid of anything that grounds humanity. The other part of this is that people have to wake up and understand that the mass media is nothing but a propaganda machine. They need to tune that out or develop their own mental faculties to challenge some of these narratives they are being fed.

The surest way to do that, for all the errors and the sins of religion throughout history, they have also been stabilizing factors and have – at the times that they have been the most faithful to themselves – allowed significant necessary reforms to occur. I'm thinking of the anti-slavery movement that began. Primarily people were waking up to the immorality based on their own religious tradition of that practice.

That's what they're afraid of. They have to get rid of that, and they are trying every trick in the book to do it. I think that we are hard-wired for it.

Ultimately, I think that's why the system will break down. You can certainly obscure or make the likeness of God obscure because that is your personal responsibility to how you respond to that, but the image of God, no, that's hard-wired into us.

To put it bluntly, we are created as human beings for worship. The moment you turn that off, you look for substitutes, and you find all sorts of idols that you could submit to. Eventually, they come crashing down because they're not fulfilling. I think that is what 'Mr. Globaloney's' position is, and I think that's the position he's in.

**Fitts:** The founding fathers said that to maintain a republic you needed a Christian basis.

**Farrell:** You need some sort of basis for it, yes.

**Fitts:** I've always thought that democracy needed Christianity, but I'm beginning to realize that you can't get rid of the democratic process without getting rid of God.

**Farrell:** You can't. It doesn't take long to 'scratch and sniff' into the fundamental spiritual core of virtually any religion to find something that is a hardcore of morality and a hardcore of 'spirituality'. However, I hate to use the general term 'spirituality' because that term is tossed around so much by people who have no grounding in any tradition so much that it's almost lost its currency.

There is acknowledgement of a transcendent principle at some point in any of them that lies outside of our ability to tinker with or get rid of, and that is what they are visibly trying to do. The speed at which they attempted to lock down the churches with this plan/ 'scamdemic' was not surprising to me because they have to get rid of that to make the plan work. It's not going to work for that reason.

**Fitts:** One of my favorite events of last year was the church that held services in their parking lot. The police showed up and said, "You're breaking the law."

They said, "Oh, no. It's a protest. We're having a worship protest," and the police went away.

I think that if enough people – and I only believe that it takes 5% - can face what is really going on, then we can start to make real headway. The problem with facing the war on God is that it can seem overwhelming when you first realize what is happening, particularly the demonic occult threads. But if you can face it, then you can start taking actions in your life that really protect yourself and support and nurture the culture.

**Farrell:** There is something else that has been a part of their playbook for some time, and I've spoken to this issue before. That is their attempt in going back several decades to infiltrate and coop the churches.

**Fitts:** They're using money; they've been trying to buy the churches and regulate them forever.

**Farrell:** That is part of the game plan, but what I'm talking about is the attempt to move churches away from their traditional doctrinal and liturgical morals because that is where the 'rubber meets the road'. I saw something recently that gave me some hope that people are finally waking up to the fact that this institutional subversion is across the board; it's not only in the academy or in the government or in corporations or sciences; it's in the churches.

This was a letter that was written anonymously by a Roman Catholic to his or her bishop. The letter was, "I am no longer making any donation or putting any money in the collection plate so long as you are tolerating this sort of hypocrisy at the highest level."

In other words, take your money out of the big banks. Only in this case, if your church is not living up to its own confession, you are obligated by your baptismal vows to be responsible for your faith. This applies if you are Lutheran, Roman Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, Anglican, or whatever.

**Fitts:** Let me ask you something: I have heard thousands of times preachers or churches refer to 'the mark of the beast', and yet here we have the mark of the best being rolled out, and you have the church almost silent. You have pastors marketing the injections, and they seem to be completely clueless. Is it because the nano-particles are so small?

If the mark of the beast comes in 100 million nano-particles, can they not see it?

**Farrell:** Maybe so. You have to understand that this cooption of the churches began to take place in the 18<sup>th</sup> century for very specific reasons. It then captured the seminaries. The seminaries were training an entire generation of clergy. It's the ecclesiastical version of what 'Mr. Globaloney' is doing with nations. They were training them to look to other churches or religions for their religious inspiration other than their own and attending their own.

In other words, you have a type of anti-Trumpism-to draw the analogy- that has

been going on in the churches for a long time. If you are trained in that way of thinking, it becomes virtually impossible for you to see the hypocrisy you are involved in.

I go back to Vatican II. I will tell a little story here. When I went to St. Vladimir's, I met a Roman Catholic priest who had converted to orthodoxy and had become an orthodox priest. His name was Father Sinatra of all things. I asked him, "Why did you do that?"

He said, "If you were a Roman Catholic priest prior to Vatican II, at your ordination when the bishop handed you the chalice, you took an oath to say and celebrate no other mass than had been delivered to you on this day on pain of excommunication."

**Fitts:** Really?

**Farrell:** Yes, that is true. So in other words, a Roman Catholic priest prior to Vatican II took an oath to celebrate the Latin Tridentine mass. Then suddenly, they were handed something that came out of a committee headed by an archbishop who turned out to be a Freemason, Annibale Bugnini. That caused a crisis of conscience for many Roman Catholic priests.

I could readily identify it. All my life, I have been in these churches where they have abandoned their liturgical confessional tradition. It started when I was a boy in the Methodist church. I watched the Episcopal Church do it. Every church is involved in this process to some degree, and I mean *every* single one.

You are not going to escape it by going to the local hangout or the local Bible Church either. It's involved there.

People have to understand this has been a long process that 'Mr. Globaloney' put into place. Incidentally, if you doubt me, the Rockefeller family was very heavily involved in financing this. Don't think that 'Mr. Globaloney' overlooked this.

I'm saying to take your money out of the big banks, and if your church is doing something, you have a responsibility by your baptismal vows. I was baptized

February 10, 1957. Those vows were taken, and I take them seriously.

Everybody has a responsibility for their faith. It's not the Pope, it's not the bishop, it's not the priest, it's not the monsignor, and it's not the pastor; it's you.

**Fitts:** Right, and you get the world that you finance.

When the financial coup started, they threw big Federal grant money at the churches. I remember being shocked. I had grown up with the tradition of separation. Then I began to notice, and really noticed this when I drove around, and saw that they were throwing big Federal mortgage insurance policies to finance big churches, and all of these congregations got themselves into a debt entrapment.

**Farrell:** And they also became outposts for money laundering. That is a perfect way to do it – through a church.

I am obviously talking of the Christian tradition, but I do not believe for a moment that 'Mr. Globaloney' ignored the synagogues or any other religious institution. It's across the board.

**Fitts:** In the last year, to watch the churches stay silent has been very shocking. I do have to say that someone who could qualify for *Hero of the Year* is Archbishop Vigano. I don't know if you've read his latest letter.

**Farrell:** I've read all of them.

**Fitts:** He has been very courageous. He is living in hiding now.

**Farrell:** I don't blame him; he's a real Roman Catholic.

**Fitts:** It's amazing to read his letters because you are listening to somebody who has genuine faith.

**Farrell:** I grew up watching Billy Graham and Fulton J. Sheen on television. I thought, "If Bishop Sheen was alive right now, what would he think of all of this?" It probably wouldn't be good.

**Fitts:** Right, but it shows you what a person of real faith would say and do. He is throwing down a marker that demonstrates the incredible failure of the church leadership. It's frightening.

**Farrell:** It's in a state of almost complete collapse. In my last volume of the tome, I talk about the patterns of apostasy and the techniques that are put into place to drive these agendas within the ecclesiastical bodies, and they are all over the place.

People can see if a church is authentic or not. It's high time to understand that if the church is being inauthentic, you are under no obligation to support it-none. You are not supporting an institution; you are supporting the church. That is a different thing, and people need to start living with that reality.

**Fitts:** I think this next story is the toughest one.

### **Story #12: Is Mr. Global Moving to Establish Private Central Ownership and Control of Education and Children?**

**Farrell:** I think so; I absolutely think so. What really sends me here is they made the play with Common Core, and that 'fell on its face'. Then came the COVID plan/ 'scamdemic', and Mr. Gates and Jeb Bush and all the Common Core supporters finally got what they wanted with the lockdowns and these so-called 'internet classrooms'.

I know teachers; I have many teachers on my website. Scott DeHart, one of my good friends, is a teacher. He had to go through this internet classroom experience for a year, and it was a nightmare. The teachers did not like it. The students complained because you cannot substitute a machine for genuine human interaction. There is just no way to do it.

One of the agendas of this whole plan/ 'scamdemic' was an attempt to get people accustomed to that type of 'education', and it turns out that it's not education at all-big surprise there!

I do think that was one of the goals.

Interestingly enough, as a result of it, more and more people took their children out of the system altogether and started homeschooling. So that whole thing may have backfired.

**Fitts:** Homeschooling has been rising dramatically already. Common Core contributed plenty to that, but now it's enormous, and we see new schools get started.

**Farrell:** Yes, and I think that trend will continue. The other thing that I think they may have 'cut their own throat' on is that 'Mr. Globaloney', back in the 1920's and 1930's, was funding all sorts of studies on how to gain control education. Of course, the Rockefeller family was heavily involved with that.

The way they came up with control was through teacher certification. It's my 'old saw': If you want to get control back and get real education going, get rid of all those education courses and start allowing teachers with degrees in real subjects like mathematics or French literature or whatever – based on those degrees – to teach their subject. That is all you need to do.

**Fitts:** I think that the goals here are far direr than most people think. One of the reasons I don't think that they are that concerned about education is that if you hook everybody up with their Neuralink to the cloud, you are back to AI doing it all.

I think they literally want physical control of the youths. We see these ridiculous plans on how you can have your baby in an incubator that is sitting in the living room so you don't have to grow it in the womb. Since energetics doesn't matter anymore and soul doesn't matter anymore, apparently, it can just grow in an incubator.

Last year someone got me to read one *Harry Potter* book. I found it very difficult to read, but the idea was that if you are a child, you want to go to school with the wizards, and your parents are muggles. They are old and a waste of time. It's all of this, "I want to play with the wizards," stuff.

I think the way they think they can jump the curve on the culture is to grab the

children. So, the thing with contact tracing and going into the home and taking out the child – they do; they want to assert physical control and move the child out of the family.

**Farrell:** That is the one human institution that has always been the bastion of preserving culture and civilization – the family. They are finding everything they can to wreck it from gender-neutral pronouns and Nancy Pelosi trying to get rid of them through acts of congress, and ‘on and on we go’.

**Fitts:** The war on God is a war on the family.

**Farrell:** It’s a war on family, and it’s a war on your children.

**Fitts:** My perception is that whatever happened with Pizzagate ‘scared them to death’, and now they are angry. They say, “You don’t like it? We’re just going to take your kids.”

**Farrell:** They’re not only angry, but they are in a hurry. It did scare them that all of the human trafficking and what they are doing to children and adolescents and so on is ‘beyond the pale’. These are Godless people who are trying to put all of this into place.

**Fitts:** Right, but they also tend to be Godless people who are addicted to adrenochrome, addicted to pedophilia, and addicted to the profits of trafficking. What they are doing now is are moving to a complete slavery system if they get their way. It’s a very gruesome story when you look at the children.

**Farrell:** Quit funding them. I hate to say it, but if you really care about and love your children, remove them from these schools.

**Fitts:** They’re not safe.

**Farrell:** I’m not saying that there aren’t good teachers in those school systems; there are. But the system itself is so broken. Do you want to take the chance on that any more than you want to take a chance on flying on an airplane that has never been tested and the company has been given a legal exemption from “if you fly the airplane and it crashes”? That is what they are doing with the

vaccines, and that is what they are doing with the children.

**Fitts:** It seems that you have plenty of good teachers, plenty of good parents, and plenty of good children. They should be able to get together. If you pull your money out of the banks and the big churches and pull your money out of the schools, you should be able to finance an alternative.

**Farrell:** I think so, too, and it's coming down to that.

**Fitts:** Bitcoin passed a trillion-dollar market capitalization in the first quarter, but we can't afford to build new schools? Can you explain that to me?

**Farrell:** I can't, other than to point out a wonderful article in the *Babylon Bee*. Did you see this? "Biden proposes \$2 trillion infrastructure project that reaches under the heavens." That is what they are doing, and the schools are part of the tower.

**Fitts:** I did a 'rant' on different cross-cutting investment and crypto issues. I said, "Let me go back for the last 20 years. What company should I have not financed so that I could invest in bitcoin? What family member who was going to lose their house should I have not helped so that I could invest in bitcoin? What person and job did I create that, instead of creating that job, I could have invested in bitcoin?"

I listed all these different things that I've done with my money, and I said, "What people should I have allowed to fail so that I could have had money in bitcoin?"

There is something about having a trillion-dollar market value in bitcoin – and I don't know what capital went into that, but let's say the principal capital that went into that is \$200 billion. Do you know what that \$200 billion could be doing in terms of building the kind of world that we want to live in?

**Farrell:** I know, it's unreal. People are investing in so much fake stuff, i.e., they are investing in blips on a computer screen.

**Fitts:** Or the national security state.

**Farrell:** Do you want to invest your money in that? How has it served you?

**Fitts:** They will say, “I’m getting a dividend, and my stock is going up. I’ve made a lot of money.”

**Farrell:** This is the problem. We are a narcissistic culture – if you can call it a culture. Morris Berman wrote these wonderful books, and he calls it ‘the culture of the hustle’.

You have to start investing locally, in your family, and in good people. That is the bottom line. And if the system is broken to this extent, stop trying to fix it and build another one.

**Fitts:** Here is the thing: You look at all the people who are building, and we are talking about building a physical slavery system with high-tech technology. If you look at all the people in technology, all the people in military, all the people in government, and all the people in central banks, we are talking about millions and millions of people building a slavery system, and their children and grandchildren will be slaves. Why are they doing it?

**Farrell:** The only explanation that I can find is that they don’t realize they are building it.

**Fitts:** I’m going to use you as the guinea pig here because you decided long ago that you did not have to go along; you decided long ago that what you did mattered.

What I hear from many people is, “I’m not important. I’m only one person. It doesn’t matter if I go along or not.”

There is a wonderful line in *The Gladiator*. I think he is quoting Marcus Aurelius when he says, “What we do echoes in eternity.”

In other words, I am only one person, but what I do matters. It matters to God, and it matters to me, and it matters to the people around me. You can’t build a slavery system and think that your contribution doesn’t matter.

**Farrell:** No, you can't. I think that one reason people are caught in the mentality of, "I'm only one person, and what I do doesn't matter," is that in a way, those people are already serving the grand abstraction. They are thinking, "We have all these high and mighty people who can move mountains and all of this. What can I do?"

Well, that is the point. Quit living in the abstraction first of all. What you do may affect your neighbors; what you do may affect your friends; what you do may affect your family, and they are the ones that you have to be concerned about. God doesn't require you to love humanity; he says, "Love your neighbor."

**Fitts:** I told this story many times. I was sitting in Hamilton Securities and turned to one of my partners who grew up on a Caribbean Island. I said, "I just realized that many of the partners I've had in my life grew up on islands. I wonder why that is."

He said, "When you grow up on an island, what you realize is that 'what goes around comes around', and what you see is that over many years, people who behave in a certain way attract back what they put out. There is a kind of karma and accountability, and it's very real. You see the dramatic difference in people's habits and behavior over the long run – both on the whole and on yourself. You can connect your behavior to the health of the whole, and you can see the relationship."

He said, "America is just a big island, but everyone here thinks that there is no connection between the whole and themselves, and there is."

**Farrell:** There is.

**Fitts:** And we are just about to discover it.

**Farrell:** Unfortunately.

**Fitts:** Before we leave **Story #12** and the children, I wrote a review in the first quarter on a book called *Irreversible Damage*. It's by a *Wall Street Journal* journalist

who went to Oxford Law School and is very bright. It's about the phenomena starting in 2016 of an explosion of teenage girls who went to transgender and their ability to get either drugs or surgery without their parents' consent. It's one of the most frightening books I've ever read. If you have a young daughter, this is a must-read.

Her number one recommendation in terms of what a parent can do is: Do not give your child a smartphone.

If you give a child a smartphone, the most psychopathic, demonic forces in the world have direct access to your child's brain and subconscious.

**Farrell:** Give your child a guitar or a piano. I can't emphasize enough to get your children off the internet addiction as much as you possibly can. It is destroying people's ability to think, to reason beyond a sound bite, and to form sentences. It's appalling to me what I see. It's to the point where, if I'm driving down by the park, I see youths walking along with their eyes on their phones. They are not talking to the people with them; they are not paying any attention to the natural beauty. Just turn that 'crap' off. It's so dehumanizing.

**Fitts:** It's dangerous.

**Farrell:** It's very dangerous. People don't even realize it.

**Fitts:** At *The Solari Report*, we have a commentary called '*Mind Control Tactics Used on Young People and Children*'. I prepared it for a group of grandparents who couldn't understand what was happening to their grandchildren. I said, "Look, you have to understand that if you look at the high-tech machinery that is attacking and manipulating your grandchildren, this is dangerous."

*Irreversible Damage* is one of the most frightening things I've ever read.

**Farrell:** It's incredible. We have an entire generation of children growing up with role-playing video games where they assassinate people or kill people or rob a bank or whatever, and it goes on and on.

**Fitts: Story #13: The Power of the Field: Is There an Energetic and**

## **Artistic Push Around Lockdowns?**

**Farrell:** I think so.

**Fitts:** I think it's very powerful.

**Farrell:** One of the interesting things that I think happened as a result of these lockdowns is that I noticed the people who were continuing normal activity would have concerts. They would get together and play music, read books to each other, and so on. That is the best thing that could have happened during this time.

I do think that we are going to have some sort of artistic pushback. I'm thinking of the early 1960's with rock music and how all of that music was really, in its own way, a cultural commentary. Some of it was very deliberate and very direct, and quite apparent. I think that is happening.

The other thing I think is happening is something that I've noticed which is very, very odd. I mentioned this in the previous quarterly report, but I want to mention it again. I've noticed more and more people who I would never have dreamed are turning to classical music. Have you noticed that?

**Fitts:** Yes.

**Farrell:** People who I would not think would normally expose themselves to this are listening to it.

**Fitts:** I think that one of the reasons it happened – at least in our networks – is that you have repeatedly made a very powerful presentation as to why listening to classical music is far superior to your entire intellectual and emotional life.

I've always loved classical music, and I've loved a wide variety of music. But since knowing you and talking with you, I have made an effort to listen to more and more classical. It started during the litigation. I told you that Bach was the only thing that could bring me back to coherence. It was only Bach and cows. It was an interesting combination.

I went into one of the first neural network websites. They asked you to listen to the music you preferred the most, and then they would tell you what people who prefer what you chose also prefer. It was a way of finding things. So I put in Bach, Handel (even though I would now say Vivaldi), Tina Turner, and Aretha Franklin. It came back saying, “Nobody likes what you like.”

I now listen to 80-90% classical music. One of the reasons is that now when I try to listen to non-classical, it's too ‘dumbed down’, and I have to go back to classical.

I think that what you persuaded me is that it's much easier to function in a multipolar world if you listen to classical music because most Americans grew up – and many people in the Anglo-American alliance – with not having to speak more than one language, and with the shriek-o-meter producing these very simplistic abstractions.

That is breaking down, so you have to function in a multipolar world, which is much more complex.

**Farrell:** The reason that kind of music – the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> century classical particularly – is so good for the mind is that if you expose yourself to enough of it, it almost subliminally teaches you to think in a very interdisciplinary way so that you can draw connections between things, and to hear or see patterns and their permutations etc..

There is absolutely no better master of that whole thing than J.S. Bach and some other composers of that era. They are exacting and very deliberate in their choice of things and the way they do things. There is no substitute for it.

If we are in a culture where we are doing this all the time and thinking in terms of one-dimensional sound bites and so on, it's no wonder that people who do expose themselves to it have that kind of revelation moment because it's there.

**Fitts:** You can't deal with uncertainty and you can't deal with what is happening in the world without the ability to engage in transcendence.

**Farrell:** Right.

**Fitts:** I don't know a better way to hook into transcendence than really fantastic music.

**Farrell:** I totally agree. As I wrote in *Microcosm and Medium*, that music is coming out of that cosmology very deliberately.

**Fitts:** I just have to show you this. You are not going to understand this, but this is a direct descendent of your influence on *Solari*. The last *Solari Report* was mailed in December but didn't get to subscribers for over three months.

**Farrell:** I received two copies.

**Fitts:** You had to because we gave up on the first mailing after three months, and we mailed a completely new copy. After their arrival, they clearly said, "We might as well let this go," and suddenly, they all arrived.

**Farrell:** Mine came within three days of each other.

**Fitts:** Yes! They let it 'rip'!

This is the new one. Let me show it to everyone. This is from the Scottish Museum; it's the Treaty of Arbroath and says, "For we fight not for glory nor riches nor honors, but for freedom alone, which no good man gives up except with his life." It's called *Visions of Freedom*. Nina Heyn, who was my first reaction when you said, "We have to preserve the culture."

So I asked Nina Heyn, "Would you write a culture column on art and movies?"

After *State of Our Currencies* and *The Injection Fraud*, I thought, "We need something a little more inspiring than more bad financial news," so I said, "Nina, I want you to write something on what artists have said about freedom throughout the ages. What have the great artists told us and taught us about freedom? Then I want a section on comets. What do artists say about comets as harbingers of freedom? Then I want something on the story of Gideon. So, what have artists painted about the story of Gideon?"

I'll mail it out this week, so you will have it the week after. I'm very curious what you think because, in fact, I attribute this entire document to your influence.

**Farrell:** Thank you.

**Fitts:** So you should like it.

**Farrell:** I'm sure I will.

**Fitts:** I did a book review on *The Power of Eight* by Lynn McTaggart who wrote *The Field*. I keep encouraging people to understand the power of what can happen through the field and the power of prayer and the power of intention to really shift things.

People keep saying, "What can I do?" and I say, "You can pray."

What you do is important, but I also think there is a great deal that can be done artistically and energetically.

**Farrell:** I do, too. This is why I say that if your child wants something to do, give them a guitar or a piano, and let them have at it. Encourage them to create something. You'll be surprised at what they come up with.

**Fitts:** I just love C.J. Hopkins. Hopkins is this fabulously successful playwright who starts to write essays about what is going on, and he came up with this website, *The Consent Factory*. He wrote an article at the beginning of the pandemic called *The Covidian Cult*. That one concept has 'ripped' virally, and it makes it so much easier for people like you and me to deal with the cults because it is a cult.

**Farrell:** It is a cult. Why? Because of the 'face diapers'. Everybody is masking their individuality to become some part of the collective that a technocrat at the CDC is telling us, "Wear your mask and socially distance." Talk about a cult! That does nothing! That's like putting up a chain link fence to try to keep out mosquitos.

**Fitts:** This is something else. You need to protect yourself from whatever the

flu is that is going around is Vitamin D and oxygen. So why don't you cut off your Vitamin D and oxygen?

One of the best presentations I saw on that in 2020 was Del Bigtree interviewing two women OSHA consultants on *The Highwire*. They gave chapter and verse on why the mask mandates violated the OSHA rules because they weren't safe. So if it had been a workplace, they wouldn't have been allowed.

**Farrell:** Did you see what Kathryn Huey did to the Ohio State Health Commission? It's brilliant! She brought in several graphs of COVID cases and deaths, but she took off the time. Then she challenged them to point where on the graph the mask mandates went into effect. If they were effective, it should be evident on the graph. Of course, it wasn't at all, and she caught them. She caught them in their own 'damnable', stupid, so-called logic because they couldn't point to anything. It's that kind of creativity that we need.

Imagine doing something like that in a piece of music or in a painting or in a short story. Just put it out there.

**Fitts:** I know you saw the flyer that Mads Palsvig at JFK 21 did. It's very artistic. It's, "How to tell if you've been captured by the Covidian Cult." It's up on the website now.

**Farrell:** I notice that more and more businesses are putting out signs that refuse to serve people who come in with a mask on.

**Fitts:** That Canadian gym is one.

**Farrell:** He is not the only business owner who is doing this. I think their days are numbered.

**Fitts:** Here is the Mads Palsvig flyer, 'How to tell if you've been brainwashed into the COVID Cult'. It prints on two sides of a page, and it's all very colorful. It has a section on COVID ideology, cult code of conduct, cult idols of worship, cult sacrifices and offerings, cult rituals and ceremonies, cult intolerance of dissenters, and the vaccine Q&A. It's hysterical-unbelievable.

**Farrell:** That is the artistic pushback. The ‘more the merrier’!

**Fitts:** What we need to do is turn that on the bankers.

## Science & Technology

### Story #14: Are Big Tech and Social Media Leading the Engineering of Censorship?

**Fitts:** I don’t think they are leading it; I think they were created to implement it – particularly the social media. I see most of these people as creatures of the intelligence agencies. The ones that have grown are the ones who have ‘played ball’ with the intelligence agencies. Whether they were started for that reason, I don’t know.

I see many of these young entrepreneurs as only being fronts for something that was created and built for others behind the scene, and their ‘claim to fame’ is that they offer a back door or a way of implementing different social goals.

If you are the intelligence agencies and the central bankers and want to build a social credit system, you create and breed up and exercise everything through these companies. So I don’t see these companies as being the leaders, but I see them as being an integral part of the infrastructure to get us to technocracy.

**Farrell:** I am four-square 100% agreed.

**Fitts:** What I don’t understand is why the millions of people who work in these industries don’t see it.

**Farrell:** They are in the habit. What you and I try to do is connect dots to try to see the big picture. Most people have been brought up in this education system to think in terms of separate compartmentalized information that is only true and has implications only for that narrow field.

It’s like John Taylor Gatto, the educator, said, “School bells inoculate us against thinking.”

What do you do? You have mathematics from 9:00 until 9:50. Then the school bell rings, and you have ten minutes to run to your next class, and you forget everything there. You're not thinking in terms of interconnections, and most people don't.

**Fitts:** I used to go crazy in school because it seemed like they were trying to keep everything from being connected.

**Farrell:** That is precisely it.

**Fitts:** It seemed to be patently obvious that everything was connected.

**Farrell:** Of course, but you and I were raised with that old tradition of liberal education. That is the way we were taught to think: Everything is connected. You don't forget math when you walk into English literature.

**Fitts:** I didn't learn that in school; I learned that on the streets.

**Farrell:** To a certain extent, I learned it in both ways, but I was also fortunate to have teachers who thought that way and who taught that way. I remember my World Lit teacher in high school, Mrs. Connors. She was one of these people who brought in everything. We were talking about Dostoevsky one minute, and the next minute we were talking about Jonathan Swift and Isaac Newton.

**Fitts:** There is something else. I grew up at dinner tables with both sides of my family, where the game was building civilizations. That is what we did.

When my father came back from the war, he designed a plan to reinvent how emergency rooms throughout the country would work. They took everything they learned in the MASH units and applied it to the emergency room. Their assessment was that this had saved many, many scores of lives by doing this. But it was all about building civilizations.

If you had said at any of our dinner table discussions, "I made money," they would look at you as though, "What? What's your problem?"

It's like a homebuilder saying, "I have more hammers than you do." It's, "So what?"

**Farrell:** And we are back to family again. This is why I think it's important to sit down and have family meals without the idiot box being on or phones, and just talk. "What do you think about this? What do you think about that?"

Start having conversations again. It's that simple.

**Fitts:** If you haven't thrown out your TV yet, just remember that your TV is a spy box.

It's ironic because we have seen unprecedented levels of censorship. It's quite unbelievable.

**Farrell:** It's unbelievable, and what is interesting is that if they are going to that extent, that tells me that there is still too much independent thinking out there.

**Fitts:** But it also tells me that they are very fragile.

**Farrell:** They are very fragile and very frightened, and they should be.

**Fitts:** You and I have never liked social media and have generally avoided it. I finally got talked into going on Twitter, which I found useful for the time that I was on it. But I just thought that the whole thing was a fix from the beginning. I am surprised to see how many people don't realize that.

**Farrell:** More and more people do. I've quit posting my blog articles on my Facebook page; I post very little on Facebook anymore. It's just usually trivial stuff.

I think that it is necessary. We have to quit 'feeding the beast'. These social media platforms are so ill for any sort of human conversation.

The other thing that the internet has done, which we also have to talk about while we are discussing the power of the field – and there have been studies about this – is that people on the internet are extremely insensitive and

discourteous. It is shocking, and there is no attempt to realize that the person at the other end of your comment or your blog or your snide remark is ‘a person’. There is no attempt. We wouldn’t talk this way in normal conversation with each other.

The other thing that I think we need to get back to is good old common courtesy.

**Fitts:** A couple of year ago I had a great-grandsons of Emily Post on for an interview. The Post family still runs the Post Institute. I think they are on their 49<sup>th</sup> edition or something like that; there are many editions. They do wonderful and extraordinary work.

I had him on because I was just despairing of the manners.

**Farrell:** There are no manners.

**Fitts:** Here is the problem: I saw more and more people on the internet behaving in a way that leads to powerlessness. There is an inability to conspire successfully; there is an inability to collaborate; there is an inability to engage in learning; and all of these behaviors lead to powerlessness, which I’m sure is why they are being encouraged.

**Farrell:** Conspiracy is interesting; conspiracy means ‘to breathe together’.

**Fitts:** I grew up doing conspiracies. I was trained that conspiracies are wonderful things. It was like that was how you built a civilization – one conspiracy at a time. Most of them were legal; they weren’t all legal, but most of them were. You stuck around and conspired because if you didn’t, you lowered your chances of getting it done.

You built civilization one conspiracy at a time, and it was fun; it was great. It was something that you wanted to be great at doing because it made you powerful.

I never knew it was a bad thing until I was ‘booted out’ of the establishment, and the fun stopped and everybody said, “No, you can’t do a conspiracy

because that's bad.”

I said, “Then how are we going to have fun?”

I can't get over it.

## **Story #15: Why Are Injection Makers Trumpeting Installing Operating Systems and Plug & Play Apps in Humans?**

**Farrell:** That's easy: They want control. They want control of your thoughts, they want control of your behavior, and they want control of your speech. That's simple. That's a big clue that these mRNA ‘vaccines’ are not vaccines; they are an operating system.

**Fitts:** Now that they have changed the definition in the Miriam Webster dictionary, they will take the position that they are ‘vaccines’.

**Farrell:** Of course, this is something that I've tried to warn people about all the time. These are very, very old gnostic tactics. Just look at the techniques of Gnosticism. ‘Boil’ the religion out of it, and what do you end up with? You end up with a batch of processes to keep people perpetually enslaved. This process itself motivates these people.

You said something two or three years ago in one of these quarterly reports, “If I were in charge, I would get rid of all the lawyers because they're all about just the process. They are not about any results.”

To put it differently, what is the end of all this progressivism? They can't come up with an end because it's the process that empowers them.

**Fitts:** David O'Hagan, who I am going to record this month on *The Solari Report*, did a series of three articles where he really dove into the marketing material of the injection makers and pulled out all of their quotes about, “This is an operating system,” and, “This is a plug-n-play app.” Here is the unbelievable thing: They feel very comfortable saying this openly.

**Farrell:** Do you know why? I think that it's because they are so confident in

their control of the media to keep that aspect out of people's eyes, and to denigrate anybody who takes their own literature as their word. "That's all a conspiracy theory."

No, that is in your own literature. They are that confident in their control over the media.

**Fitts:** One of the things that I've done for years, being an investment advisor, is I listen to the company analyst presentations and the discussion of their business, and read their SEC documents. They tell the stock investors one thing over here, and then they tell the shriek-o-meter another thing over there. It's integrating those two things, which is a fascinating process.

**Farrell:** And why would they have that shriek-o-meter out there if they weren't doing it? I'm totally in agreement.

If you want to find out about these mRNA vaccines, go on their websites and read it. It's right there.

**Fitts:** I told you that I was reading the FBI affidavit on the indictment of Charles Lieber from Harvard, head of the chemistry department. When Lieber was arrested, they arrested him at the beginning of the pandemic for his role working with the Wuhan Institute. I went to his website, The Lieber Group, which has received approximately \$15 million in grants from NIH (National Institute of Health) and DOD. So, this person has been getting 'big money' from DOD for a long time, and then he was getting 'big money' from the Wuhan Institute as the Institute was being financed by NIH.

When someone like Barr locks a person down like that, it looks like he is trying to shut down discovery. He is trying to put a big cone of silence over Charles Lieber. I thought, "What is he trying to shut up here?"

I went onto the Lieber website. I even took a copy of it because I thought, "I don't know how long it's going to be until this site disappears." This man is a leader in injectable brain-machine interface. If you look at some of the indications from Wuhan, it appears as though you are looking at people who are experiencing significant neurological damage, which is what this stuff does.

I thought, “Are we looking at a Bill Gates-Harvard prototype in Wuhan on brain-machine interface?”

Then many of us ‘turned on the juice’ to criticize Gates and say that he wants to load an operating system and all of that. So, you can see that Gates’ brand is getting a bit tattered. Then suddenly, Trump appointed a new person to run Operation Warp Speed. I thought, “Who’s this person?” He used to be the head of research at GlaxoSmithKline. So I went online- I’m a subscriber to *The Financial Times*- and found that they had a 2012 article saying that this man was an expert on brain-machine interface.

I thought, “Oh no!”

**Farrell:** There we go.

**Fitts:** But it’s completely out there; it’s not hidden.

**Farrell:** I agree with you on Barr and the arrest.

**Fitts:** They want to keep that person quiet. He can’t say anything; his lawyers don’t give him permission. I would love to know who his attorneys are because I doubt that they are loyal to him.

**Farrell:** I doubt it, too.

**Fitts:** In looking forward with **Culture**, we all need plenty of organ music. That’s a problem because the churches are closed. You don’t have that problem because you have Bruno (organ).

**Farrell:** I don’t have that problem.

**Fitts:** Who would have thought this would ever happen? Remember when we first talked about you getting Bruno? The idea was that you could use one of the churches. If you had found a church where you could use an organ, look where you would be now.

**Farrell:** That's the whole problem of studying organ. Any organist will tell you that getting practice time on a decent organ is the biggest problem because you are fighting committees and you are fighting choirs and you are fighting the church organist. It's like extracting teeth! That's why there are so many bad organists out there, present company included!

**Fitts:** But you are getting better.

**Farrell:** I'm getting better, yes, but it's really just 'beyond the pale'.

Part of me really thinks this, and this is going to sound bizarre, but I believe that one of the reasons that they had to shut down the churches is to limit people's exposure to some decent music.

**Fitts:** I've become convinced that the Sunday organ music service was a healing; it's an electromagnetic healing. It's necessary.

**Farrell:** Even with Bruno, I've had a few people over and played around on Bruno for them. They said, "Wow! That sounds like a real pipe organ," and it does, but I tell them, "If you really want to experience what these things do for you, you have to actually hear one in a big building."

**Fitts:** The acoustics in the cathedrals are incredible.

**Farrell:** You have to experience it because there is a real physiological effect that is like no other instrument in the world.

**Fitts:** Here is my question before we leave **Culture:** One movie that I love is *The Neverending Story*. In the *Neverending Story* they are fighting the force in the universe called The Nothing. The Nothing moves in and pulls all the life out of it; it turns it to nothing.

The Nothing is upon us, and The Nothing is trying to get you. It's what Rappoport says, "Hopelessness is an op, and it's planet-wide."

I think it's absolutely necessary that each one of us find the way that we each have to build the something – whether it's a guitar or a piano or whatever. It's a

war with The Nothing, and if you are going to defeat The Nothing, you will have to 'out' The Nothing with something. Does that make sense?

**Farrell:** That makes perfect sense. My friend Scott de Hart and his wife do these concerts around little clubs and bars in California. They, of course, had their lockdown period in 'Nutty-fornia'. They've gotten back into their live concerts. I wish I could be there because I know what the energy is going to be of people getting together only to listen to people sing and play guitar.

There is a physical aspect to music that is very important. You talk about conspiracy and breathing together – watch an orchestra! Watch the strings section.

**Fitts:** My favorite orchestra to watch – and you see them a great deal in the music we do every week – is the Vienna Philharmonic. They can create a field together. It takes my breath away what they can do together.

**Farrell:** There is absolutely nothing like a live concert; there is nothing that can replace that. It's like watching baseball on TV or going to a baseball game. There is an energy with the crowd.

**Fitts:** And don't forget the hot dogs!

**Farrell:** Yes, you know what I mean. This human contact and socialization are absolutely necessary for us to be human. Mr. Nothing moves in to shut it all down as 'nonessential'. 'Bull crap'! It's quite essential. It's who we are as human beings.

**Fitts:** Each one of us has to find our particular creation of creating something.

**Farrell:** Right.

**Fitts:** Space.

I'm going to add another question to **Space** that I didn't send you. I will talk a little more about SPACs (Special Purpose Acquisition Company).

I've ordered a whole new round of books that have come out about space and war. It's finally beginning to dawn within the think-tank world, "Oh, this is all or nothing. This is a pretty binary situation that we are facing here."

## **Story #16: Space and Non-Lethal Weapons: What Is the Winner-Take-All Question?**

Talk a bit about the binary question in space.

**Farrell:** Space is the high ground. Whoever controls that high ground controls the planet. LBJ, back in 1958 when he was still Senate Majority Leader, came right out and said, "Space is the high ground. Whoever controls that controls the game." I'm not paraphrasing.

**Fitts:** Then he gave the speech, "He who controls the weather controls everything."

**Farrell:** So, you have to do both. It is a binary game, and this is the reason I think we are on very borrowed time if space is not already heavily weaponized, which I think it is. But whoever wins the scramble for the moon and the moon base are in the 'catbird seat' because, first of all, that is a permanent satellite around this planet. They will not be able to get rid of it. So, whoever wins this race wins the 'whole shebang'.

**Fitts:** It has to be. If even the Chinese and the Iranians are wearing 'face diapers', then whoever Mr. Global is, doesn't he have that high ground now?

**Farrell:** He might, but here is the problem: Mr. Global made some deals at the end of World War II with some very nasty people who had their hands on quantities of high-tech. I have to wonder if Mr. Global is partially in a panic, precisely because that particular group is not entirely under Mr. Global's control. I really have to wonder.

**Fitts:** I think that whatever the United States or China is up to, we are not in a world run by sovereign governments. Mr. Global is meta to the world governments, and that means that meta has a military capacity which is quite stunning.

**Farrell:** I definitely think there is a non-state actor out there who is not corporate and who is not tied to any national government. I really do and I've said this all along.

**Fitts:** Are they part of what is in Antarctica?

**Farrell:** They could be. I go back to the strangeness of the people associated with Antarctica. It's the most bizarre list you could possibly imagine – Rudolf Hess, Hermann Göring, Admiral Byrd, King Juan Carlos, and John Kerry. This is a very bizarre list of people going down there for whatever reason. I have to wonder what the heck is going on down there. Who is down there that they have to see?

**Fitts:** Here is what we know: From what little information we have about activities on the moon, information we know about what is happening in the orbit around the United States, information we know about what is occurring in the underground bases in Antarctica; even if you sort this out and are unbelievably strict about which stories and bits of evidence you believe, there is something rather strange happening on this planet.

**Farrell:** Absolutely. There are actors we don't know.

**Fitts:** Where I struggle every day is whether in the financial world people are trying to do something about the pushback about the pandemic. There is an inability to realize the full picture. You can't push back and negotiate with Mr. Global unless you understand what Mr. Global is dealing with.

**Farrell:** Right, and here is the 'rub'. I get the impression that 'Mr. Globaloney' doesn't know what he is actually dealing with. He has a better idea than we do, but I don't think that he knows the full extent of it.

If there is a third or a fourth non-state, non-corporate actor on the world stage, does Mr. Global think that those actors are the full extent of it or not? I don't know. What I find very, very interesting is: We met Dr. Carol Rosin at San Mateo in 2014. I am constantly intrigued by her affidavit that she said Dr. von Braun told her when they were both working at Fairchild Industries, "First it's

communists. Then it's terrorists. Then it's nations of concern. Then it's asteroids. Then, finally, it will be E.T. This is all a plan to weaponize space."

'Lo and behold', what stage are we at now on this resume?

**Fitts:** It looks like they're building up to play the E.T. card.

**Farrell:** Yes, we are in the asteroid stage right now, and they are making all of the noises to prep us for something. So who knows?

I've said all along that 'Mr. Globaloney' is on some sort of timetable, and they are in a mad rush to get there. Much of it has to do with space. Why? I don't know. Are they waiting for someone to show up? Are they going to stage a fake invasion? Who knows?

**Fitts:** I do see real competition between Asia and the G7 when it comes to space.

**Farrell:** Absolutely. The space players are India, Japan, China, Russia, Europe, and the United States. That's basically it. It may be Brazil starting sometime, but essentially it's six players. There may be somebody else.

That is a very narrow group of people. So why the mad scramble from all of them? China and Russia want to build a lunar base by 2030. We've just announced that we are going back to the moon in 2024. I'm thinking, "With what?"

**Fitts:** I said this in 2015 when we published *Space: Here We Go* that I was convinced the reason we moved forward with globalization as quickly as we did was to create the capacity we needed to build a multiplanetary civilization, and globalization was driven by the urgency of creating human development on other planets.

**Farrell:** Or there is another possibility: It could be that it's a response to an interplanetary civilization.

**Fitts:** That is very possible.

**Farrell:** I don't know. If I had my 'druthers', I would say that it's probably a bit of both.

**Fitts:** I keep coming back to this question that I see on the financial side. What I've seen throughout my whole life is that the financial system is a harvesting system, and it is producing a dividend. The dividend is going somewhere, and I want to know where it's going. It gets back to the question of: Who owns the debt?.

We don't need central bankers to do what they do other than to maintain secrecy in the secret dividend. So it gets back to the question: Is the economy open or closed? If you look at what has been going on for the last 20 years, it looks like an open economy, not a closed economy. And is the debt owned on planet or off planet? To this day, I can't 'unpack' who owns the debt. It's a big mystery.

**Farrell:** I'm fours-square with you. Since we're off on the 'twig of speculation' here, I just saw an article that someone sent me. It left my 'jaw on the floor'. I haven't even read the article; I've only read the header.

**Fitts:** What does the header say?

**Farrell:** It says, "FM signals picked up from Jupiter's largest satellite, Ganymede": frequency modulated signals from Ganymede. And I thought, "Whoa!"

**Fitts:** We're back to the rings of Saturn problem.

**Farrell:** What did George Lucas know and when did he know it when he came up with his Death Star, which looks everything like the moon of Saturn called Iapetus.

**Fitts:** I didn't realize that.

**Farrell:** You have my book, *Cosmic War*. Look at the pictures of the Saturn moon Iapetus, and then look at the comparison picture of the Death Star. I defy

anyone to say that is a coincidence.

**Fitts:** It can't be. If you look at what world leaders are behaving like right now, it looks like people who are subject to a Death Star.

**Farrell:** I go back to what I said when the bailout hearings were taking place in 2007, and all of these bankers were in front of Congress. I kept thinking that they looked scared; they looked like someone who had a gun to their head.

**Fitts:** Exactly.

**Farrell:** So why was there no oversight of all this bailout money? Where is it really going? And why don't they want to talk about it?

**Fitts:** Between the bailouts and the missing money, we are over \$100 trillion. In 2019, it was \$35 trillion missing in one year-\$35 trillion.

I want to insert a new **Question #17** about the SPACs because, if you look at the number of space companies they've been building with venture capital privately, and now they are taking them public – What? For many years, I've said that they decided to use the money for nursing homes and take it to space. But here we are while we are watching significant deaths in the nursing homes, thus relieving the budgets, and space companies are going public with what seems to be an infinite pocketbook.

I'm going to try to do more research on it this year along with central bank digital currencies. I think that the relationship between the SPACs and space is absolutely critical.

### **Story #17: SPACs and Space: Are SPACs Just Missing an “E”?**

**Farrell:** I think so. With the number that you are talking about with these Special Purpose Acquisition Corporations (SPACs), it sounds a bit like the shotgun approach – that they are putting all of this out there and hoping that one or more of these things work. It sounds like people are in a hurry to get something done, but they don't know exactly what. So they are funding all of it.

**Fitts:** Here is the thing: What they have discovered – and I agree with them on this – is that you are much better off doing 30 fast things than the right one carefully. They are prototypers. If you look at the economics, one succeeding and 29 failing will produce better economics than slow, careful, doing the right one.

So this is their way of doing it, and the economics make total sense.

**Farrell:** It's a shotgun approach; they are in a hurry for some reason. I have to wonder why.

**Fitts:** When I was on Wall Street, whenever we invented an acronym for something, acronyms were very important. They had plenty of meaning. So, I would like to show you that everybody is referring to these SPACs as 'SPAC', but if you look at the acronym, just add an 'E' and you have 'SPACE'.

There is a new space ETF (Exchange Traded Fund) I sent you, and their ticker symbol is 'UFO'. I couldn't believe it! I fell off my chair.

**Farrell:** There is no message there, is there?

**Fitts:** It's funny because I remember I had one subscriber come back to me after we did *Space: Here We Go* and then *Who's Who and What's Up in the Space-Based Economy*. He said that his family was very critical of him. I said, "Why?"

He said, "I keep trying to give them your space reports and telling them that space is going to be a very important investment area in terms of both government and private, and it's going to be corporatized, and they just laugh at me and tell me that space is over."

Apparently space was not on people's radar, and now it's exploding.

**Farrell:** It's exploding, and there is a financial aspect to this that I keep going back to; they have quadrillions of dollars' worth of derivatives that are still 'sloshing around' on their books.

**Fitts:** It's a collateral problem.

**Farrell:** It is a collateral problem.

**Fitts:** If Planet X is real, which I don't believe, we had better grab it for the collateral.

**Farrell:** Forget about Planet X; it's all those asteroids. There are estimates that they have a value of minerals on it between \$14 and \$17 quadrillion. 'Lo and behold', that just happens to be right around the amount of money 'sloshing around' with all of those derivatives in the system!

**Fitts:** I should point out that in the *Going Direct Reset*, Rob Kirby did a big update on the derivatives.

**Farrell:** If nothing else, there is a financial reason they have to go out there. Forget about E.T.'s; forget about non-state hidden actors here on the planet. That alone should tell you that they have to go get that material.

Now, they have a bit of a problem if they suspect someone else may own it already.

**Fitts:** Oops!

**Farrell:** We might want to be building out those space weapons before we go out there and add other things.

**Fitts: Food & Health.**

### **Story #18: Is the Roll Up of Farmland and Groceries Accompanied by Growing Synthetic Food Investment?**

This is the world's easiest question to answer: There is definitely a relationship.

It's so frightening to me because I'm watching the same people who are rolling out the injections every day doing more to control the food system. It's frightening.

**Farrell:** It's frightening because you have people like Bill Gates buying up the farmland and telling us, "Oh, we are all going to eat synthetic beef."

No, I'm not.

**Fitts:** They just built a factory for insects.

**Farrell:** If I want to eat an insect, I'll eat a lobster. (That's what they are, they are underwater insects.)

If they are willing to put aborted fetal tissue in vaccines, they are willing to do it in food.

**Fitts:** Many years ago, I stopped buying hamburger. As soon as Amazon bought Whole Foods I said, "No more hamburger. I don't want to buy meat that way."

**Farrell:** I'm the same way. I do not buy ground beef at all. If I buy any of that type of meat, it's bison.

**Fitts:** I don't put anything past them in terms of what they will put in the food supply.

**Farrell:** I don't either. They could put their nano brain interfaces in the food supply. There was talk a couple of years ago – and I blogged about this – about using GMOs as vaccines. I don't trust any of these people.

**Fitts:** One of the most frightening questions yet came from a subscriber – and there is a large amount of crossover between your site and my site. I had one of the smartest subscribers write me and say, "If they have a patent on this mRNA, and they change your gene, can they organize things so that you need their permission to have a child? You are infertile without their help. And then who owns your child? If your child has that DNA, and they have the patent on that DNA, do they own your child?"

**Farrell:** I've wondered the same thing. We are already seeing stories, as I said in *Part I*, where they are detecting antigens from these antibodies in the children

of pregnant women. So, are they going to step in and assert through patent law any sort of lien or right of ownership? My answer is, “No, not with me they’re not.”

These people are wicked enough to pursue any legal angle they can to get everybody to lock down into their slavery system.

**Fitts:** There is no doubt that the dollar is the reserve currency after they shut down the gold standard and moved to an oil standard. I’ve always believed that their new financial system needed to lock down food because food would be the new oil. Every sign says that is, in fact, the case.

The food wars last year between China and the United States were frightening.

**Farrell:** They were ‘off the charts’.

**Fitts:** Yes, and the weather warfare is part of the food warfare. I think that there is also real targeting of the small farms to control them and roll them up.

The last thing that I saw this year was that the shutdown of the restaurants was partly shutting down independent producers, but partly it was what is needed to control the food supply.

**Farrell:** You shut down the restaurants, and in many cases, you are shutting down restauranteurs who go out of their way to have an independent food supply. In other words, they are not relying on the big producers.

In this respect, the other thing that I noticed when the lockdowns first occurred was I shop at a little grocery store about six miles from me that carries a lot of organic products that I use. I’m willing to pay the extra money for them.

One thing I noticed was that the first things to start disappearing from the shelves were those organic products – the eggs, the milks, the butter, and so on. There was a period of about three to four weeks where it was very difficult to get any organic products around like that.

I think there was a strike at those people as well.

**Fitts:** I also believe that people are becoming more aware that the food supply is no longer safe through the normal distribution chains, and they are getting smart about that.

**Farrell:** This particular store has a rather large organic food section in it, so there is no doubt in my mind that they are trying to push those people out of business. I think that is going to backfire.

You talk about the food supply and your experience in the Netherlands with these farmers who deliver their products right to the door. If people in this country would start connecting their farmer's markets directly to the internet and delivery systems, that is an alternative system, and they need to do it on platforms that are not under the control of the big tech companies – because the big tech companies will try to shut them down.

It can be done.

**Fitts:** It absolutely can be done. I've seen it work here.

Right after I found them, they were offering to do a crowdfund raising capital. I waited two days because I wanted to discuss with some of the other people who were using them what I should do. They shut it off because it had been so successful so fast that we couldn't invest. I said, "What?"

### **Story #19: The Injection Fraud: Is the Shriek-o-Meter Doubling Down on Public Fear? The Nursing Home Killing Fields Terrify.**

This one is tough. I've always believed that the number one goal here was to prototype downloading an operating system in our bodies. This is about the mark of the beast. But I have to tell you that starting with the flu shot in 2019, and now the COVID injections, if you look at the death rates in the nursing homes, it's off the charts, and it is impossible to explain other than through genocide.

The reason is that in government when you do something and it has an unintended consequence, you stop, you change, and you learn. They are not

stopping.

One of the things that I have to ask is: If you look at some of the scientists, most of the scientists who I trust say that most adverse reactions from the injections will come six to 18 months out. But if you look at what these injections do to our immune systems and what could come in the form of new pathogens.

Are we looking at a significant genocide?

**Farrell:** I have to entertain the possibility because we have no long-term studies of the effects of these things. That is number one. We have already seen the adverse reactions. That is number two. The real problem for me is the immune response to these vaccines. If I understand the scientists and doctors who have raised this issue in their papers or their podcasts or whatever, they are suggesting that these things could so conceivably alter the normal immune response that pathogens that are well-known already and not fatal could become so because the immune response is so depressed.

That is more frightening than anything else because it means that things we supposedly have licked like polio or smallpox or tuberculosis could come roaring back and happen so suddenly and quickly that the healthcare industry cannot respond to it fast enough. That sets up a literal genocidal scenario.

My other problem here is what I am calling the ‘zombie reactions’. Some people take these things and they have these strange neurological responses. We are only seeing the start of this.

There was a science fiction author back in 1954 who wrote the book that was made into a movie called *I am Legend* with Will Smith. I don’t know if you’ve seen that. They came out with a vaccine to cure all forms of cancer, and everybody rushes out to get this vaccine. Then suddenly, they turn out to be zombies, and they are slaughtering each other, and the human population is wiped out, and you have a few people around trying to come up with a cure.

This is what really bothers me about this whole mad rush to these stupid vaccines. We have no data – none, zero, zilch, nada – of the long-term effects of

this. We are already seeing strange neurological responses. So where is this going to be in two to three years?

**Fitts:** I have no idea.

**Farrell:** I don't either, and it frightens me. So, do I think that there is a possibility? Look at the Pfizer executive again-you have mentioned him previously. He came right out and said, "Yes, this stuff could be used to control populations." He said that.

There is another agenda in play here.

**Fitts:** Remember: He is a veterinarian, and an expert at livestock management.

**Farrell:** And we're the livestock.

The other thing that bothers me about this whole nursing home issue is that if you are 'Mr. Globaloney' and want to move society and civilization away from any mooring that it has in its tradition, the first thing that you have to do is kill the history. So, you kill the old people who remember the history. Look at what else they are trying to do with history right now.

**Fitts:** Not only do you kill the people with the most historical knowledge, but you also kill the people who refuse to digitize. So if you want to go to full-on digital, you have to get rid of the people who won't use crypto.

**Farrell:** We are dealing with stacked functions here.

**Fitts:** I grew up remembering in school having these discussions on: How could the people sit by and let this genocide or that genocide happen? Here we are again watching elderly being culled and killed in the nursing homes in this process. The question is: What do we do?

Part of the challenge is that we have a huge part of the population that is pretending that it's not happening.

**Farrell:** I don't even know that they are pretending. They may not realize the

extent of it because the major 'propertainment media' is not reporting it.

**Fitts:** I get back to this: Why would anybody listen to any of that?

**Farrell:** I grant you that, but the plain fact of the matter is that people still rely on CNN and 'faux news' and CBS (or see-B.S., as I like to call it).

**Fitts:** My favorite CNN shot this quarter was Chris Cuomo's face. He was interviewing a scientist about the lockdowns. She said, "But if we let people out, then how will we get them to take the injection?"

It's like, "Let's not be subtle, shall we?"

One thing that I pointed out in the first quarter to everyone was that they are putting out contracts for manufacturing distribution capacity for as many as one a month. So, that would be 330 million injections a month. Now we're starting to see people come out and say, "Well, you need to get refreshed once a year or once every two years or twice a year." It's 'all over the map', but they are playing that game.

If you look at what the material-adverse events we are watching from only one or two injections, what happens when people take one a month?

**Farrell:** Exactly. It's a gruesome scenario, but my speculation is that they have done something to make injections necessary to live.

**Fitts:** If you wipe out somebody's immune system, then you can say, "If you want to keep up your immune system, you need these injections."

One of the subscribers sent in a video recently of a wonderful pathologist in Idaho or Iowa giving a presentation, and one of the things he made very clear was, "You don't want to get sick during this time. You don't want to get COVID-19. Make sure you have plenty of vitamin D. Go out and run around in the sun. If you have to supplement during the winter, then do so."

It's comical because we all have sunlamps here. What a difference during the winter because it's so gray.

## **Story #20: The Pandemic Heroes Stand Up to the Great Poisoning and Engineering of Societal Submission.**

This is the thing that really ‘rocked’ my world last year. In the *Injection Fraud Wrap Up*, we did a section called ‘*The Solari Pandemic Heroes*’, and chose the people in medicine, science, law, and journalism who were just amazing heroes. It was very inspiring after we put together that section. It was a considerable amount of work because we had to get bios and permissions, etc.

We realized that if you look at what these people did, they were fearless; they risked their lives, their reputation, their career, and their income. They risked everything, but they did it without any hesitation and without any equivocation. ‘Balls to the walls’ is the way that we used to describe it on the street.

If you look at the difference they made, you realize that these 50-60 people changed the world.

**Farrell:** And think of the lives that were saved. Think of that gynecologist-I forget her name, but she was in Texas. She was interviewed by some ‘propatainment’ media reporter who asked her why she didn’t recommend vaccinations and why she was treating people with zinc and hydroxychloroquine and so on. Her response was, “I’m a doctor. I took an oath. Why would I endanger my patients with make-believe, experimental stuff when I know that this works?”

**Fitts:** My favorite one was Stella Immanuel. A Houston TV station interviewed her.

**Farrell:** She is the one I was thinking of.

**Fitts:** They sent a CNN hitman-type, and he was threatening her. He said, “You could lose your license.”

She leaned into him – she is also a pastor – and smiled. She grew up in Africa, so she knew how to deal with real bullies. She said, “How many people should I let die so I can keep my license?”

He backed up. He got afraid because he realized that that game is a two-way street.

**Farrell:** There is another aspect of this story that I think is critical to mention and bring back to people's memory and recollection. Have you noticed that since the COVID plan/scamdemic, that the amount of holistic doctor deaths and suicides has declined dramatically in the number of stories?

I have to wonder: Was that part of the preparation for this whole plan/scamdemic?

**Fitts:** I'm sure it was. And remember the deaths of all the microbiologists?

**Farrell:** I do.

**Fitts:** That was going into the anthrax game and the anthrax vaccination. Interestingly enough, it's that old anthrax player, Emergent BioSolutions, who was hired by AstraZeneca to be their manufacturer in the U.S. So the anthrax 'boys are back'.

**Farrell:** The anthrax 'boys are back', and then we have the Johnson & Johnson story where they have recalled millions of vaccines because of wrong ingredients.

**Fitts:** I want to know what was in that vaccination because I don't think it was wrongful.

**Farrell:** I'm with you; I don't think so either. I think that is a cover story of some sort. They are backpedaling, and there has to be a reason.

**Fitts:** Interestingly enough, I was amazed because when I reviewed the stock charts for the first quarter, the U.S. banks were up 25%, and big pharma and biotech weren't up that much despite the fact that the U.S. government has poured money into them like an 'empty hole'. They've just been pouring it in.

That tells me that if it wasn't for this injection game, what would have

happened?

**Farrell:** I have to wonder the same thing. The other part of this equation is that you have all these crazy QAnon people saying, “Trump is coming back on April 17<sup>th</sup>.” God bless them, but the problem is that when these vaccines really start hitting with the adverse effects, ‘we ain’t seen nothing yet’. I could be wrong, and I hope I’m wrong.

**Fitts:** Let’s talk money for a moment. If you look at what vaccine injury does to family economics, we are talking about something that will bankrupt the society.

**Farrell:** It’s not only that, but it is going to bankrupt a few political careers, too. Let’s remember Operation Warp Speed wasn’t Joseph Biden’s operation; it was Trump.

I try to remind people about that, and it’s falling on deaf ears. I hope I’m wrong with the adverse reaction issue and projections that are months or years down the line, but I get this feeling that ‘we ain’t seen nothing yet’.

The other problem is if they come up with these ‘updates’ and booster shots and so on with an untried experimental vaccine with more experimental updates, what is that going to do to the population?

**Fitts:** We didn’t talk about QAnon, but we shouldn’t leave the first quarter without mentioning it. The whole phenomenon just keeps getting stranger.

I’m particularly worried that there is a real effort to pass a domestic terrorism bill that will enable them to target and confiscate the assets of people like me.

I had one of our attorneys write a piece about confiscation of property. If you make it easy for them to do seizures of people who are speaking up, it’s all part of censorship. So, I see them working up to that.

After the Administration changed, we saw a great deal of information come out to indicate that it may have been, among other things, a U.S. intelligence and enforcement operation to get people into the domestic terrorism trap. I think

that is a reasonable possibility.

**Farrell:** I do, too. You remember that I said right from the beginning with the whole QAnon thing that this was an op; it was an operation that required the use of heavy computing power, and some very sophisticated search engines.

**Fitts:** And simulation. I think they had some very sophisticated simulations and feedback loops with the surveillance. That means the NSA or an intelligence agency.

I thought of it as primarily hope porn that would get people to be passive and stay on the couch.

**Farrell:** That was absolutely one objective.

**Fitts:** But I didn't think that it was a trap for domestic terrorism targeting.

**Farrell:** No, it's stacked operations once again. At some point, the bottom line is that these people will have to have camps where they put people like us, and then people will start noticing. That is where they are headed, but that doesn't work. It hasn't worked at any time in history, and it's not going to work now.

**Fitts:** Gun sales and applications for licenses have been skyrocketing.

**Farrell:** That is because you have the Congress talking about more gun legislation.

**Fitts:** I have to tell you that we did an interview with John Harris, who is the president of the Tennessee Firearms Association. It was the Tennessee Firearms Association that was instrumental in persuading me to stay in Tennessee.

According to U-Haul, in 2020, the number one drop-off point for one-way trips was Nashville, Tennessee. Everybody is moving to Tennessee. I said to John, "You know, every realtor in the state should send you a thank you note."

**Farrell:** Missouri already passed a nullification law six or seven months ago. If the Federal government passes any sort of 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment gun grab, no state

official is authorized to help the Federal government do it.

**Fitts:** Yes, but what this will come down to is this: Is Missouri going to allow JP Morgan Chase to be their lead correspondent banker? In other words, they have to start pulling the corporate charters on the bad banks and get them out of their bank accounts and out of their asset management and get them out of their pension funds and their business. That is what this is going to come down to.

So you can pass all the laws that you want, but if you won't deal with the money and the currency, you're not going to make it. That's a fact.

One book that had a tremendous impact on me was the finance person in Grease during austerity, Yanis Varoufakis. He wrote a book called *Adults in the Room*, and he described getting in there and getting ready to try to 'hardball' the EU in the negotiations by reissuing their own currency. He discovered that all the IT systems and payment systems in the tax collection and other parts of the government were under the control of private corporations who reported to the banks, not the sovereign government. They had no way of replacing those systems overnight. It would take so long, and in the meantime, he was 'booted out'.

So, you have to clean these things out of the systems.

**Farrell:** You have to clean these things out of the systems and pursue all avenues to do so.

**Fitts:** Are you ready for **Unanswered Questions**?

**Farrell:** I'm as ready as I'm ever going to be. This is quite a list!

**Fitts:** We don't have to hang to on any of them. You and I have gone through the **Unanswered Questions** before. I think I've added about five, but I want to go through it because we have a fair number of new subscribers, and they are still digesting the framework and the particulars. So I think that the ones we've done many times before, we can go quickly through, with one exception, and that is '**Who is Mr. Global?**' This is the thing that really baffles people, and it

still baffles me.

Let's just dive in:

### **Question #1: Mind Control.**

I must tell you that I think our number one obstacle here is mind control. I think that this is a huge part of the puzzle.

How do we keep our minds free of mind control technologies? How do we help others understand that such technologies exist and are manipulating, addicting, and influencing us? What is the relationship between mind control and reducing millions of people to poverty and death through the pandemic? Is this why people cannot see that the pandemic is a governance and monetary event? Are people who are dependent on government subsidies more susceptible to mind control? How does the QAnon op and other fear and hope porn fit in?

**Farrell:** That's a 'tall order'.

**Fitts:** For 25 years, I have struggled with trying to explain how important the high-tech mind control is. The thing that really got me focused on this was investment advisory. When you deal with people who are very concerned about financial security, and as a result of entrainment technology, they are doing completely irrational things that have a 100% chance of losing their money, and you see this, you realize that this is extremely bad.

More importantly, if you go throughout history, certain habits that lead to financial success. This is causing addictions that cause us to behave in ways that don't lead to financial success. You are talking about societal failure through bad habits, and these are habits that lead to control files. On and on it goes. I talk much about pornography being used to get control files.

One of the great stories from 2019 that I just discovered and reviewed in *Money & Markets* is about someone in Congress putting in legislation to allow them to clean out the DOD pornography usages. If you look at what they were saying, it appeared like all the different people who they used pornography on to help them move the money – to get low-cost control files and move the money –

those networks are being cleaned out and closed down.

I think that pornography was a huge part of getting the missing money outside of government. It's a for-profit way of getting massive numbers of control files on people. All you do is get them hooked, and then you lead them into child pornography, and suddenly, you have them on a felony.

I feel as though trying to communicate this, I can hear my grandmother's voice say, "It's a taffy pull."

**Farrell:** That is a good word for it!

I think that part of the problem that many people still have is they simply cannot fathom that this technology is very real and that it does exist. If you are one of those people, I am going to make a plug for my book here: Get my book on Lulu called *Microcosm and Medium*.

**Fitts:** It's excellent.

**Farrell:** Thank you. I go into all the technologies, including the technologies we don't think of that are mind manipulation technologies.

**Fitts:** You have the high-tech mind control information, but it is being added to what they are doing with education, with art, with these deeper, longer-term forms of mind manipulation.

**Farrell:** Right, and people have to understand that. There is good mind manipulation, and then there is bad mind manipulation, depending on what you expose yourself to. Turn off the 'dang idiot box'. If you must watch news, at least try to supplement that with some equal time for alternative news sources.

The other thing – for those who are not religious in the audience I apologize here – is I am going to recommend once again that you pray. I have a certain prayer that I always pray; it's a prayer for protection. "In all of my comings and goings and dealings, protect me from all harm to body and soul from any source, quarter, reason, accident, ailment, affliction, evil spell, spirit, intention, person, use of technology, or government policy, natural or manmade disaster."

That covers it.

I think it's very important for people to understand that technology needs to be on any list like that as well as government policy. In other words, it's time to get down to 'brass tacks'. There is an old saying by St. Vincent of Lérins, and I've mentioned him before. He is a 4<sup>th</sup> century Western Saint. "Lex orandi et lex credenda est," or, "Law of prayer is law of belief." What you pray is what you really believe. People need to latch onto that.

He was saying it in a very different context than what I am using it for, but I do think there is a spiritual component to all of this and that 'Mr. Globaloney' thinks it's all about technology. It isn't; it's about the human soul. So start protecting it.

**Fitts:** It's under attack.

**Farrell:** It's under attack everywhere.

**Fitts:** The prayer I most use is *The Deer's Cry*, but it's also a prayer of protection in a war or a life-threatening situation.

**Farrell:** Right, *The Breastplate of St. Patrick* is another one. It's important. If nothing else, even if you're not the praying sort, or if you are an atheist or an agnostic, what it does when you vocalize and make things that explicit is it gets your mind focused.

**Fitts:** Right, but it also invites in help.

'Once upon a time'. I had a client who was a devoted atheist and a devoted hyper-materialist. They were a lovely person, but that was their bent on life. They got themselves into real trouble with litigation – serious trouble.

We have a prayer book that includes a copy of *The Deer's Cry*. So I sent it to her and said, "Here is what I want you to do: I don't want you to believe in it, I don't want you to trust it, and I don't want you to like it. I just want you to pray it three times a day for two weeks."

She called me back in two weeks and said, “Oh my God! This works!”

You know how the coaches in the gym will tell you, “Just do the weights. You don’t have to believe in it; just do it?”

**Farrell:** Just do it, it works.

As far as government subsidies go, to the extent that you are able to, get off that handout.

**Fitts:** Franklin Sanders said, “All government money comes with a sock in the face.”

**Question #2: Invisible Weaponry.** How important are invisible and secret weaponry and technology to the replacement of global currency systems with crypto control systems?

**Farrell:** Hugely.

**Fitts:** I think that many of the people fighting with the government don’t understand what their government is dealing with in terms of invisible weaponry.

**Farrell:** Yes, and one reason there is a direct connection – and people really have to ‘latch their heads’ around this one – has to deal with computing power. If you recall, when President Reagan announced his strategic defense initiative, or Star Wars, one of the first criticisms that was made of it was, “We don’t have the computing power to deal with these types of systems.” So, they had invent the computing power to make the weapons that they were planning to put online work.

So there is a direct connection. All of this massive computing power that we have now is coming from that whole venue.

**Fitts:** If you look at the COVID-19 injection article by O’Hagan, he points out this interview with a Microsoft techie about how they can load data onto a single cell. Then, of course, there is this new Microsoft patent, which is

essentially using the human body for computing power. So, you almost wonder if eight billion people who have dumped to the cloud can be part of providing the ‘juice’ for the crypto and all these different computing power needs.

**Farrell:** Not only that, but I think that ultimately, the game here is they are engaged in a huge physics experiment to see if a group observer effect can have a cosmological or consequential effect in the big world, not only the small world.

**Fitts:** Do you believe that this is part of what CERN (European Council for Nuclear Research) is about?

**Farrell:** I believe absolutely that this is part of what CERN is about.

**Fitts:** That is one of the **Unanswered Questions:** What in the world is CERN about?

**Question #3: Invisible Technology.** How are invisible technologies being used to engineer civil wars, turn people against each other, and engage in disaster capitalism?

**Farrell:** Personally, I don’t know about you, but I think that it’s a possibility. Their method has been to divide and conquer all along. The problem here is that is always a risky, risky proposition if you don’t control everything down to the last detail. As of yet, they don’t.

I think that their policies – as we have discussed throughout *Parts I* and *II* – are creating backlash at the ground level. It’s that they are in a mad rush to head off.

**Fitts:** Think about it: They have tried every divide and conquer in the book, and now they are saying, “Okay, six feet apart everybody.” It’s the ultimate divide.

I think there is some relationship between the average size of our aura during the day and six feet. It’s almost like my aura goes three feet, and yours goes three feet. So, six feet is enough to keep them from getting connected.

**Question #4: Missing Money.** There is more in 2017-2018, but we haven't had time to look at it. Only adding the \$35 trillion from the missing money in 2019, we are now up to \$56 trillion.

The shocking thing about this is that even with FASAB 56, they are still having undocumentable adjustments, and they are still not passing audits. This suggests to me a system which is quite out of control.

So where did Mr. Global invest the \$56 trillion (DOD and HUD), the \$24 to \$29 trillion on bailouts, and the QE (Quantitative easing), and where is Going Direct central bank and fiscal stimulus going? So, we are well over \$100 trillion here.

**Farrell:** I'm going to throw a 'curveball' here because the way that the question is posed is suggesting that 'Mr. Globaloney' knows where all of it is going. I strongly suspect that they know where much of it is going, but I suspect that there is a little 'skimming mechanism' in place that someone else – maybe a non-state actor, who knows? – is skimming every single financial transaction that they can. Maybe they are using floats or whatever; the old banking practice of using floats to do this.

I suspect that plenty of it is bleeding out of their system, and that this may be one of the reasons they are trying to get everything clamped down in a digital framework.

**Fitts:** You also may have multiple factions who are all stealing, and one can't shut down the other without shutting down their own stealing. The thing has literally gotten out of control.

**Farrell:** Exactly. I strongly suspect that. Their hidden system of finance has come back to 'bite' them.

**Fitts:** If you look at how hard it is to run a 'tight ship', even with total transparency and complete audits, it is still hard to do. Imagine what a mess this can turn into, especially when you have a military where you are not trying to be economical because you need to buy everybody up.

So, you are just printing money and buying everybody up. Talk about lack of productivity! It's a mess.

The follow-up of **Question #4** is: Cui bono (who stands to profit) Covid-19? How does this relate to the financing and reinvestment of the hedge funds, private equity firms, SPACS (Special Purpose Acquisition Company), and corporate buybacks?

Basically, what I see are the private equity firms and the asset managers – the SPACs and the hedge funds. They are all being infused with massive money, and they are running around the planet and buying everything. It's like a global shopping spree. It looks like free money to me. The question is: Is it coming out of DOD and HUD?

**Farrell:** Let's go back to something that you said at the two Secret Space Program conferences. Let's factor in this idea that there are massive amounts of skimming taking place in transactions. If that is the case, then the hedge fund managers and the SPACs, and so on don't know the whole picture. So, they are dealing with 50% of the picture – pick a percentage – and they are formulating policies and doing risk assessments and investment portfolios, and speculative analyses based on an incomplete picture. So that adds to the mess; that creates more confusion.

In other words, what I am suggesting – and I think that you are partially in agreement with this – is that 'Mr. Globaloney' is working this massive, elaborate plan, and he doesn't have the full picture.

**Fitts:** Right. I remember when the money started to disappear from HUD. Suddenly, the Clinton Foundation was capitalized. Suddenly, Epstein was capitalized. But suddenly, money was 'rolling like a river' into Carlisle, who had no record. They were a new Washington start-up without much investment experience. Suddenly, billions are flowing into them, and everybody was asking, "Where did they get that money?"

It was suspicious because they hired several old Dillon Read people. I was at Hamilton dealing with subpoenas and was in the middle of this war. We had just gotten kicked out of HUD, which is what they needed to do if they are going to

start stealing all this money. The money started going, and it was flowing into Carlisle. A person who they hired from Dillon Read to help with the China fund – they had this huge China fund money rolling in, and they were going to move the money to Asia – came to Hamilton to check out what I was up to and whether I've figured out the game or not.

That is exactly when Jay Powell, the current Chairman of the Federal Reserve, went to Carlisle. That is how he made his fortune.

My theory is that Nick Brady, who used to be the Secretary of the Treasury, put him there because they didn't quite trust the Carlisle people. Brady wanted one of his own persons watching.

So we are watching this money pour out again, and Powell made his fortune at the beginning of the financial coup. So, he is there at the Federal Reserve consolidating the financial coup, and you wonder what he's thinking.

It looks and feels right now like we are in a pump in all these different markets – equities and crypto – and it feels just like the pump back in 1998.

**Farrell:** Yes, and they don't have the full picture.

**Fitts:** No, nobody does. I shouldn't say 'nobody' because I think there are people who have the full picture. Remember how you noted in *Part I* the flash crash in the Treasury market? My attorney and I, in 2001, wrote an extensive piece called *Caveat Emptor* that described the issues of real serious credit problems in the Treasury market. What is a Treasury security?

If you lever up the sovereign governments and then send the money out to a separate entity, the asset that you just financed is not in that legal entity; the debt is, but not the asset. If this entity is all liabilities and none of those assets, and it is subject to a real coup, what is your credit?

I think you have smart money all around the world trying to figure out how they get out of fiat-denominated assets into real assets. That is part of why we are seeing the inflation engineered through the balance sheet here.

**Farrell:** There is another factor that I mentioned in the last quarter, but I still think they may be operating here. I mentioned what I am calling ‘cantorian economics’. These are cantor numbers; those transfinite numbers that are not commutative in functions. In other words, A times B with a cantor number is not B times A; it’s the order of the functions themselves that determine the result.

I think there is every possibility that they have passed some inflection point that standard economic and financial theory just can’t handle, as crazy and ‘wacky’ as that sounds.

They are faced with this question of: How do we get out of this?

**Fitts:** When you are this far ahead of your collateral and you have no place to go but to make it worse, this is what you do.

**Question #5: Reality TV & Paid Protestors.** ‘Who and What’ do you think the command structure for the Antifa/BLM/Trump armies and related covert operations look like? How does it relate to reinvestment in real estate and building out of the smart grids? How does it relate to Opportunity Zones? How does it relate to narcotics trafficking gangs and networks? How does it relate to military and intelligence capacity and corporate contractors and mercenaries? How are the patterns similar to The Phoenix Program (U.S. CIA program during the Vietnam War) and COINTELPRO (Counter Intelligence Program)? What is the relationship to the DOD and CIA cloud contractors and the fusion centers? How does this relate to the push to create ‘domestic terrorists’? How does this relate to the push for additional laws and regulations related to mental health or guns?

**Fitts:** You can go into certain places in America, and it’s like being in Disneyland; there are more downstairs people than there are upstairs people. There are more engineers running the system than there are people walking around. There are more Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse operations than there are people.

If you look at real people just trying to lead their lives or get their work done, they are so overrun with ops.

We just published an article by a correspondent who has gone to several rallies for us and covered them. She is describing it as: First, the Antifa people show up, and they are clearly paid. Then the BLM people show up, and they are clearly paid. They had one person who was naked from the waist up and another with black face or white face – I forget which one.

She asked the white face one, “How much are you being paid?” and they barked back, “Not enough!” So, they are angry that they are not properly being paid for their acting talent.

Then the Trump people showed up, and they were clearly paid protestors. Then an anti-Asian hate thing happened, and that was clearly engineered. Suddenly, there are more people being paid to make a mess than there are people trying to rally.

Of course, it breaks and destroys the field because you are so overrun with reality TV shows that you can't have a communication.

**Farrell:** I think there is possibly something else is going on. This is another one of my ‘wacky’ speculations off the ‘end of the twig’.

You and I have discussed the fact that as ‘Mr. Globaloney’ gets closer to the end game, the more intense the infighting becomes. So I think what we are seeing, and you've mentioned this many times, is the creation of privatized armies for each little faction.

Part of the game there is everybody who is into finance makes money off wars. So, another money maker for them is to create as much of that kind of activity as they can. The problem is that they don't have total and complete control over it.

I go back to Wall Street setting up the Bolsheviks, Roosevelt, and Hitler. When they set up Hitler, they put their money on the wrong person because he was not going to ‘play ball’ with them, and he didn't. They are in this position now. They are creating all of these private armies, and that is also part of this war card that we've seen and talked about. So we are in a mafia war.

**Fitts:** Junious Ricardo Stanton was on *The Solari Report* a couple of weeks ago, and he pointed out that in the BLM tax return, they ended up the year with a balance of \$60 or \$80 million.

Can you imagine being a shareholder of one of these corporations that is putting massive amounts of money to them? I would show up at one of the annual meetings.

**Farrell:** You and I can't start a paramilitary and get massive amounts of donations.

**Fitts:** The scary one – and I wrote about this in *The Injection Fraud* – was there was a subscriber who was at a protest. The Antifa people showed up, and started attacking a person who was just standing there. Our subscriber was very curious about what was happening. He talked to the Antifa people, and they said, “He gave a Heil Hitler salute,” and he hadn't, but they were absolutely adamant that he had.

You're in this Pokémon reality where people can see things that don't happen.

**Farrell:** Again, that might be mind control.

**Fitts:** I'm sure it is; I'm sure that it's mind control.

**Farrell:** They are seeing things they have been 'encouraged' to see. COINTELPRO is right up that alley.

**Fitts:** If you're not familiar with the words 'Phoenix Program' and COINTELPRO, look them up and read them.

**Question #6: FASAB 56.** How important is FASAB 56 to what is happening? How important is the increased secrecy for the central bank members and shareholders and other major investors? How does this relate to the recent updates on the Missing Money? How does it relate to the cash pouring into SPACs?

**Farrell:** All of the above; it is hugely important. Here is another problem: They are taking everything black. So how do they transact with each other? Ultimately, they can't.

**Fitts:** This is why I think they will have the secret train tracks, and then they are going to have the retail train tracks. The wholesale and the retail systems are going to be very, very different.

**Farrell:** They will be very different, and the wholesale system is going to be good, old-fashioned, analog because that is the only way to be secure and confident that who you are dealing with is on the 'up and up'.

**Fitts:** If it's going to be analog, you need places where you can keep analog records. That is why I think it will be underground.

**Farrell:** It's going to be underground or on the moon.

**Fitts:** Yes, but you won't make it 100% in the suborbital platform.

We did another space update in the first quarter on space law, and it was a special report. I'm convinced that the new offshore tax havens are up there – all free from tax.

**Question #7: Poisoning of Populations.** Why is there a great poisoning underway in multiple areas? Why is there an ongoing global program to increase the levels of aluminum, other heavy metals, and nanoparticles or nanotechnology in humans? Is the push for Neuralink because humans will be more intelligent accessing AI and easier to control and integrate with robots, or because the elites want and need access to uniquely human intelligence and consciousness?

**Farrell:** I don't know about you, but my guess is that 'Mr. Globaloney' may not need access to human intelligence and consciousness, but somebody else sure does. The aluminum levels always makes me wonder.

**Fitts:** It's been going on for 100 years.

**Farrell:** Yes, it has. Aluminum is directly linked to Alzheimer's, it's directly linked to foggy thinking, and, oddly enough, if you investigate the Soviet-era highly classified research that Nikolai Kozyrev and his people did, aluminum was the only thing they found that could blot out torsion or scalar fields. It's like a Faraday cage (blocks electromagnetic fields) to that metal.

So, I have to wonder what is really going on here with all the aluminum that they are trying to put into people. Are they trying to create neurological dysfunction? What is going on there? That is a huge question mark for me, and I'm glad that you mentioned it.

**Fitts:** This started with the vaccinations over a century ago.

**Farrell:** Yes, and I've known people that I grew up with who cooked in aluminum cookware, and they ended up with Alzheimer's and all other sorts of problems when they were older. So I have to wonder.

I've never liked or used aluminum for cooking, but there is something going on there. I think it has something to do with the human intellect. What, I don't know.

**Fitts: Question #8: Genocide.** The nursing home patterns since March 2020 clearly indicate a genocide is underway. Consequently, we have to ask the question: To what extent are the COVID-19 injections about installing a smart grid compatible OS into our bodies for the Going Direct Reset and related surveillance, mind control, and travel control, versus depopulation through lowering life expectancies or controlled fertility or infertility? If biotech companies own the patent on modified DNA resulting from an injection, will they then own us and or our children?

We talked about this earlier.

**Farrell:** I don't know. I've speculated ever since the GMO business and their patent ownership of GMOs came out that this may be one of the things they are after – a patent right lien on human beings. I think that it is all related, particularly with fertility.

You study the GMO literature and the fertility rates and so on, and now with pregnant women having these adverse reactions to the COVID vaccine, they are up to something. It's all about controlling humanity – reproduction, thoughts, and everything.

**Fitts: Question #9: High-tech Risks.** What are the extreme risks generated by new technology: mRNA gene therapy, high-tech fires, the push for immortality, DNA editing, 5G and mind control and assassinations, and the interbreeding of humans with other species? What else? What should we do to learn more about weather warfare, interdimensionality, time travel, and geophysical risks? Could we get an Operation Bluebeam (New World Order) in 2021? Do we have the capacity to create our own telepathic portals for global travel?

Which one of these keeps you up at night?

**Farrell:** Out of that list, what keeps me up is the possibility of a Bluebeam-like false flag. There are so many ways that that can be exploited.

**Fitts:** They have the hologram technology.

**Farrell:** Remember the Pope on the balcony (He disappeared)?

That does keep me up because in my book, *Saucers, Swastikas, and Psyops*, I pointed out that one of the things that some of the Nazis were talking about was using high-tech for a form of psychological warfare. They could spin that so many different ways – false flag, E.T. invasions, second comings, and all sorts of ways. And in that kind of operation, you want to make sure that if you try something that gigantic of a lie, you want to make sure that you have enough social engineering in place to make it work. So what do you do? You create a plan/'scamdemic' and get everybody to buy the narrative.

So far, that part of it has been fairly successful. So in that list, that is the one that scares me. What scares you?

**Fitts:** I think it's the mind control that scares me. I'm afraid that the human race will not be able to rise to the challenge because they are too mind-

controlled. My concern is that the injections are going to disconnect them from life. It will disconnect them from God, and it's going to disconnect them from the divine intelligence.

I believe that we have the power to access all of the intelligence in the universe through time and space. To a certain extent, we've lost it, but we can get it back. If we do something that physically shuts down that ability permanently, then you are talking about becoming just like a natural resource. You're letting go of your divinity.

**Farrell:** That is an important point because it highlights the importance of language. People have to understand that one key method of mind control is to have people get on board linguistic agendas. "Use this term, not that term."

I think the biggest sign – and I've mentioned this many times – was in the 1970's and 1980's when they changed corporate departments of personnel to 'human resources'. That was an enormous clue, but everybody just shrugged it off.

Pay attention to the language they use and pay attention to the language you use, and make 'awful darn sure' that the language you use is not following the dictates of a Nancy Pelosi or whomever.

**Fitts:** Here is what I would say: If we have a clear mind and a good map, amazing things are possible. If we can't get a clear mind and a good map, then we can't access the intelligence we need to preserve and grow a human civilization. If we don't have a human civilization, that's it; it's over.

I don't think there is as high-risk issue in the world that we can't deal with if we have a clear mind and a good map.

I absolutely believe that interdimensional intelligence is in play, but I've seen many stories or indications or symptoms that time travel is happening. I don't know that. If I had to guess, I would say, "Yes, it's happening." But I have to ask you: Do you think that time travel is happening?

**Farrell:** Every standard physics theory would say that it would be extremely

difficult. More recently, there are serious papers being published that are questioning the whole time-paradox logic that has been in place ever since Einstein's relativity theory. That is one question.

Do I think that it is happening? I will put it this way: There are so many strange things out there. I think of one example in particular: This strange novel that was published about 100 years ago about a boy named Baron Trump. Where is that coming from? Something is in the ether, and people are latching onto it.

I think there is a time aspect to human consciousness that we do not fully understand, and that we can tap into things. Just look at the remote viewing program – future or past – that we can tap into with accuracy. That means that your consciousness is not locked up inside your skull; it's a nonlocal phenomenon.

**Fitts:** It's shared.

**Farrell:** It's out there.

**Fitts:** Right, but I think that the injections are trying to turn it into a local phenomenon.

**Farrell:** I think the injections may be trying to cut it off altogether. It's part of that transcendence. Human personhood and individuality are ultimately, I think, a very nonlocal thing. Please don't misunderstand me here. I'm not subscribing to any idea that you lose yourself or your individuality and merge with 'the one'. No, I'm not talking about that.

**Fitts:** No, you are talking about inalienable rights.

**Farrell:** Yes, I am talking about that aspect of things also, but I think in that sense, there is something about time that makes time travel possible – at least at a consciousness level – that we really haven't 'wrapped ourselves around'. Let me be very clear: I'm not suggesting that I believe in reincarnation or any of that either. I think that's an extremely misunderstood phenomenon.

I think that something very, very weird is going on. There is a kind of retro-

causation that is possible, if I can put it that way.

**Fitts:** I think the human race does not yet understand time.

**Farrell:** No, it doesn't.

**Fitts: Question #10: China & the Quad.** Will India start a war with Pakistan? When will China invade Taiwan? Will the U.S. and China go to war, or separate the Internet and financial markets? Are China and the U.S. pitted in a win-lose position in the orbital platform and space race? What about Russia? How far might other countries' conquests go once it becomes clear that the U.S. will no longer play global cop? What is the emergence of the Quad?

**Farrell:** Personally, I think they have concluded that the U.S. is no longer strong enough to play global cop. God help us if we get this 'woke (slang for social awareness), politically correct' U.S. American military involved in an actual shooting war with Russia or China.

**Fitts:** They will lose.

**Farrell:** They will lose hands down. And if they think otherwise, then they are truly and genuinely not only infants, but they are 'nutty' infants.

The Quad, as you know, I have my own version of it. For the political pundits and the think tank people, the Quad is the United States, Japan, Australia, and India; that is the Quad. In other words, it is all of the Pacific powers ganging up against China.

For me, the Quad is something very, very different. I call it the 'Quadruple Entente'. I think that everybody knows that China is the long-term biggest potential player, and therefore, the long-term biggest potential threat. So, that means that in spite of what Russia and China might say about each other in the long term, their interests diverge. That means that Russia is the really weird player in that Chinese-Russian alliance.

Russia has the technology, and Russia has the resources, but it doesn't have the economy.

**Fitts:** But it has the land mass; it umbrellas Europe and China. It has the Northern extension of the Silk Road.

**Farrell:** So you see Russia doing strange things, like making all these overtures to Japan, making all these arms deals with India, while at the same time talking about its wonderful alliance with China. If you are selling large amounts of sophisticated equipment to India that you are not willing to sell to China, that should tell you something about where Russia stands.

**Fitts:** Given the demographic problems, if you are Russia, why don't you turn around and say to every young European person who has been reamed by austerity – or certainly the Germans – “Come to Russia, and we will stake you 40 acres and a mule”?

**Farrell:** Well, they have; they quite literally have done that. Russia has its own kind of Homestead Act and has made overtures to South African farmers.

It's not something that I've seen Russia push, but I expect they will, particularly now that we are trying to get this proxy war started with Ukraine. Europe is not going to go along with that. I'm sorry, but they won't. Maybe Poland will, but I just don't see France or Germany or Italy going along with that – not for a minute.

**Fitts:** One question that I have is: How long can Taiwan stay out of the One-China policy?

**Farrell:** The answer is: As long as Taiwan gets smart and realizes that it cannot depend on the United States to defend it.

**Fitts:** So will Japan and the Quad help it stay out?

**Farrell:** I guess that you will look for Taiwan and Japan to start talking seriously.

**Fitts:** Oh, I'm sure they are now.

**Farrell:** I'm sure they are, too. You've already seen the Japanese and the Indians ink a military logistical assistance deal bilaterally. I talked about this the last time. The United States is not even in the 'mix'; it's Japan and India.

**Fitts:** Japan is the engineering juggernaut still in Asia.

**Farrell:** Yes, it still is, and they are re-arming. Expect more of that.

**Fitts: Question #11: Reengineering of the U.S. Government.** How will the U.S. government and central bank be reengineered after FASAB 56, the 2020 ops, and election, and after the JEDI contract is fully in place? Is the Plunge Protection Team being reengineered or privatized? How critical is the use of major clouds for economic warfare to the takeover of business and market share by private equity firms?

This is a question that I would love to have a clear picture of, and I don't yet.

So, you have the Amazon cloud at the intelligence agencies, and now you have the JEDI cloud. And with the central banks moving and taking over the executive branch, there is no reason. You can reengineer all of the payment systems, and basically you can let go of 90% of the bureaucracy if you wanted to reengineer this through the cloud.

I'm not saying that is what they are going to do, but we are looking at a government which is completely run and controlled by banks and corporations. There are no government bureaucracies that have any power unless the banks need a front man.

**Farrell:** They have a golden opportunity to spin this in playing to the complaint that we 'deplorables' out here have been complaining about for decades, and that is the growth and size of the Federal government.

If they play to that and then do their AI and robots and all of that, and say, "See, we are downsizing the cost of the government and downsizing the size of the Federal government," they might be able to pull it off. The question that I have is: Are the state governments going to wake up in time and start pulling – as you suggested earlier – their banks of account away from the major banks?

**Fitts:** They have to decentralize money creation and equity markets.

**Farrell:** Texas took a huge step with the bullion depository and Governor Abbot talking about moving the NASDAQ data center to Dallas. That was a huge clue that if nothing else, whoever is running that state behind the scenes knows what the game is going to be. Whether or not other states pick up on that and start doing that, time will tell.

**Fitts: Question #12: Land & Real Estate.** What will happen to land and real estate as a result of changes underway? What about the existing energy model? Will energy delivered by wireless technology at low cost be implemented soon?

**Farrell:** That question depends on whether or not ‘Mr. Globaloney’ is able to clamp down his global surveillance state. The thing that has kept all of that technology and energy production out of public use is precisely because they did not have the means to police everybody.

**Fitts:** If they get the smart grid in place, they have the ability to police everybody within that system, but they may not get 100% of the global population in that system.

**Farrell:** That is their problem. You have many good engineers in India and Japan who can ‘whip this up’ in their garage. I’m overly simplistic, but that is literally the case. This wireless energy transmission, Tesla was talking about this at the tail end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. They had to shut that down really fast when he also told them, “Hey, this stuff can be weaponized.”

That is their big nightmare. I’m convinced of that; they are afraid of losing control.

**Fitts:** Many people in the United States believe that we are about to watch a real estate collapse because when the tsunami of foreclosures and mortgage defaults come, you will see many people moved out of their housing. But if you look at the money they are printing and the global shopping spree, short of a war – which could happen – they can continue to engineer the inflation entirely through the balance sheet. I think the likely scenario is that the value of land is

up from here.

**Farrell:** I agree. I can't tell you how many emails I'm getting every day about people wanting to buy my house.

**Fitts:** I can believe it.

**Farrell:** It's 'off the charts', and there are signs all over town, "We will buy your house." Who is 'we'?

Real estate will go up, and property taxes are going to go up.

**Fitts: Question #13: Who is Mr. Global?** What is the governance structure on Planet Earth, and what are the risk issues that are driving Mr. Global's actions?

This one has me stumped. I've told you a couple of times that I've seen people on the internet saying, "You know she's lying because she worked at the top of Wall Street and Washington, so you know she knows who Mr. Global is."

I realize that they can't fathom how horrible it is that people that high up don't know who Mr. Global is.

I've gone down every theory. If you take the top 20 theories of who Mr. Global is and who really controls, I've gone through every 'rabbit hole', and I don't know. But what I will tell you is if you look at the top 20 theories, there is some 'pretty weird stuff'.

**Farrell:** From my perspective, I think that 'Mr. Globaloney' is at least the following: the familiar families-the Rothschilds, the Rockefellers, and so on down the line. But I think that behind them, you have the older families, and some very specific ones: Thurn and Taxis in Germany, or Della Torre e Tasso in Italy, the Venetian nobility, the Genoese nobility, and these very old banking families that are still there. Look at Lorenzo de' Medici who wants to start up the Medici Bank again.

They are still there. So that is one part of 'Mr. Globaloney'. The other part of

‘Mr. Globaloney’, I think are, what I call, the ‘internationals’. You still have the common term networks; you still have the globalist fascist networks; you still have the clergy networks like the Vatican. Think of its global extent with boots on the ground in every little ‘nook and cranny’ all over the world. Tell me that’s not a good intelligence network.

**Fitts:** The confession booth was the ultimate control file network, but they’ve been power-shifted by telecommunications.

**Farrell:** Absolutely. So you have those networks, and for want of a better expression, you have the ‘Secret Societies International’. You have all of these networks of lodges and so on. You could call it the ‘Occult International’. You have all of these different factions and groups, and they each have their own little agenda. Like all mafias, they make their alliances and then break them as it suits their agenda. That is why they are such a mess.

Military-Industrial Complex is another one. Every major power on the planet has one.

**Fitts:** It’s interesting because what I used to see in Washington is the way they would settle fights is agree to print more money for each other. The way they could always agree was to give each other more money by taking it from us.

There was no framework that wouldn’t stall financial accountability. So, you solve a fight by ‘kicking the can’ and printing more money for each other. It’s like there is no papa to say, “Stop! Sit down, shut up, go back, grow up.” It’s a mess.

**Farrell:** You have the intelligence international, and anybody who has been in intelligence will tell you that those intelligence agencies may talk the game like they are all KGB and CIA, and they are fighting each other all the time..

**Fitts:** They are a cartel, and they are coordinating.

**Farrell:** Precisely, and you have that problem. I’m going to sound ‘totally nuts’ here but I think that part of ‘Mr. Globaloney’ is off-planet.

**Fitts:** Somebody is off-planet.

**Farrell:** Somebody is off-planet who is calling a few shots.

**Fitts:** If you look at the history of flight, it's been happening on this planet for thousands of years. So the question is: Who is that?

I'll never forget that magic moment of 2014's Secret Space Program when Richard Dolan talked about the General who looked him 'dead in the eye' as he was pitching transparency, and said, "Trust me, you don't want to know." It was quite a chilling moment.

When the Trump Administration took their first photo in the Oval Office with all of the cabinet officers, you had Mattis and the person who was at HHS who became Chief of Staff. Everyone looked happy and cheery, and they had these bright, shiny auras, and their auras were gray.

You had to say, "What do they know that we don't know?"

That leads us right to the next question.

**Question #14: High Strangeness.** Which is stranger—what is going on behind the veil of secrecy, or the overwhelming effort to pretend it is not going on and to create an official reality diverging steadily from reality?

**Farrell:** That is a good question and a tough one!

**Fitts:** I want to know.

**Farrell:** Anybody who I have run across who is even moderately awake to half of the things we've talked about knows that something mighty strange is going on. Many of them have the feeling that the people who are supposed to know are equally baffled.

I think it's the secrecy. Somebody somewhere does know, and it is so strange that we probably wouldn't believe it if we were told.

I think there is a certain segment of the population that would not be surprised at all, and I'm going to 'toot my own horn' here and say that I am probably one of them. But that doesn't take away from the strangeness behind that secrecy veil. I think that it is very strange.

**Fitts:** I don't know if I ever told you this. I was giving a speech at a *Coast to Coast* event in Canada. I went on the first half, and the second half was Whitley Strieber and his wife. His wife has passed on now, but they were an absolutely fascinating couple. They were brilliant.

The *Coast to Coast* audience is so knowledgeable, and particularly the ones who listen to Art Bell. So, they have heard it all and studied it all and read it all, and they ask the best questions. Many of them are independent engineers or entrepreneurs.

A woman stood up and asked Whitley and Anne, "Are any of the movies about aliens successful in communicating what it feels like to be with an alien?"

Whitley stopped and thought for the longest time. It was about 30 seconds, which, in that context with a big audience, was huge. Then he said, "No," and that was it. Then there was another long silence.

The woman said, "Why not?"

Whitley waited around 30 more seconds while he was thinking, and you could see the Cray workstation (super computer) going around and around. He finally said, "There are no words in the English language to describe to you how strange it is."

My interpretation of what I heard him say was that their electromagnetic reality and intelligence is so completely different than ours that it is impossible to remain coherent in their presence. That was what I heard.

It was like you could hear a bell ring in that audience, and you could hear their consciousness shift. They were like, "Oh sh\*t!"

It was very interesting. To this day, I think Whitley would tell you that he's not

sure if that was an alien or some type of military black budget phenomena.

**Farrell:** Yes, he has discussed that with me many times. I told him on one of those occasions, although we weren't recording at the time, that it sounded like it was the experience of angels or demons that people have written about for hundreds of years because it is so strange.

At this stage, nothing surprises me anymore.

**Fitts:** This leads us to **Question #15**.

**Question #15: Demonic Intelligence.** Given the tsunami of occult and demonic practices and symbols, how concerned should we be about the interaction between AI and interdimensional intelligence?

**Farrell:** I think hugely.

**Fitts:** Next to mind control, this is the one that scares me the most. I think that AI and software allow interdimensional intelligence to control, govern, and impact our world.

**Farrell:** How many of us have had the experience where our computer acts like it has a mind of its own?

**Fitts:** I've had that many times.

**Farrell:** Here is my problem: This is going to sound totally 'wacko', but most of my members will understand this. The problem with AI and all the thinking about it is that you are dealing with binary systems. It's 'yes' or 'no'. It's 'infinite' or 'finite', 'spirit' or 'matter' – all of this dialectical 'claptrap' that we have been caught in for so long. But if you really examine the human intelligence, and if you really drill down, there was an American logician and philosopher named Charles Peirce. If you ever read his writings, it's just 'trippy'-there is no other way to describe it.

What Peirce was describing and what I have seen other philosophers try to describe is that human intelligence is really triadic in structure, not dualistic in

structure. If that AI intelligence seems so foreign, that is why.

**Fitts:** Part of it is also that if you look at how AI is being applied, any consumer or citizen is subject to thousands of different AI programs, all of which are designed to optimize somebody's process that has nothing to do with me.

So, you have AI armies attacking you to optimize this person's profits and that person's profits and this person's efficiency and that efficiency, and the net result for you is a complete waste of your time and money. It's very incoherent. It's not trying to optimize your free and inspired life; it's just trying to harvest or work you in some kind of different way.

The net result of being the target of that many different AI optimized processes is total insanity.

**Farrell:** Let me give you an example that may clarify what I mean by 'triadic structure of thinking'. We in the West, for long, complicated, involved, theological reasons, tend to think of the issue of free will or free choice in a dualistic or dialectical fashion. In other words, we think that we have free will because we can sin. We tend to define our ability to choose dialectically; it's either 'this or it's that'.

But if you stop and analyze the choices you make during an average day, you will discover that very few of them are dialectically or digitally binarily constructed. "Do I want to go to the grocery store today, or do I want to stay home and read a book?" Those are two choices not conditioned by any sort of dialectical binary condition of moral opposition.

In other words, our whole thinking and thought structure has been conditioned to be binary. When we stop and put our minds to it, very few of our decisions or thought processes are structured in that fashion. Most of our thought processes and most of our decisions are completely structured differently and we are analyzing and balancing a multitude of variables, all of which by themselves are probably good. We are trying to weigh them just like an investment banker. You weigh all these different options and all these different variables, and you are trying to decide which one is the best for you to choose.

Our whole thinking has to change on this score. We have to get out of this digital way of thinking. What frightens me is the same that frightens you. If you are replacing a system where you are going to be basing everything on AI, and that system in turn perforce is binary in nature, the 'and' or 'or' gate in the computer system on a computer circuit is a binary circuit. A binary circuit will never approach the complexity of the relations that go on in the neurons of the human brain-ever. It can approximate it, but it will never ever match it. This is why they are in such a hurry for a quantum computer so that they can get rid of all of that binary system.

I think that people have to understand that we need to wake up and get out of this paradigm of thinking either/or all the time. We have to get out of the binary way of thinking with dialectics and all that. Marxism made a career out of that.

**Fitts:** Here is the thing: If you look at reason and logic, I think that one of the things that makes our intelligence so interesting is that you can combine reason and logic with light and love.

In other words, when you think with your mind and your heart simultaneously, you get a very different intelligence than when you are only thinking with your mind. Your heart is not binary.

**Farrell:** This is why I said earlier that the ancients had the idea of reason as being more than mere ratiocination. It included the human passions. It included things like wisdom, experience, and so on. That was what they meant by reason. Along came Descartes (16<sup>th</sup> century French mathematician, scientist), and we've been in that mess ever since.

**Fitts:** It's amusing because, throughout my business and deal-doing career, we constantly come to these decision points. I used to have a partner who would say, "It's a Gestalt (theories of perception, i.e., the whole is greater than the sum of its parts) thing."

He would say, "We have to go to the right because this is so important that we can throw out all of this rational binary thinking. That is all good and very helpful, but this is a Gestalt thing."

You come into these things, and one of the reasons at one point that I said, “I have to have my own company,” was that I had to be free to exercise the Gestalt thing.

What is remarkable is I have never exercised the Gestalt thing and regretted it. It always turned out to be the right thing because when you are dealing in highly complicated situations, figuring out the right way to go takes a different kind of intelligence. Binary doesn't do it.

I do an investment screen, and essentially, I am always coming back to who the owner is, who the governor is, and who the manager is. So, it's the people who own, the people who govern, and the people who manage because the reality is that all of the other things, when you get into the corner, if you have excellence in leadership, they will figure it out because it's a Gestalt thing.

**Farrell:** We can boil it down to a simple series of questions. We have been culturally conditioned to think that the most important questions are what, how, and why.

**Fitts:** That is because ‘who’ is the important question, and they don't want us knowing about that.

**Farrell:** Right, it's the ‘who’.

**Fitts: Question #16: The War on the Divine.** Who is burning the churches of France and why? Why is there an attack on Christianity in many parts of the world? Should we be concerned that the depopulation efforts are focused on Christians? Does this explain the real targeting of communities with a high percentage of Christians? Does this explain the effort to shut down and bankrupt churches or get them financially dependent on government?

We've discussed this a great deal, but I will confess that I think that one of the reasons for the war on the African-American community – and I think that BLM is just the cover-up for a new beatdown – is their deep roots in Christianity.

**Farrell:** Yes, I agree with that. I think that looking at the whole picture, as you are trying to do in that series of questions, there is no doubt in my mind that the people behind it are ‘Mr. Globaloney’, but particularly the ‘Mr. Globaloney’ that is either a materialist or an occultist or, the worst of all things, both.

**Fitts:** That is an excellent point; the worst of both things.

**Farrell:** C.S. Lewis makes that point over and over again. I go to the third book of his space trilogy, which is one of my favorites. What you see portrayed in that book is a technocracy. You discover ultimately, that technocracy is not as materialistic as they present themselves. They are heavily involved in all sorts of wacky, crazy occult activity and so on, and they are presenting this public façade of materialism and strict scientific rationality. It’s an eye-opening book, and very prophetic.

I think that if we were to ask the question, “Who is responsible for burning down Notre Dame?” I look squarely at ‘Mr. Globaloney’. No sooner had that happened than we found out that Michelle Obama was there when it happened, and they were ready to go with a plan to turn Notre Dame into a greenhouse.

**Fitts:** Right, they already had the blueprints for it.

**Farrell:** They had the blueprints of what they were going to change this ‘monstrous cathedral’ into. Bless the French! They stood up and said, “Absolutely not!”

There is no doubt that they have initiated this program, and they have installed their Marxist Pope, and so on. There is no doubt that they have big plans for Christianity. The only thing that is going to stop them is if people who are Christian and take their baptismal vows seriously stand up and say, “No,” and cut off the money.

**Fitts: Question #17: Education.** Is moving education online using Covid-19 a step to privatization and a corporate takeover of education?

**Question #18: Historical Plague Laws.** What is Mr. Global going to do next with the Covid-19 pandemic? There appears to be a 100-year cycle of plagues

and plague laws used to centralize capital. Is it tied to currency or other cycles?

The Pye book takes it back to the bubonic plague. I would love to see a PhD candidate take this on. My guess is that this is very much tied to the currency cycle.

**Farrell:** I think so, too. The reason is in *Babylon's Banksters*. In there, I talk about the foundation for the study of cycles. If you don't know about that foundation, it was Herbert Hoover's legacy. When the Depression hit, Hoover turned to a man in the Department of Commerce and asked him to do a study on why we keep having these boom and bust cycles.

So, this man has the database of the entire Department of Commerce, and he notices all of these very strange long-wave cycles that every now and then merge or converge at the same time. He started a foundation called the Foundation for the Study of Cycles. Any cycle that you can imagine – pig iron, pork production, bacon, rivets, steel – he tracked these long-wave cycles.

What interested me the most when I started looking at this Foundation – and Richard Hoagland was the one who told me about it – was the number of people on it who were representative of major banks. Mitsubishi in Japan is not only a bank, but a major corporation.

In other words, do they know about these cycles? Yes.

There is one important point that the man who founded this foundation made, and people have to 'latch' onto this. He said that these are cycles of nature. They are hardwired into the fabric of the cosmos, and that may sound strange for economic and financial activity to be hardwired into the structure of the cosmos.

**Fitts:** It makes sense to me because we are herd animals.

**Farrell:** There is always a connection between your system of finance and your system of physics. Always.

What he said was that it is impossible for human action to reverse a cycle, but it

is possible to influence the degree of whatever period of the cycle you are in. You can attenuate it, or you can exacerbate it.

**Fitts:** I finished reading Ben Davidson's book on the sun. He believes that we are going into a period of low sunspot activity, which means that the economy should fall; the stock market should fall.

What we are seeing is the opposite. We are seeing the 'juicing' of the stock market and the consolidation of economic activity. But if you look at the application of technology to economy, we seem to be beating the curve, if you will.

One of my questions is: Are they worried about the sun activity?

**Farrell:** My suspicion would be yes. If they are playing that game, they have to know that all they are doing is making the finance capitalism and production capitalism diverge in major ways that will eventually come crashing down around their heads.

They are engineering an unreality.

**Fitts:** They just have the finance people eating up more and more of the economy.

**Farrell:** This is a struggle between finance capitalism and the real thing. This is why I'm so against all this algorithmic trading. This is my old 'hobby horse' that I've been on forever.

If you have markets that are controlled by computer trading, then you don't have markets that represent genuine human economic activity; you have markets that are in the hands of an AI with all of its digital binary thinking. What do we see as a result? We see more chaos and markets that are completely or increasingly divested from any human reality. That is one reason I won't put any money in the stock market; I don't trust it.

**Fitts:** I think there is something about cycles that has them very worried.

**Farrell:** I think they are very worried. I think that one of the things they are worried about is that we are at one of those moments of history where all of these different waves of cycles are converging at a nodal point. In other words, if you look back at human history; I mentioned Fulton Sheen in *Part I*. Years and years ago on his old television program, he actually came out and said, “We are going into a period of one of those 500-year cyclical changes in civilization.”

If you extrapolate what he was saying-if you look back at all of human history-we are entering a period now of all these things converging at the same moment of time and converging in such a way that it is qualitatively and quantitatively unlike anything that has preceded it.

**Fitts:** I absolutely agree. Part of it is that we are moving out of the central banking warfare model, and we don't know what will work. But here is what I would say: It's a moment in time where the leadership has to do the Gestalt thing.

**Farrell:** Right, and they're not.

**Fitts:** Mind control and hypermaterialism and fear and binary thinking will not support you in making, not just wise decisions, let alone 'jumping the curve'. We have a huge opportunity to step up to a much more powerful and excellent civilization. I believe it's an opportunity. What I feel and see is just a race to the bottom.

**Farrell:** It's because 'Mr. Globaloney' – and we've talked about this many times – is now a victim of his own propaganda. He cannot think in any other way than these disconnected, binary, dialectical ways that are inadequate to the situation.

**Fitts:** Is it possible to help him raise his mind?

**Farrell:** Possibly. I'm going back to the things that I pray for, and one of the things that I pray is for those people – 'Mr. Globaloney' – to repent. Let's remember what the word 'repentance' means. It's a Greek word, metanoia. Metanoia in Greek means 'a change of mind'. In other words, it's a gigantic paradigm shift.

So, we have to hope that somewhere in ‘Mr. Globaloney’s’ cabal there is somebody who wakes up and says, “This isn’t working.” That is step number one: “Let’s try something else.”

In other words, what we have to do is look for the people who leave the ‘Mr. Globaloney’ camp, and make sure when we see anybody signaling that they have something else to look at and ponder and consider.

In the last *Wrap Up*, you told me about a group that met in Switzerland. So, it’s that sort of activity that we need to be on the lookout for.

**Fitts:** I think that we need a huge change of mind. There is a failure of imagination happening.

**Question #19: Down Under.** Why have the Australian and New Zealand lockdowns been so brutal? What does it have to do with Pine Gap (satellite surveillance base) and Antarctica?

**Farrell:** I can’t figure that out either. I have some members in Australia, and one of them regularly sends me material. It’s not because I don’t think that what this individual sends me is not interesting that I don’t blog about it; it’s just so ‘over the top’ that I don’t know what to make of it.

**Fitts:** Australia has always been the lucky country. If you look at the leadership of Australia, I would describe it as highly masonic and highly competent. By and large, they have engineered a wonderful way of life for the Australian people.

Part of it is you have this vast landmass the size of the United States with 24 million people. Of course, everybody in Asia would love to go there. So they’ve somewhat had the wind in their sails, but these lockdowns have been absolutely brutal.

**Farrell:** They make no sense to me; I can’t figure it out.

I’ll be very blunt: Part of it is because you have a group of progressivist lefties all over the place down there who are running things.

**Fitts:** That includes New Zealand.

**Farrell:** Part of the state is in Australia. Even that doesn't explain it all for me, and I can't figure out why. Is it related to Pine Gap? Who knows? Is it related to Antarctica? I don't know. There is something mighty strange about it. I'm in the 'same boat' as you, and I cannot figure it out.

**Fitts: Question #20: AI & Machine Enforcement.** When are robotics and automation going to go up the S curve? Will the 'defund the police' movement turn out to be an install robot and drone police wave?

**Farrell:** I think so, particularly in the major cities. I think that is what they are pushing for, and that is to get everybody locked down.

**Fitts:** Any time I see robots with the police, I'm out of that state. Get out, just get out!

**Question #21: The Climate Change Op.** Can the Covid-19 to Climate Change bait and switch really work? Why has Biden appointed a climate change czar who has the carbon footprint of a Panzer division?

This one baffles me.

**Farrell:** I think of these big German tanks from World War II.

**Fitts:** Looking at John Kerry, he has always been a remarkably effective politician in many respects. I disagree with him on many things, but he has always been a hard-working, talented politician. He has tried to do some good things.

He married John Heinz's wife, Teresa Heinz, so he is responsible for his money, and his wife's fortune. You're talking about many houses, private planes: she has a private jet company. This man gives no evidence of his lifestyle. It's like Obama's beachfront properties; they don't believe in climate change, and they're not subtle about it.

**Farrell:** It's such a mystery to me why they keep pushing this thing.

**Fitts:** I know why. It's because they want everybody on the smart grid. They're trying to build an all-electrical system, and while they're at it, they would love to cut your use of energy because their crypto energy hog is going to take up all the energy in the world.

**Farrell:** That too, but here is the problem. I was alive during the first Earth Day. Remember that in the 1970's where they had all the schools around the country doing Earth Day. At that time, the big thing wasn't global warming; it was global cooling. "We're going to have another ice age." Then it changed to global warming. Of course, there was no science for that either. Now it's 'climate change'.

So, I'm watching the change of language; the climate is always changing. We are dealing with something that they can get away with anything. Add to that their weather manipulation technologies, and there you go.

**Fitts:** For 25 years, I've been watching the spraying going back and forth. Driving across America, there is spraying, spraying, spraying. Then suddenly, they are saying, "Gates wants to dim the sun."

I said, "Really? What do you think has been going on for 25 years?"

**Farrell:** And that during a solar minimum! Either these people are colossally stupid, or there is something else going on. Global warming: Earlier this year, there was two weeks of global warming in the form of bitter cold sub-zero temperatures, and Texas was frozen.

**Fitts:** I have to tell you that the whole "Texas being frozen" was very strange.

**Farrell:** Of course, it was! So I thought, "Right, we're in global warming!"

Even the local radio announcers were talking about, "We have more global warming today. The temperature is going to be ten degrees, and that is without the wind chill. There are going to be six more inches of 'global warming' on the ground tomorrow. We're sorry you can't go get your groceries right now, but

there's nothing that we can do about it.”

I just laughed because even the media wasn't buying it anymore!

**Fitts:** At some point, I think that all the commentators will have trouble keeping a straight face; they are having trouble keeping a straight face now.

**Question #22: Sun Cycles.** What is happening to the sun? Are we entering into a period of diminished sun spot activity? What would that mean for our weather and economy? Are we at risk of a new ice age? Why is Gates talking about blotting out the sun? Is the risk of a coronal mass ejection (CME) real?

We've talked about sun cycles. Let's talk about another Carrington Event (powerful geomagnetic event). Could that happen?

**Farrell:** Yes, I think so. Forget about all the EMP energy burst from nuclear weapons and electromagnetic weapons and so on. The other thing that could take down your cryptocurrencies is a nice big coronal mass ejection.

Let's remember that the Carrington Event took down nearly all of the telegraphy in the country at the time. Given what we have now, it would be far worse.

If we are entering into a solar minimum, my question is: If they know this, are they trying to make it worse by trying to blot out the sun? Are they literally trying to kill off so much of the population through lack of food production and warm temperatures and so on?

**Fitts:** And lack of vitamin D; our major source of vitamin D is the sun, and the number one reason for deaths during COVID-19 was low vitamin D.

Get a sun lamp.

**Question #23: Geophysical Risks.** Does Earth have a Three-Body Problem? Why was there a pattern of civilization destruction 10,000 years ago?

Dr. Skidmore has been looking deeper into the 10,000-12,000-year cycle of

disaster. There has clearly been a cycle of disaster every 10,000-12,000 years.

Last year I finished reading *The Three-Body Problem*, the Chinese science fiction book. What a depressing book!

There is no doubt that something seems to come along in this cycle that 'flattens' us. We don't know what it is, but I'm sure that somebody knows.

**Farrell:** The problem that I have with the cycle theory isn't necessarily the cycles themselves but that people are not taking seriously those ancient texts about cosmic wars, which seem to run somewhat parallel to some of these cycles for some reason.

I do think that we have a Three-Body Problem. I do believe that there are these cycles. What the next one might be, I don't know. But it is curious that every now and then in the last few years, you've seen these little stories about, "Such-and-such asteroid is going to fly by the Earth, and it's going to be dangerously close," and so on. Maybe this is one reason they are in such a hurry. Perhaps they've calculated potential asteroid strikes in the next few years. I don't know, but I don't put anything past these people.

**Fitts:** I think their behavior suggests there is a reasonably good chance that they are deeply concerned about a geophysical risk of some sort.

**Farrell:** Oh, I do too.

**Fitts:** I'll tell you the one that worries me is the upper atmosphere nuclear testing. Did they do something with the upper atmosphere nuclear testing that really compromised the atmosphere, and are they terrified that people will realize they have 'screwed things up'?

It's also the question of: Has the manipulation of the electromagnetic core 'messed up' the core?

**Farrell:** There are two little things to ponder here. When we were about to set off our first hydrogen bomb in the Pacific, I don't know if you remember seeing this person, Admiral Blandy. He went on television and gave a statement to

calm the fears of people who were saying, “Oh, if we light off a hydrogen bomb, it might ignite the hydrogen in the atmosphere and burn the earth to a crisp.”

So, Admiral Blandy went on television and said, “I’m not a nuclear playboy. This will not ignite the hydrogen in the atmosphere.”

So, they took their hydrogen bomb to Bikini atoll, and this was called Ivy Mike (codename for first nuclear test). They set it off, and it was supposed to have a 5-megaton yield, but it went to about 7 megatons – two more than they thought it might.

So, the nuclear ‘playboys’ then came up with Castle Bravo (first in a series of nuclear tests), which is my favorite one of them all. That was supposed to have a calculated yield of 7 megatons, and it ran away to 15. That’s a little ‘oops’!

I thought, “Do these people really know what they are playing around with?” The answer is, “No.”

**Fitts:** Who wrote the letter at the beginning saying, “If you do upper atmosphere testing, you could destroy the atmosphere”? Wasn’t it Einstein?

**Farrell:** I don’t remember who started all of that, but here is the other problem: If you are letting off something like that, it’s going to create a magnetic resonance effect. Those upper atmosphere tests were the ones where they were trying to figure out how much damage there would be from electromagnetic pulse. When they did that, they shut off Hawaii and significant portions of the Pacific.

This is my problem here with the systems we’re playing around with: We simply do not have any real good empirical data on how these systems affect other systems.

**Fitts:** Right, and think about how they affect our mind.

**Farrell:** Yes, because our mind is an electromagnetic instrument – or at least our brain is.

**Fitts:** We've exploded tremendous numbers of these things.

**Farrell:** Stop and think: We have HAARP (High-frequency Active Auroral Research Program). What does HAARP do? It raises and lowers the ionosphere. That's a planetary system. Do they really know the effect that this is going to have via magnetic resonance or whatever on weather systems on the magneto dynamic core of the planet? The answer is, "Probably not."

**Fitts:** When you look at all of the manipulation of the electromagnetic field on the planet from all these different things, it's remarkable that any of us can think.

**Farrell:** Arthur Firstenberg brings that out in his book. Every time there is a big electromagnetic technological wave that hits the planet, we have all of these epidemics. He points out the problems with HAARP as well. This has been my problem with HAARP and CERN and numerous other things. We are being told, "No, there is no danger of any effect like that".

I'm a 'butterfly effect kind of guy'. It doesn't take much to tangle up these very complex integrated highly-complex systems; it doesn't take very much at all.

**Fitts:** Add to that the fact that we are launching satellites in the scores and scores.

**Farrell:** Exactly. Personally, I wonder if this is having an effect on aggregate human behavior. I do.

**Fitts:** It has to.

**Farrell:** Anybody who has ever worked in a casino – and that would be me – can tell you that as a manager, one of the things that you watch are the cycles of the moon. You are waiting for the full moon to come around because people go 'bats'.

**Fitts:** I used to run a couple of bars when I was in college and grad school. Full moon nights were a problem.

**Farrell:** It's there. I have to wonder: Are we so complicated with things in our technology that we are not really aware of the system's effects that they have? My answer is probably, "Yes."

**Fitts:** Part of our challenge is that we are highly dependent on the financial liquidity and all the other benefits of the systems we've adopted. So. it's quite a 'pickle'.

**Farrell:** It's a very big 'pickle'; it's a whole jar of them!

**Fitts: Question #24: The Vision Thing.** What are the supporting facts and arguments for optimism?

What I think is that all over the world we've been 'kicking the can' for my entire life. For the first time in my life, I am starting to see people of great talent and ability start to say, "You know something? We can't stay in the middle of the road; we are going to have to step up and work together. We could lose human civilization, and we can't afford to do that. We will pay any price to, instead, take a big step up."

I'm watching people worldwide step up to the challenge, and I think that if that keeps happening, I know the big secret about all the waste in the system will be exposed. There is no reason for poverty on this planet; there is no reason for suffering on this planet. This is a glorious planet.

**Farrell:** It is; it's a jewel.

**Fitts:** We have the ability with reason and our mind and cooperation to shift the whole state of play. The question is: How do you get the different groups to feel safe enough in the new picture?

**Farrell:** I'm optimistic because I see the same thing that you are. More and more people are aware at some level and to some degree that we are on the wrong path. By awareness, I mean that it's not simply an awareness that things are confused and that 'Mr. Globaloney' is completely 'whacked and nuts' and an infant, but they realize there are some fundamental problems with the systems

of governance or academics or whatever you may be focused on. There is something drastically wrong, and there needs to be a serious deep level critique of some of these things.

**Fitts:** The other thing is that we will have to figure out what we are going to do about the Beck brothers.

**Farrell:** I finished watching the third season of *Yellowstone*. I've watched the complete third season twice now because this is a very interesting series. There are some very subtle messages. It's not this preachy kind of 'in-your-face' message sending and 'join the agenda'. It's much subtler than that.

One of the things that really stuck with me was the Indian tribal chief.

**Fitts:** He is a very interesting character.

**Farrell:** Oh, he's an incredibly interesting character because he's in the system, and he's not.

**Fitts:** Right, and he has to balance many different things.

**Farrell:** He made a remark that really 'grabbed me'. He said, "Our people," meaning Native American Indian people, "didn't build houses; they sought shelter. They didn't produce food; they went out and looked for it."

I thought, "Okay, here is a guy who is a casino owner and using all this tribal money to try to uplift his tribe, and he's commenting on this. So, this is a man who is not offering a simple, 'Let's just get rid of all technology and return and be luddites.' He's not saying that, but he is saying, 'You've got to change your thinking about things'."

I do think it's something like that that we are going to be forced by circumstances and by 'Mr. Globaloney's' agenda to do. We have to change our whole paradigm of thought. I'm not saying to get rid of technology or any of that, but we have to measure it much more carefully; we have to deliberate about it.

**Fitts:** It's what scripture says, "It's time for the renewing of our minds."

**Farrell:** Right, I really think that.

**Fitts:** We are coming into an inflection point, and we will have to do the Gestalt thing.

**Farrell:** Exactly. This is why people need to start dot-connecting. Something that I tell people over and over again is, "Don't worry if the dots you are connecting look crazy. It's a crazy world, so it's going to look crazy."

**Fitts:** The other thing is that I believe that all opportunities for real solutions first have to go through the doorway of reality. Part of the trick or judo of facing reality is being willing to go through the overwhelm. It is overwhelming, but you have to go through the overwhelm, and you have to say, "What I do matters."

It's back to, "What we do echoes through eternity."

One of the things that has helped me tremendously in the last two years, and I don't know if I told you this, but I was reading an article about Jim Mattis when he first joined the Trump Administration. They said that he carried Marcus Aurelius' *Meditations* with him everywhere.

I thought, "What is this? The new *Catcher in the Rye*? Is this a mind-control thing?"

So I decided to fall for it, and acquired a copy of Marcus Aurelius' *Meditations*. I absolutely love it! It's so inspiring.

I'm somebody who gets plenty out of a good church sermon, and I can't get a good church sermon right now. But Marcus Aurelius really lifts me up and rebuilds my backbone. It's fabulous!

**Farrell:** Watch Bishop Fulton Sheen if you want a good sermon.

**Fitts:** I was marking that down as you were talking about it.

**Farrell:** He is one of the preachers in the old grand style.

**Fitts:** That's a style I love!

**Farrell:** I do, too. He is a good speaker, he is a good orator, and he handles his gestures well and in a very deliberate way. He is part of that.

Whenever I sit down to read Marcus Aurelius, I have to remind myself, "I'm reading the intimate thoughts of a Roman Emperor who is out there on his campaigns and says, 'Enough sword play for the day. I'm going to go over here and write all of this thought down'." That is amazing to me that he took the time to do that.

**Fitts:** It's also a discipline. He is trying to be excellent, and he exercises the discipline, "Just like I would lift a weight to build my muscle, I need to do the same for my character."

**Farrell:** It's his character. Consider all of the nonentities and chumps and corrupt infants that were emperors at more or less the time that he was. Then you have him come along.

I agree with you with the Marcus Aurelius *Meditations*.

**Fitts:** There is nothing more important than good leadership. That is why whenever somebody is willing to bank at a bank that has lousy leadership, I think, "Don't you understand? You can't afford to be associated with lousy leaders. You can't afford to give money to lousy leaders." It's back to what you finance.

We have one final question before we get to Inspiration and Take Action.

**Question #25: The Road Ahead.** What is most on the minds of members of Giza Death Star and *The Solari Report* subscribers? What can we do this year to help improve the learning speeds in our shared intelligence networks?

There is an unbelievable rich discussion at Giza Death Star, but that has also

started to happen at *Solari*. We are working on some things that will help, from a systems standpoint, support conversations that people want to have.

With this *Wrap Up*, we are reintroducing *Solari Circles*, which we somewhat sat on. I've tried to encourage people to do circles before, and now I think that once again we are ready to try. They are beginning to understand why they need other people to watch their back.

One of the things that we are saying is, "You've got to find your family."

**Farrell:** Yes, you have to find your family; you have to find soul mates; you have to find people who have similar outlooks on life and share similar 'values' – to use the modern term, although I prefer the term 'virtues'. You have to find people like that to talk to and bounce ideas off of. All revolutions begin in coffee shops. It's that simple.

All paradigm changes begin in those types of conversations. Look at poor Martin Luther. He went out and he proposed a collection of theses for the college to debate, and, suddenly, he was embroiled with the Pope, he was embroiled with the emperor, and all he wanted to do was only discuss a few things.

**Fitts:** Do you know the country in the world that has the highest per capita coffee drinking?

**Farrell:** Probably the Netherlands or France.

**Fitts:** Yes, it's the Netherlands.

**Farrell:** I can believe it; that totally makes sense to me. You can't get a group of Dutchmen sitting in cafes in Amsterdam and not talk about something. That does not surprise me.

I think of the movie called *Adams* about John Adams. There is a marvelous scene where Adams has gone to Amsterdam to talk to the Dutch about a loan. Have you seen that? It's marvelous. You have to see this.

There are all of these dour Dutchmen in their hats and their costumery, and they are staring at him and waiting for him to talk. He finally talks, and he was just going around and around. Finally, one of the Dutchman says, “How much money do you want?”

It’s really a priceless scene; they ‘cut right to the chase’.

**Fitts:** That’s the Dutch!

So, we did our 25 **Unanswered Questions**. Now I want to turn to **Take Action** and **Inspiration**. The theme for the *1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Wrap Up* is ‘**Take Action 2021**’, and we will be doing many things about what can help people take action. I think that, to a certain extent if you look at what is going on in the world, it is so important to take action in your life and in your circles and in your communities.

One of the things that we did put up – and it was inspired by Giza Death Star and *Solari* – was a Family Financial Disclosure form because so many people were struggling with their family trying to stop loved ones from getting the injection.

I was really concerned about this. I was talking on one of the Children’s Health Defense forums about the fact that the informed consent doesn’t go far enough because it doesn’t disclose financial matters. So Bobby Kennedy jumped on and he said, “Would you do an article about this for *The Defender*?”

I said, “Yes,” and then I tried to do it but I couldn’t do it because I realized, “What is the point in trying to persuade the medical establishment to do the right thing? It’s a waste of time.”

Then I realized that if you look at the planning process for healthcare proxies to help families design their proxies and plan for managing those kinds of healthcare situations together, there is a great planning process. Why don’t we take that and apply it to this in a discipline that insists, “If somebody in the family is going to take this injection, they are required to prove to the rest of the family that their adverse event will not translate into a family bankruptcy.”

So, their health freedom is that they have the right to take the injection if they want to, but they don't have the right to bankrupt the family without the family's permission. So, it's designed to force the family together to face the potential financial ramifications of an adverse event and a death from an injection and go through that process.

Part of it is to force people to do real due diligence and help make it easy by giving access to all the information about adverse events and deaths. So it's now up in English, and it is translated into German and French. We just launched that.

It's not the kind of thing where everybody says, "Oh, this is great! Let's share this widely. This is so exciting and new and interesting!" but instead, it is spreading like a tool that people need. It's percolating around.

**Farrell:** I have to tell you when I saw that, it was one of the best things that I've ever seen, and precisely for that reason. It's going to slowly percolate. There is no better way to get advertising than word of mouth.

**Fitts:** I also think that it's by being useful. I think that it will be useful to one family, they will give it to another family and it will be useful, and the utility will pass it along.

Another thing that we are doing, which I wanted to tell you about, is we updated the '*Coming Clean*' piece, which is what the 24 steps are that you need to take to get the bad people out of your life. It's called '*Coming Clean*', and it's about getting righteous in a practical way, but getting away from organized crime. It's a collection of links.

Jon Rappoport and I recently did it. He agreed to help me, and we went through it, and it's on the site.

The other thing that we are doing is, when the website was taken down long ago, we are still cleaning up from that event. We lost the '*Silver and Gold Calculator*', which helped you go back and forth between your coins and all the other currencies. If you want to pay somebody 1,000 euros as a Christmas present, you want to know how much is in gold and silver. It's a simple

calculator. So, we hired a development team. I'm hoping that it will be ready by the end of the month, if not by the end of May.

We will relaunch the '*Silver and Gold Calculator*' because I keep saying to communities that there are two issues. One, we have to have a human civilization, but to achieve that, we have to decentralize the money-printing process. What I keep saying to people is, "Don't make it complicated. You need a community currency? 'Just do it'. You have silver, you have gold, you have local coins, and that's enough. Just do it, what's the problem?"

So we will bring out the circles, we have the Family Financial Disclosure form, we will bring out the Silver and Gold calculator, and we have some other things planned. I think that whatever you do, take action; just take action and just act. Try things. Move forward without a 'face diaper'.

The other thing is that I've been screaming about food for so many years, but with this headline about Bill Gates and farmland and the synthetic food, I think that people are getting into this idea of knowing who your farmer is and needing to support them.

**Farrell:** I think that it's time that people start asking their local grocer, "Where are you getting your produce? Are they local farmers?"

Just start asking questions. They will get the message if enough people start asking questions. They will get the message.

**Fitts: Take Action.** Any thoughts from your side of the pond?

**Farrell:** From my side of the pond, what I hope people will start doing is, first of all, on the food business; I love what you told me about what is happening there in the Netherlands where you are dealing directly with a local farmer.

**Fitts:** Do you know what it's like to get the world's finest organic and biodynamic food delivered to your door? You go downstairs, and it's all there.

**Farrell:** And in the Netherlands, those Dutch polders have such rich soil.

**Fitts:** The food here is incredible.

**Farrell:** I can imagine. I would like to see people start working on some of that in this country. I would love it if I could call up a farmer and say, “Hey, I need a couple of dozen eggs and some corn and tomatoes.”

**Fitts:** I’ve been told that this is happening in the U.S. In other words, these websites are being put together, and they collect it up from the different farmers and then deliver it to the door.

AI software has caused many more restaurant delivery services, and from a technology standpoint, this is not very different.

**Farrell:** I would love to see that here.

There are farmers who will bring in their produce and sit on a street corner somewhere and set up their tents and sell it. The trouble is that it’s not regulated, so you never know where they are going to appear. I think that that is the ‘ticket’. I would love to see something like that here because I would make use of it. I would much rather deal with a local farmer who I know and whose produce I know than to deal with a grocer, where it could be coming from anywhere.

**Fitts:** We received this wonderful question in ‘*Ask Catherine*’ from someone from France who many, many years ago had gone out and had bought farmland and hired a farmer to produce the food. It was a small group of families, and it increased to more than 80 families now.

**Farrell:** I can believe it.

**Fitts:** They have a completely dedicated food supply. I’ve seen that arrangement in America, and I’ve seen it here as well in Europe. It’s a great thing to do.

Under **Take Action**, we put numerous links in the web presentation, but we also put a multitude of links in the Equity Overview. We had a special link collection. So, there is one in **Coming Clean**, and there is one in the **Equity**

**Overview**, and there is one here with hundreds of different ideas. But the one thing that I will say is that whatever action you take, only do what gives you energy.

We are all being drained, and we need to take the actions that reverse the drain. There is no 'ought to', but do what gives you energy.

**Farrell:** Do what you are passionate about.

**Fitts:** Right.

**Inspiration.** I had a very inspiring quarter. Every week we have a *Solari Hero*, and the hardest thing in the first quarter was that we had so many candidates for *Solari Hero* every week. It was like, "I want this one. No, I want this one. No, I want this one."

Celia Farber wrote a fabulous piece on John Magufuli, the President of Tanzania. I don't know if you noticed this, but Kristi Noem, the Governor of your old state, South Dakota, at her speech at CPAC, had a reference to accounting gimmicks.

**Farrell:** Do you know what I thought that was a reference to? FASAB 56. I was watching that, and I thought, "Oh, Catherine has to see this!"

**Fitts:** I saw it right away.

One thing that was amazing was Dr. Scott Atlas was one of the heroes. Here is a complete member of the establishment coming out publicly and saying, "This is all hooey." Did you see what he wrote? It was unbelievable.

**Farrell:** There is an example right there of what I would call someone who has had a change of mind, someone who has 'left the reservation', so to speak, and come out. Those people need to be encouraged.

**Fitts:** One hero, and I'm not going to mention all of them because we have a list in the 'Heroes' section, is Dr. Simone Gold. She was the doctor from L.A. who was arrested relating to the January 6<sup>th</sup> event. It looked to me like she was

set up. I don't know the details. She has been one of the most ferocious about the withholding of protocols that work and what is going on with the pandemic.

Another one was my childhood hero, Hank Aaron.

**Farrell:** Yes. I saw that, and I posted that notice on my Facebook wall. I thought, "Wow!" He did this in perfectly good health.

**Fitts:** I believe that Hank Aaron was an excellent human being and a great man. He was my favorite baseball player. I used to have a bet with my father every year as to who would get more RBIs and home runs – Hank Aaron or Willie Mays. We would have an argument, and I would always win because Hank Aaron was nowhere near as entertaining as some of the other players, but he had an amazing character.

Then if you look at his amazing career afterward for the Braves and what he did, this is a man who has contributed immensely in many, many ways. So, you are talking about somebody who has given and given and given. This is somebody who has performed and performed and performed. He didn't whine; he was just a 'brick'.

For him to be murdered that way, it was really heartbreaking.

**Farrell:** I had the same exact reaction. I'm not even a sports fan, but I had the same exact reaction to it.

**Fitts:** He is a person who has inspired me tremendously.

I'll go very quickly over this: You started the *Food for the Soul* series. It's one of my favorite things at *The Solari Report*. Nina Heyn writes two columns a month and then does podcasts on art. When the pandemic started, I made the stupid business decision of the year. There were about 10-20 exhibits that she wanted to go to all over the world. So I called Nina and said, "I want to protect your travel budget, and we are going to fund and buy all of the tickets in January and February so that it's locked in; we've put the money away, and there can be no question that you will go." Famous last words!

Do you have any idea what Nina had to do to cancel all those travel arrangements and ‘claw’ back all the money? It was a full-time job!

**Farrell:** I can believe it. You saw the strange story from Oxford, right? Sheet music is now banned.

**Fitts:** Oh my God!

**Farrell:** Fortunately, the University hasn’t gone along with that. My problem is: What are those people doing there to begin with?

**Fitts:** It sounds to me like the kind of thing that somebody would do to get attention.

**Farrell:** It may be that, but still, it is so asinine.

**Fitts:** We should tell the listeners and readers what we are talking about. They may not know.

**Farrell:** Oxford University had people on the music faculty who came out and determined that sheet music – musical scores by the likes of Duke Ellington and Beethoven – is an example of a white Colonial imperialist period of history, and we should rethink it.

I was so outraged! I went into the living room where I had my diploma hanging on the wall, and put it in the closet. It is staying there until they wake up and come to their senses. That is so asinine. What are those people even doing on the faculty? Even if it’s a publicity stunt, what are they doing?

**Fitts:** They are receiving printed money from the central bankers.

**Farrell:** Probably! To get rid of Beethoven and Duke Ellington and John Denver and anybody who uses a music score to write down their music on. This is ‘nuts’; this is just totally ‘nuts’!

One of my Facebook responders posted, “So now we are getting rid of Miles Davis and Louis Armstrong?”

So my diploma is staying in the closet. I have never been so outraged, livid, and ashamed that anything like that would be going on in a major academy in the world, especially that one; that is the oldest university in the English-speaking world.

**Fitts:** I think that the printed money and the mind control is messing up everything.

**Farrell:** It's unbelievable to me.

**Fitts:** We stacked up in the **Inspiration** section many of our favorite videos from the last 5-10 years. One that I repeated, which I just love, is called *Great Big Story: The Friends Who Planted 10,000 Trees*. It's about two Chinese men – one who is blind and one has no arms or legs.

**Farrell:** I think I've seen that.

**Fitts:** You have because we've discussed it before. They are sitting around, and have no income or jobs. They are somewhat destitute. They look around, and their village has deteriorated badly. So they think, "What can we do to help our village?" So, they decided they would plant 10,000 trees.

The blind one can climb the trees, and the one who is lacking the legs and arms can watch and yell out to him. So, you have these two people who together have the skills of one person when they work together. They planted 10,000 trees. They don't have enough money to buy seeds, so they use stripped seedlings.

With all the grafting, they planted 10,000 trees, and the trees all died. But they don't give up because they said they learned from that how to do it. Then they planted another 10,000 trees, and that saved the village.

You watch it, and think, "What is my excuse?"

**Farrell:** Start a website; do something; go out and take pictures; sell your music; play guitar at a coffee house, but do something.

**Fitts:** You had many great blog posts this quarter, and many very inspiring blog posts.

**Farrell:** I want to credit my readers here. Every article that I blog about on my website is something that one of my readers has sent me.

**Fitts:** It's the same here.

**Farrell:** I started out doing internet searches and blogging that way, but soon I started getting all these articles that people were sending me. Over the years, it has evolved into this kind of community-driven thing.

Those are what people send me, and I'm so grateful to everybody.

You are probably in the 'same boat': I wish that I could blog about all of them. It's simply sifting through all of that information, trying to figure out every week, "Should I talk about this or should I talk about that?"

It's amazing the amount of information that, even with my Honorable Mentions page on Saturdays, I'm not even scratching the surface of what people are sending me.

**Fitts:** If you come into the web presentation for *Part I* and *Part II*, we have the TablePress of all the headlines. We collect every day the headlines, which is a huge job. We put the headlines in these tables, and then mark some of them as 'WU' for *Wrap Up*. So, we take out about 10-20% that we think are important enough for the *Wrap Up*, and it's from working with those and looking at them that the stories emerge.

**Farrell:** That is exactly what I do every week.

**Fitts:** Many of those are sent in by the subscribers. What is amazing is that I think I understand what is going on, and then I see the flow of what comes in – particularly the ones that the subscribers find. Then I go through them, go over to you, and we comb through them again.

When I finish the process, it's as though, "Whoa!"

**Farrell:** You are in a different place than you thought you would be. I am constantly astonished at what people are finding. I cannot predict from one week to the next what it is going to be. More often than not, I'm astounded at how I missed this or that.

**Fitts:** Absolutely. It's amazing. It's like we are becoming an intelligence network.

**Farrell:** In a way, we are. We are like the old newspaper clipping agencies, but an internet version. There is so much to analyze and sift through.

The interesting thing is you can tell that the people sending you these articles have a big picture because of what they are sending you. I don't know how else to describe it, but it is definitely happening. We are but two websites, but magnify that worldwide, and you get the picture.

**Fitts:** It was amusing. I was doing one interview this quarter, and the host was flipping through *The Injection Fraud Wrap Up*, and said, "It's incredible. There are no ads."

I said, "When the President gets an intelligence briefing from the CIA, his briefing document doesn't have ads in it."

There is a difference between news and an intelligence briefing. The government doesn't do open source intelligence briefings, and that is what we seem to be doing.

**Farrell:** That is the best kind of 'boots on the ground' analysis.

**Fitts:** I would never have been able to understand the pandemic if I didn't have an incredibly rich, tsunami of information coming from doctors and hospitals. It was mostly in the beginning with the scientists and the doctors and the medical people. It was flowing in, and it was flowing in from all over the world, and it was different in different places.

**Farrell:** It was the same here.

**Fitts:** I'm beginning to feel like we have enough eyeballs on the world to really get a good, grounded perspective.

**Farrell:** I do, too. The comfort in that is if they take us out, there will be another website that will come in to take over. It's not going to go away.

**Fitts:** Right, but if they take you out, who can I talk to?

**Farrell:** There are many people. If that happens, they reform the community somewhere else, and that will happen.

**Fitts:** I have a prejudice, so I am sending prayers of protection over you.

**Farrell:** Thank you. I appreciate that, and I do the same for you.

**Fitts:** So looking back on the first quarter, give me the big picture. What did the first quarter mean to you? What did you learn in the first quarter? If you had to bring it down to just a few sentences, what did the first quarter mean to you?

**Farrell:** That is easy. I found myself, after the inauguration of the 'Bidenenko' Administration, saying, "What a sham, the whole thing was theatre!"

**Fitts:** But the thing was they looked so afraid; they looked 'scared to death'.

**Farrell:** They should be. They know they are not there legitimately. They know that.

My big thing about the first quarter is strange because I found myself catching myself doing this, and what I was catching myself doing was not reacting; I was amazed. It's been that way for most of the quarter.

With all of this 'defecation storm' chaos – and I want to use another word, but I'm trying to remain polite here – I've been sitting back and laughing at it because it is 'sound and fury', and much ado about nothing, in a certain sense; it's all theatre. You can tell these people are scared, and they know that this has either got to work or their 'goose is in deep doo-doo'.

I'm just doing my own little 'Zen thing' here. I'm starting to relearn some more pieces on Bruno that I used to play.

I thought, "Wow! Widor is not easy to play". This is a person who managed to make his slow movements extremely difficult. That was a neat little moment for me. I think it is partly because I'm so disconnected from caring one whit about what anybody in this absurd infantile government does or thinks. I'm not paying a bit of attention to it.
