Catherine Austin Fitts: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to *The Solari Report*. This is **Part II** of the **2nd Quarter 2021 Wrap Up** with Dr. Joseph Farrell. We had a great conversation in **Part I**. **Part II** is a ‘real doozy’ if you see what we are getting into. We will get into science and culture and space.

Joseph, welcome to *The Solari Report*.

Dr. Joseph Farrell: Thanks for having me back.

Fitts: I want to remind everybody in the commentary on the homepage there is a link to the web presentation. Each **Wrap Up** we do, we build it on a special web presentation, and we will be working from the **Part II** stories.

The *News Trends & Stories* team does an incredible job going through all of the headlines that we collect throughout the quarter, and you can see them in the *News Trends & Stories* section on the website. If you go to the presentation, we have three stories in *Culture*, two stories in *Science & Technology*, two stories in *Space*, and *Food & Health* is the big one with three stories.

We have a TablePress of all the most important headlines we pulled out in support of these stories, and you can manipulate that dynamically. It’s quite fun to play with.

Our goal is this: If you can only listen to or read Joseph and I ‘chew’ through the *News Trends & Stories*, you will understand what is going on better than most people on the planet. That’s our goal.

We talked plenty about the Going Direct Reset last week, and then we discussed the shift to the multipolar world. As you know, I think it’s the Going Direct Reset that is ‘driving the train’. It’s a reengineering of the governance system and the financial system, but it pops out everywhere.

You’ve taught us that ultimately this fight will be won or lost in the spiritual and cultural realm. So that is where, at first, we have to find our power. I’m glad we are going to talk about that now.

Do you have any thoughts on **Part I** before we dive in?

Farrell: Let's dive in-I think that this will clarify **Part I** quite a bit.

Fitts: Oh, yes!

Culture:

Story #11: The War on God.

Farrell: Let's start.

Fitts: I think that this is about whether or not you resonate with the divine or you resonate with the machine. Mr. Global wants you in the machine. This is a slavery system. I believe that freedom requires an intimate connection with the divine. You have to be plugged into the wisdom of the universe, and you have to resonate with all living things. So, there is a real war.

Can high technology poison us and talk us out of the divine? That is the question.

Farrell: One of the interesting things that I've noted – and I don't know about you – is if you read Mr. 'Globaloney' and the technocrats and the transhumanists and so on, do you notice how little, if any, they ever talk about animals?

Fitts: You have pointed that out to me before, and you're right-it's very strange.

Farrell: There is no place for them other than as guinea pigs for science experiments and miscegenation and all the other chimerical things they want to do. That is a key part of it because I think if you are going to claim to resonate with God, and you don't have any place for the stewardship of animals in that, then you are talking the machine game writ large.

Fitts: They talk about the brain like it's a computer and the body like it's a machine, and it is the strangest thing.

Farrell: They talk about humans the way that the 19th and 18th century people talked about animals; how animals were just a ‘living machine’.

In essence, what they’ve done is reducing humans to the way they view animals.

Fitts: We’re livestock.

Farrell: Exactly.

Fitts: I keep referring back to Ulrike Granögger. She just published Medical Nanobots, Part 1 and Part 2. She had this very interesting video of a professor from Tufts talking about how you can manipulate the physical body of a living thing by manipulating the electromagnetic field; aka the epigenetics.

They have to know that the electromagnetic field exists if they are going to manipulate it, but it’s almost as though they are missing a whole piece. They have no concept of what life really is or how it works.

Farrell: They don’t, and this idea of manipulation of the electromagnetics – and I mentioned this before we started this – I think that much of this goes back to the Soviet era research in the 1970’s where the Soviets discovered that there were electromagnetic signatures that certain diseases gave off. There is also an electromagnetic signature for healthy cells.

They discovered that if you can modulate that signal on a beam, and beam it at something, you can create that disease, or, conversely, you can create the healthy condition. So, you are dealing with something that, in a way, is not all that material is responsible for most of this. I think that is where much of this is coming from.

Fitts: I agree with you. The other thing is that if you study Tesla and study Royal Rife, there is no reason for our medical system to be expensive. We have the knowledge and the technology to have a very economic medical system.

Farrell: Look at what they did to Rife: If you are listening or reading this, and you don’t know the name Royal Raymond Rife, he was a doctor. He claimed to

have invented a microscope that allowed him to see viruses in their living state. That is in part what got him into trouble. The other thing that got him into trouble was that he was trying to treat people with this kind of electromagnetic and acoustic template of energy on diseased and healthy cells, and he was getting some amazing results.

They shut him down; they took away his licensed practice, they confiscated his microscope, and who knows where it is now.

Fitts: They stole everything from him.

Farrell: They shut him down so that we could have our injections.

Fitts: We keep burning down churches. That is the frightening thing. We continue to see these stories.

I think that one of my favorite stories of the last year was a group of people who were denied entrance to their church because of the COVID-19 restrictions. So, they decided to have a worship service in the parking lot of their church. The police came and told them that they had to disperse, but they said, "No, we're having a worship protest."

So, the police left and let them stay.

Farrell: It was all okay because it was a protest.

Fitts: I remember a friend of mine telling me that if you could start a church for ex-Catholic Church members, it would be the biggest church in the world. I feel as though the churches of the world let their membership down over the last year. They showed no faith in the divine. None.

Farrell: It is part of the phenomenon I've mentioned many times on your **Wrap Ups** that people really have to 'wrap their heads around'. It's difficult because people are having to surrender an institutional connection that they have been brought up with to believe in.

Basically, you have to understand that every single organized denomination

within Christianity, bar none, has been infiltrated and coopted by people who do not subscribe personally to the articles of faith of whatever denomination they are in. If you can't wrap your mind around that, then you won't understand why the churches are so lackluster.

Fitts: I think it is very important that each of us take a deep breath, and to a certain extent, forgive the churches. They were part of the red button problem – like all of us – and then you have to believe that we can create new churches, new institutions, new circles, new networks, and we can find like-minded people.

The world is full of friends, and we need to create something that has integrity.

Farrell: That is the flip side of what I was talking about. You also have to understand that every single church denomination has some form of either underground church or organized resistance.

In other words, I go back to my Episcopalian days. I was there when the Episcopal Church took the nosedive off the cliff, and almost immediately, there was a reaction of parishes around the country that simply pulled out of the denomination, contacted numerous people to make their own bishops, and got all of that done. Many of them lost their church property in the process, which left the Episcopal Church with many empty buildings.

That is the other thing to remember: There are traditionalist groups in every single church out there. Not all of them are sane. You can get on, what I call, the 'purity spiral', but many of them are not, and they are relatively sane and traditional in their practice. Those are out there, too. You just have to spend a little time and be willing to ask some hard questions, and be able to discern the answers that you are getting. But all of them are in this, and the COVID thing did more to expose that to many people than anything in the previous six or so years as far as the church is concerned.

Fitts: Do you mean as far as exposing the hypocrisy of the churches?

Farrell: Yes.

Fitts: The good news is that I feel much less alone in the wilderness because you have many, many brave, capable people now saying, “I have to separate from these institutions. They don’t have integrity.”

Story #12: BLM & Other Genocide Cover Stories.

On one hand, we are watching with the Great Poisoning with the Going Direct Reset a series of actions, which I would describe as killing millions of people intentionally – however you want to describe this legally, whether it’s murder or genocide. This is very, very ugly.

The shriek-o-meter has never been more innovative and creative in coming up with these stories to basically overwhelm the facts. I told you in **Part I** that, on one hand, we see 60% of the African-American businesses shut down in America in a year. I think that is economic genocide. Do you know how many people you kill when you’ve destroyed that many businesses? At the same time, we have BLM closing the year with an \$80 million cash balance according to Junious Ricardo-Stanton, and ‘rolling in dough’. They are running around the country irritating everybody and everything.

What is tragic about it is I can’t tell you how many people I’ve run into who are not African-American who think that the African-American community is getting tremendous advantages because of BLM when, in fact, it’s quite the opposite.

Farrell: It is quite the opposite. It’s creating a bad name, and the problem – as I see it – is that what is really happening is a significant portion of the African-American community is not taking the vaccine.

Fitts: Well, they know.

Farrell: They know, and there is no other word that I can put on it other than eugenics as far as this push for vaccines. You have here *Cancel Culture is a Dress Rehearsal for Mass Murder*, and that is exactly what I think it is. It’s the same sort of propaganda that was used by the Nazis against the Jews and so on.

In fact, look at some of those propaganda films where the Jews are portrayed as

‘disease carriers’ and ‘rodents’. They are prepping this narrative now, and I find that very disturbing.

In a certain sense, you are advocating the killing of the very segment of the population that didn’t lose its mind over all of it.

Fitts: Right, but as a control group, they are a threat.

Farrell: Absolutely.

Fitts: I’m afraid that this is going to get much worse. It’s because we are now seeing variants being used as the excuse or the cover-up for vaccine injury. People are getting sick and dying from the vaccinations, and they are saying that it’s a new variant of COVID.

Farrell: The other thing that bothers me about this is I’ve heard people seriously proposing, “Let’s just round up all of the non-vaccinated people and put them on reservations.” I don’t know how true these stories are, but in this culture and climate of fear, this is the sort of thing people start talking about.

In other words, they are creating this climate where you have the vaxxed people and the non-vaxxed people, and the non-vaxxed people are going to be less than the ordinary citizen because of that. So, they require special treatment and special places; it’s a segregation all over again.

Fitts: It goes both ways: There have been many efforts to scare the unvaccinated against the vaccinated.

I told you in **Part I** that I think the number one cause of death and illness right now is fear; fear is causing unbelievable problems.

Because of my unique experience, when the pandemic started, I knew it was a joke and a fraud. I just assumed it was a fraud. I’m used to knowing that something is a fraud and not being able to persuade many other people of this, so I just have to ‘turtle’ through. They believe it’s real, and I know it’s a fraud. I have to ‘turtle’ through until they wake up.

In the meantime, if you can help them, great, but you watch them in their various states of fear. Occasionally, I'm reminded that people are afraid, but since I'm busy and never notice, I realize what a luxury it is to not be afraid. I'm not afraid because of all the training and experience I've had. Unfortunately, I know the fraud is that big and that bad.

Farrell: People need to latch onto all of the stories of doctors refusing to see vaccinated people. They are out there, and you can look them up. That, I think, is a trend that you never hear reported in the 'lamestream propatainment' media.

They are not reporting adverse events or only making a slight bow to them, so take the time to examine some of the alternative reporting out there. You will quickly discover that it's not all 'hunky-dory', and you have doctors refusing to see vaccinated people because of the fear of what they call 'shedding'.

I agree with you. I think that this business of 'the new variant' is their cover story for adverse reactions.

Fitts: I've been waiting to ask you this because your 'big brain' can figure this out: Why are they calling the new variant 'Delta'?

Farrell: I have no idea. The first thing that comes to my mind is that 'Delta' is the mathematical symbol they use for a change in a system.

Fitts: In investment, the delta is the increase in value that you can add by inserting whatever the process is.

Farrell: In physics, it's a change in the system's state of a system. A delta T function is a time function that applies to a system. So I think, "Okay, they've wired this in so that now they can claim that anything that happens by way of an adverse reaction is simply the virus mutating, and we have a change in the system."

I believe it's another big scam that they are trying to pull. We see right now in Israel the delta variant being reported in the vaccinated people. It's going 'off the charts'.

I think, “Gosh, maybe there’s a correlation there, huh?”

Fitts: I was stunned at what happened in Israel. Israel took the worst brunt of this whole thing. Who would have ever believed that would be the case?

Farrell: I wouldn’t. For one thing, where were the rabbis to point out that these vaccines may not even be acceptable under kosher laws?

Fitts: How can they possibly be?

Farrell: I don’t know how true some of these things are, but I’ve seen reports that they have aborted fetal tissue cells in some of these things. I think, “Where were the rabbis? Where was the Pope?”

Fitts: It’s not only that you have aborted fetal tissues; you don’t have full disclosure. How can something be kosher if it’s a mystery?

Farrell: Exactly. It makes no sense to me. There is something going on vis-à-vis the vaccines and the churches (including synagogues and so on). How can that be unless you have so hollowed out the clergy in those institutions to get them to go along with it? It’s a mystery.

Fitts: It’s a control file. I think that one of the amazing things about the digital systems – and the Israelis are at the heart of this – is getting the control files through digital surveillance mechanisms. Let’s face it: From the mid-1980’s onward, as soon as they had PROMIS (Patient-Reported Outcomes Measurement Information System), they were off and running.

The missing money happened after they installed Windows 95. I am told that they did a special series for the government. I don’t know if that is true, but it wouldn’t surprise me.

I think that between pornography and Windows 95, they had a way to get a control file on almost every civil servant in the government. That is what they did. Between back doors and Windows 95 and the control files, there you go; there is \$21 trillion ‘sucked’ right out.

Farrell: Stop and think of those digital control files and their potential relationship to things like the Franklin scandal (child prostitution ring) and so on. I think that you are onto it.

Fitts: I don't know if you remember this, but Kemp was being blackmailed by Cuomo on the Franklin cover-up. I wrote up that story.

Let's dive into mortgage fraud and pedophilia while we are into genocide cover stories. I went into Kemp's office. Kemp and his team had been screaming about the scandals going on in the Reagan Administration, which were called the HUD scandals. They were furious and getting big headlines on how scandalous the Reagan Administration had been because they were giving grants without going through a competitive process, which was not legal.

Kemp called me into his office one day. A couple of the other appointees were standing around. He was in a state of complete panic and terror. He said, "I want you to give this grant to this agency in New York." This was in violation of the competitive bid laws and the process that was promised, but it was also in violation of the Antideficiency Act because HUD was out of money for the year, and to promise next year's appropriations is a violation of the Antideficiency Act.

I said, "Mr. Secretary, I can't do that. That's illegal. Besides, you are on TV saying that you will never do this. The person who runs this unit is a big democrat. Don't think he's not going to tell on you. We can't do this."

He said, "You have to."

I said, "Okay. Let me see what I can figure out."

So, I left. I had an assistant general deputy who was quite savvy in the ways of Washington. He came to me and said, "You've got to be really careful."

I said, "Why do I have to be really careful?"

He said, "There is some really dirty stuff on Kemp."

I said, “Everybody knows about the rumors of Kemp’s AC/DC.”

He said, “No, I’m not talking about that. It’s much worse.”

I said, “Sheep?”

He said, “No, it’s much worse,” which, of course, means pedophilia.

I said, “Oh, God! Okay.”

So, one thing led to another. I was going on a field trip, and received a call from one of my deputies who said that he had an undersecretary – a D’Amato person – to bring everybody to his office so he can figure out how to engineer a grant to the New York agency for Andrew Cuomo’s homeless project.

They got it all done, and the undersecretary called the person running the agency and said they got it done. Then he called Cuomo and said in Italian, “It’s done.”

All my deputies were sitting there, but I was out of town. So, I picked up the phone and called the General Counsel, who was not my favorite person, and said, “Frank, we have 100% chance that this is going to get to the papers. You have to cancel this now.”

So, he did, and it turned out that it was for Andrew Cuomo’s homeless project, and Kemp was clearly being blackmailed. I had never seen a man more afraid.

That story is on the blog (*Solari*). When Cuomo came in as Secretary of HUD, everybody said that he was going to get me for that.

I don’t think that is what happened; I think it was a much larger fight. You had the intelligence agencies and a variety of players, like the Harvard Corporation, taking billions out the back door. So, this was about being able to go back to taking billions out the back door. But it was clear that there was a control file.

That week was the week that the *Washington Times* had the front-page story on call boys (male prostitutes) being taken over to the White House. It wasn’t

until I read the Franklin cover-up that I realized that Jack was totally implicated.

If I had been reading the papers, I would have known, but I was working 18 hours a day and never saw the *Washington Times* headline until later. I didn't realize that the Franklin cover-up had been blown.

I'll tell you another one: If you go onto the website (*Solari*) for subscribers only, which means that you have to be logged on, and go to the library, there is a history of Buffet's investment performance. I'll tell you what I think the number one contributor to Buffet's investment performance was. He bought a paper in Buffalo, but he used the paper in Buffalo to do a complete outing of Boys Town and the management of their endowment. My question on that one was: Is that where Buffet acquired the Boys Town boys? That was the basis of the Franklin cover-up. That is where many of the call boys came from.

Check on the library on my website.

Farrell: If you read John DeCamp's books and Nick Bryant's books on the Franklin scandal, they mention Buffet's influence over the Omaha newspaper.

Fitts: This came out of the Buffalo paper.

Farrell: I know, but they implicate Buffet in trying to help suppress the story. So, it wouldn't surprise me that he is doing 'double-duty' through another newspaper and claiming to break the story while papering over other things.

Fitts: It was a different story-he wasn't breaking the Franklin cover-up. It was the Boys Town endowment. I think that is how he got his 'hooks' into Boys Town.

Farrell: That could be.

Fitts: Payback for that was getting promoted to the *Washington Post* investor and board member. He was a paper boy for the *Washington Post* when he was a child.

It's so amusing because if you look at how the world really works, the idea that

these 'worked hard and rose' is laughable.

Farrell: I haven't believed the Robert Berens stories since I was a child.

Fitts: It's like the rocket. I love the story about your dad not understanding what you meant about the rocket.

Farrell: He understood; he kind-of grunted, like, "What are you going to do about it?"

Fitts: I do get a feeling in the same way that this has come down to COVID-19, the Pizzagate (human trafficking theory) stories really scared them.

Farrell: Yes. They not only scared them, but not even a full year after Trump was in office, he came out with that executive order about the human trafficking. I think it was those two things that really scared them. If there was anything that may have cemented their opposition to Trump, that may have been it.

Fitts: What they are doing through the health ministry is basically saying, "We reserve the right to tell you what genetics you can give birth to, whether or not you can give birth, and we reserve the right to legally own and control the children."

Farrell: That is exactly what they are up to.

Fitts: "We can come into your house and take them out. We can use them for adrenochrome or whatever we want."

Farrell: "And we can give them full protection for minors to consent to taking the vaccine without having their parents involved," which, of course, is nonsense. But that is what they are trying.

Fitts: Right, but the consent for injections will be the first of many different consents.

Finland just announced that sex with someone from age eleven or older was

okay if it was consensual. This brings us to our next story:

Story #13: The War on Sex, Family, and Childbirth.

Did you see that story of them saying that you could grow your child in an incubator that is out in the living room?

Farrell: Yes, I did. That is the objective. They want to have control over, not only how many children you have, but how you get them. I'm totally convinced of that.

Fitts: But how can a child's electromagnetic field and spirit and consciousness grow in a mechanical incubator?

Farrell: I've never told anyone this, but I'm one of these people who has memories of being in the womb. I can remember an episode where my parents were having an argument. I was listening and wondering, "Where are those voices coming from?"

I'm very serious. Lee Marvin, the actor, was another one who had those kinds of memories. I asked the same question that you did: How can you expect to have a normal human child without that connection to the mother and without that connection through the mother to their father? How is that possible?

We are not cattle. For that matter, just look at how animals protect and care for their young. I think this is just nonsense.

The other concern is that by doing these things, we are sexualizing children at a ridiculously young age – before puberty and before adolescence. We are sexualizing children in their innocence. This makes no sense to me because we are robbing people of an essential component of being human.

Fitts: I think the vision is that our intelligence will come from the AI, so we don't need any local intelligence.

Farrell: Yes, but tell me how AI is going to inculcate this basic common human morality.

Fitts: I don't think it will.

Farrell: It can't. If nothing else, it's going to be diabolical, and I mean that in the full sense of the word.

Taking innocent children and robbing them of childhood and shoving them into adolescence years before it actually happens is nonsense.

Fitts: One of the challenges I've had in communicating with other people who I would describe as freedom fighters is that they can't fathom that it's really this bad. How do I help them understand that it's really that bad?

Do you know what is interesting?: The people who live in Eastern Europe who are in totalitarian countries have no problem getting it. They get it totally. It's so much easier to work with them because they understand.

Farrell: Totalitarian ideologies are totalitarian. They want control over every aspect of human life, including its cycles. The one good thing that has come out of COVID are those parents who watched their children on the online classrooms and were actually appalled. I've been trying to 'beat this drum' for years that the school system and teacher certification and all the 'claptrap' they learn in 'education courses' are responsible for this mess. Thank goodness some parents are seeing it firsthand.

Fitts: I'm curious to see how many people just leave the system in late August and September.

Farrell: I think it will be more than they bargained for – especially if, as you suspect, they go full-board in the school systems.

Fitts: You have to assume that they will get a full authorization FDA, and then the schools are going to mandate, and they are going to try to push down the consent age.

The dead giveaway is the reversal they did on the WHO that they had to do recently.

Farrell: It's going to happen. At that point, I think many parents are going to toughen up and pull their children out. I hope they do because these are your children that they are doing this to. This has to stop.

Fitts: There will be no future. It's time for me to have that movie again, *Children of Men*.

Science & Technology:

Now that we know that science and technology are both completely out of control, we can go to our next story:

Story #14: Cyberwarfare Threats Grow.

Especially now that Putin has been given a roadmap of where you're not supposed to go.

Farrell: Now that he knows 'things not to attack'. I sent you that, and your response was they would have had to approve this. While that is true, I have to wonder about this. Mr. 'Globaloney' is also extremely stupid. Somewhere along the line, I can see some technocratic expert thinking that this was a good thing to do; to let Putin know that we are going to be 'really tough' if you attack these things.

Fitts: That's not how you tell someone like Putin what not to attack.

Farrell: Especially Putin. In other words, we told him, "Attack here."

Fitts: I just don't get it.

Farrell: Here is the problem about the cyber threats: This exercise on July 9th, Cyber Polygons, is a drill where they will simulate massive cyber-attacks. Every time they say 'drill', I think '9/11'. Let's nest the real operation inside the drill. I put nothing past these people.

Fitts: What we are talking about today (June 30th), will be published later. We

publish **Part I** on July 8th, and Polygon is July 9th. Then we are going to publish **Part II** on the 15th after Polygon has happened. So, we will know then.

Farrell: Right, but we are recording this before Cyber Polygon. I would not be a bit surprised if there were to be some sort of operation that is dovetailed into the so-called ‘drill’. I would not be a bit surprised if they were to blame it on Putin. He is responsible for all the ills of the world. “Those never-to-be-trusted, always Byzantine Russians.” Nothing would surprise me at this state.

As you have pointed out many times, the problem here is there is no integrity to these cyber systems, bar none.

Fitts: That’s the problem. I don’t know how to build things on something that has no integrity. We all have to use this technology, but that is why I buy hardcopy books.

Farrell: I do the same thing for exactly the same reason. I’ve been against e-books from the beginning. You think the Soviet Encyclopedia was bad? Just wait until they get their ‘hooks’ into your book that you’ve put on an e-book.

Here is the other problem: I don’t see how you can rationalize a commitment to digital currencies and at the same time, be talking about Cyber Polygon and drills and cyber-attacks and so on.

Fitts: That is what is so ridiculous. On the one hand, you are saying that the whole system could fall apart and be destroyed, and on the other side, you are saying, “We want you to move your whole life and all of your money onto this system.”

Farrell: I’m sorry, but that’s not the way it works. It’s either one or the other. I’m with you; these systems have no integrity; they can be hacked.

I don’t care what they are and how blockchain is supposedly the end run around all of this, anything can be hacked.

Fitts: I recently had an interview with Alison McDowell, which I’ve wanted to do for a long time. It was an interview that took plenty of reading and research

because I needed to backtrack on what she had done. I think she has it ‘nailed’. Basically, they want to put every human being on a blockchain. With an operating system in your body, they can make a complete record of your entire 24/7 existence. Every aspect of your existence, they can put on a blockchain, and that is slavery.

Farrell: It is. Since when did they pass a law allowing all of these companies to gather our private personal data? I don’t recall one.

Fitts: They never did.

Farrell: They assumed they had that right, and I don’t think they do. It needs to be challenged.

Fitts: I completely agree- I call it the ‘databeast’.

Story #15: A Mr. Global Three-fer: The Financial Digital System Integrates Mind Control & Surveillance.

The more that I learn about what is in the injections, I believe it’s the last inch of the smart grid. We are talking about a digital system that is doing both the financial transactions, but can simultaneously do surveillance and mind control.

Farrell: Let’s remember the patent that ‘Bael’ Gates put out. (I actually call him ‘Bael Gates’, not Bill Gates.) Let’s not forget the work that Dr. Lieber at Harvard was involved in, and that is to couple vaccination systems with a surveillance system. That is what they were focused on, and that is what they have taken patents out on. They are there, and people can look them up. So, we’re not talking speculation at this point; they have done the research and taken out the patents on this.

Now we are hearing all these stories about these little nanoparticles in the swabs for the PC tests, and on and on this goes. I think the whole thing has been designed, one way or another, through injections or tests, to get some of that material into people’s systems so they can start surveilling.

I am going to ‘walk off the end of the twig’ here, but I also think the 5G rollout

is somehow connected to this.

Fitts: Absolutely.

Farrell: Everything in my intuition tells me that this is a huge system.

Fitts: If you look at the manipulation they are doing on animals in the lab with electrical stimulation, and then you look at 5G relative to what is in the injection, and what is in the food, it is very interesting what is in the swab. I am convinced that the deep nasal tests are dangerous, and the masks are dangerous – if only because you are cutting off people’s oxygen.

The problem that we have now is that you have to be very careful where you buy things because you have no idea what could be on it. I don’t know if you ever read the stories of Amazon and the nanodust.

Farrell: I have. I have to tell you that I used to be of the mind that buying produce from Mexico was a bad idea, but not anymore.

Fitts: The deterioration of the food quality in the United States is unbelievable.

Farrell: It’s off the charts.

Fitts: And pharmaceuticals, too. You know that a big portion of our pharmaceutical ingredients come from China, and they don’t begin to have quality control. It totally changes the nature of what you buy and where you buy. You have to be very, very careful.

I think that the challenge for most subscribers – and this is a challenge that I’ve always had and you’ve always had – is that there are people who disappear into the official reality, and it becomes increasingly difficult to work or communicate with them.

One of the things I found that has helped me tremendously is if I know somebody who disappeared into the official reality, I know I can love them, and I can be responsive if they ask me a question or they want my help. Otherwise, I

basically have to stay as far away from them as possible because it's a question of bandwidth. We have to use our time productively, whether we are having fun or we are working. We need to have fun and work with people who we can get something accomplished. There is nothing to be accomplished by debating the official reality with someone.

Farrell: I'm in the 'same boat'. All we can do is plant seeds. We can't win an argument. We have to get that operative principal 'drilled into our heads' because sometimes people will wake up, but they will wake up down the line from something that you may have said or suggested at a point in time. I've had that happen to me over and over again, and many of those people who are part of the official narrative, I have found it usually takes one thing – and it may be something completely unexpected – that wakes them up and gets them out of it.

I don't know what example to give. I think of Senator McCarthy. I've had people tell me that those things were an eye-opener to them.

Fitts: That one was a big one! When you told me that McCarthy was getting into Area 51, I was thinking, "What?"

Farrell: That was an eye-opener for me, too. It's little things like that that may wake people up to the fact that the narrative they've been told and the actual reality are two different things. It doesn't matter what it is, but it can happen to many of those people. You just have to plant the seeds and let them grow as they will.

Fitts: While we are on Mr. Global's Three-fer, Sofia Smallstorm has repeatedly put me onto the science and the ideas that if you install an operating system in a human being, you can store massive amounts of data on DNA, and you can use people as an energy source. So, if CBDCs (Central Bank Digital Currency Tracker) are very energy-demanding, you can basically put the blockchain in a person. My blockchain with all my data can be on me.

Farrell: And guess who has a patent on that very thing using human DNA as data storage and energy?

Fitts: Microsoft. That's why if you look at my computer, you won't find any

Microsoft.

Farrell: Unfortunately, I am stuck with it as my operating system, but I don't blame you at all.

Fitts: Create an intention that you can evolve beyond it.

Farrell: I hope so, eventually.

Fitts: Once in a while I have to download Skype to do an interview, but then I wipe it off.

One brilliant academic sent me something called the 'cardiogenic protocols' or something like that, which is the set of protocols that determine the rules by which GMOs can cross borders.

One of his questions was, "Do we need vaccine passports because the injections cause people to become GMOs?"

Farrell: That makes sense. I don't know if you recall this, but a few years ago there was a story that they were working on, figuring out a way to put vaccines into GMOs. Do you remember that story? It was three or four years ago when that came out.

In other words, take the food supply, and turn it into a blockchain data management surveillance system and an updatable vaccine and so on, and there you are; you have completely corrupted the food supply, and I wouldn't put it past them that if they are going to mandate vaccines, they will mandate things for your food supply as well.

Fitts: Here is the thing: Once you let them get an all-digital financial system, they can mandate everything, and you are a slave.

I think it's hard for people who have grown up in the G7 democracies to understand what that could be like. "But don't worry; you'll be happy."

Farrell: "You will own nothing, but you will be happy."

Fitts: Schwab (Charles) has really blossomed into a ‘creepy guy’. It’s quite remarkable.

Farrell: I call him Ernst Stavro ‘Bloschwab’ from the *James Bond* movies because he looks like Ernst Stavro Bofeld, and he talks like it.

Fitts: Right, so it’s really Nazi International.

Farrell: Oh, don’t get me started! He has some interesting connections in his background!

Fitts: We are moving onto the next category:

Space:

Story #16: Space Is about Controlling Earth: Who Controls?

Let’s dive in. You ‘rocked my world’ recently. Tell everybody about the NATO story.

Farrell: NATO has come out and clarified Article V, which is the NATO article saying that an attack on one country is essentially an attack on all. They have clarified Article V to extend it into space so that NATO will respond to any attacks or provocations, “To, from, or within space.”

That means that if you are an Earth-based nation or power and you attack a space asset that belongs to a NATO country, NATO is involved. It also means that if you have an asset in space and are attacking the Earth from there, NATO is involved. It’s the ‘within’ category that suggests to me that they are not thinking only in terms of human attacks. The way I read it is they are trying to send a message to whomever – be it an Earthly power (China or Russia), or somebody else – that they will respond as an attack on NATO.

Fitts: This is interesting because this puts NATO over the Russians. If you look at the extension of the NATO umbrella to impinge on the Russians, this is a major impingement.

Farrell: It's a major impingement of every country that is not part of NATO. In other words, it is an impingement on India, China, Russia, Japan, and all of them. They are all involved in that blanket statement. So, they are making the power play for space. I think that this is intimately tied to your idea that the Great Reset and the plan/'scamdemic', and the financial governance of the world, is all tied together, and NATO just announced it.

Fitts: It's a winner take all problem.

Farrell: It's a winner take all proposition that they just put out there.

Fitts: That is their challenge in space. You either create a commitment that space cannot be weaponized and all nations hold to it, or one country has control, and that's it. But whoever gets control, controls the planet.

That's the difference. Sovereignty in a world where one can't control from space is a very different world than a world where one can.

Farrell: It's the high ground, just like Lyndon Johnson said. Whoever controls it, controls the world. That is why there is the big scramble for the moon.

Fitts: Absolutely, it's the watchtower.

Farrell: Precisely.

Fitts: One of the things that has come out since I wrote *The State of Our Currency* is that I've had so many people come to me and say, "I always thought your focus on space was inappropriate."

They had the impression since after the Kennedy assassination that space was old, and it was over and done. It's almost like there is a force field over it.

Farrell: I go back to my presentation in Bastrop, Texas during the Secret Space Program conference. It's clear to me that if you look at certain old, ancient texts with space lenses on, they are talking about some sort of quarantine zone around the Earth – a space demilitarized zone. I think that is

part of the calculus here with this NATO Article V clarification. They're not just sending messages to people here on Earth; they are sending messages to anybody out there.

Fitts: Here is the question: What is the relationship? If the breakaway civilization is breaking in, what is the relationship between the dollar reserve governance structure and the breakaway civilization?

Farrell: That breakaway civilization, as you know, was financed by an enormous hidden system of finance. That is going to buy you plenty of technology over time that you don't necessarily have to reveal. The other thing about that technology is you want to prevent proliferation of it from people tinkering around in their garage, so to speak. So, if you're going to bring that technology out, you have to install a global surveillance structure in order to monitor that problem alone. And that is what they are doing.

Fitts: Exactly. Mr. Global does have a problem because the technology that is now being applied is highly dangerous.

Farrell: They've been struggling with this problem – quite literally – for over a century with Tesla. People have to wake up and understand that they've been dealing with this problem for at least a century, and that it's not going to go away. They factor it into their calculations.

Fitts: It's suspect. You can't understand our world until you realize that the choice to use oil and gas is a political choice. So, if they are so worried about carbon, why have they intentionally used oil and gas when they didn't need to?

Farrell: Let's go back to the fact that it was the Rockefellers who first put out the idea that petroleum was a limited resource and that it was a fossil fuel. I've never been on that bandwagon. It's a ridiculous narrative, but it's one designed to suit their financial and political purposes. Space is the same thing.

I go back to something that I've said many times in these **Wrap Ups**. If you are Mr. 'Globaloney', and you have quadrillions of dollars' worth of derivatives 'sloshing around' on the books, and then all of a sudden, "Lo and behold, we've found an asteroid out there that's worth \$14 or \$15 quadrillion," space is part of

their calculation even in this financial meltdown that they've caused.

Fitts: Space will solve the financial fraud problem.

Farrell: Right, and it may be that they don't go out there and actually mine the asteroid; they just pretend to.

Fitts: All you need is to mark it up. It's amazing the places that collateral fraud will take you.

Farrell: Collateral fraud, in this instance, is taking them directly to space. That is my point.

Fitts: Absolutely.

A wonderful subscriber in Australia was telling me about this ancient machine in Russia that stops asteroids. It's almost like a three-body problem story. Have you ever heard of this?

Farrell: No.

Fitts: I'll have to find that and send it to you.

Farrell: Do you remember about a month before the Chelyabinsk meteor incident? Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev went on public television a month before the Chelyabinsk meteor incident and was asked, "What should Russia do to defend itself against asteroids?"

His response was, "Russia needs to build an international community to create an international asteroid defense system." Then he went on to say, "But, if Russia can't get people to agree with this, we will have to build one ourselves."

I listened to this, and thought, "Okay."

Then the reporter asked, "How would we do that? How would we defend against asteroids?"

Medvedev was very nonchalant, as ‘cool as a cucumber’, and said, “Well, we can use our thermonuclear missiles, and we have other means of doing it.”

I’m sure the reporter was wondering exactly what I was wondering, “Okay, Dmitry. What are those other means?”

Of course, he didn’t follow up with the question, and Dmitry Medvedev never answered it, but I thought that given the strangeness of those remarks just a month before the Chelyabinsk meteor incident, which was on television all over the world, “What exactly is going on there?”

Fitts: The thing that I love about the Russians is that they let a great deal slip out.

Farrell: They do, and they do it in these wonderfully deliberate ways to make you stop and think.

The other incident that I can think of is when those two satellites – one American and one Russian – collided. Do you remember that a few years ago? Neither Russia nor the United States is going to put up a satellite in orbit where they would collide. So my question is: Did we or the Russians put up a satellite and maneuver it into position to collide it with the other satellite? Well, both governments are denying it.

So, who is ramming those satellites together up there, and what are they using to do it?

Fitts: For many years, I’ve always said that one of the great fortunes in the 21st century would come from the person who solved how to clean up space debris. Lo and behold, a year ago, a company started in Zurich that is dedicated to cleaning up space debris.

I told one subscriber in Zurich, “Go over there and see if they will take an investment.”

Farrell: If I recall correctly, the company wasn’t being terribly forthcoming on how they proposed to do that either.

Fitts: No, and they were very private about it. I determined that the person who figures that out will make a large amount of money.

Before we go onto **Asian Space Programs**, do you have anything else about who controls?

Farrell: Right now, space is a mystery. No one individual power on Earth controls it. Certainly, the United States is way ahead, but it by no means has a monopoly on it. So, that is problem number one; nobody does control it.

If there is that kind of control, it will have to reside with an entity or entities with some quite sophisticated technology that is ‘off the books’. We could have any number of players – breakaway civilization, Mr. Extraterrestrial, who knows?

Fitts: Here is what we know: The technology that is functioning in our world is way beyond what you are taught in school and way beyond what you read about in *The Economist*.

I want to show one thing: I think that one of the most interesting issues of our day is how we are going to create a framework for the law in space.

We did an extensive article in October 2015 on the state of law in space, and attorney Matt Hale did an update that we published in November 2020 called *Issues and Framework of U.S. Law Concerning Outer Space – An Update*, and it’s here. These issues are fascinating. Of course, it goes back again to who controls.

Farrell: The bottom line there is if you look at the response of governments to space law, they all admit that they have to do something. But they are so slow in doing this that space is being privatized at a tremendous speed.

Fitts: They are privatized with taxpayer money.

Farrell: What I fear you will see happen is the space version of the old East Indies Companies – the French East India, Dutch and British – or you are

going to have corporations that assert private jurisdiction and establish their own courts.

Fitts: Right, and they will have their own armies.

Farrell: These things eventually become rolled over into the governance structure. That's the way I see things going right now.

With private jurisdictions, you will see a kind of Wild Wild West situation out there for a while. Let's hope they don't pick fights with people they shouldn't be picking fights with.

Fitts: But I think they will. I don't see how they avoid it.

Farrell: I don't either.

Fitts: It's interesting because one of the things you saw in Washington was people who were trained and experienced at exercising real power, and they operated completely differently than people who had no experience or training exercising power. It was the ability to think strategically over long periods of time.

I assure you that if they use the East Indies model, we will get the inability to think strategically.

Farrell: I think so, too, because they are literally in a mad rush to go out there and mine asteroids – either fraudulently and say that they have or do it in reality – because they have too much paper on the books, so they have to do it. My fear is that they are going to go out there 'guns blazing'.

Fitts: There is another fear I have. Have you ever studied the Darien scheme (attempt to establish a colony on the Isthmus of Panama)? Basically, they bankrupted Scotland. The way the Brits finally got their mitts into Scotland was by bankrupting them on the Darien scheme. If you look at our society, we are making enormous bets on space. Essentially, we have decided to leave everybody who thought they were going to get nursing homes and healthcare, and leave them 'high and dry', and instead, use the money to go to space.

So, we are making a civilization bet that we can become a multi-planetary society and grow up. That is a considerable investment, and yet we are making it with a cultural approach, which does not have that strategy and culture, which means that the chances of failures are increased dramatically. That means we will have done massive pain and massive financial fraud and massive violations of many of the laws of civilization to make this bet, and then we will mess it up.

I would argue all day long that making a bet on space is a good bet if you do it right, but if you do it wrong, that is a big, big problem. You are back in the Darien scheme.

Farrell: Not only that, but you are essentially taking the idea of corporate private jurisdictions and rivalries. Let's not forget that those East India companies fought each other. You are making a bet on being able to control that somehow, and I don't see it happening.

Fitts: You can't control it. Even more so, you are talking about breeding up people in incubators without morphogenic fields and without mothers who have Neuralinks and get their intelligence from AI. You are talking about creating an entire society of idiot savants. How are they going to make wise, strategic decisions?

Farrell: On top of that, let's throw in the final 'monkey wrench': What if they go out in space and find somebody out there? What if there is already an alien on those asteroids that they want to mine? This is the problem. I don't know about you, but I don't want to have a group of corporations with a happy 'trigger finger' in control of that situation with a pack of idiot savants. That's bound to go badly.

Fitts: To make great civilizational bets, you need great leadership and you need great governance.

Farrell: And we don't have anybody that I can tell that is thinking in terms of space and showing that kind of leadership – not the Russians, not the Chinese, nobody that I can see here on Earth. Nobody is thinking these problems through to the degree that they need to be thought through. So, we are creating

a mess.

Fitts: Sean Parker is the example I used in the transhumanism conversation that you and I recently had, which was very popular. I'm reminded again of how few people understand that is really happening. I want to read you the exact quote. Do you know who Sean Parker is?

Farrell: No, I don't.

Fitts: He was the founding president of Facebook, so he is one of the Facebook billionaires. This was the quote that I used in our transhumanism commentary. In 2017, he said in a public interview, "Because I'm a billionaire, I'm going to have access to better health care. I'm going to be like 160, and I'm going to be part of this class of immortal overlords. You know the expression about compound interest. Give us billionaires an extra hundred years and you'll know what wealth disparity looks like."

So how much of what we're watching is being driven by the fact that these people think they can live to be 160 years old? Remember that last year the average life expectancy dropped a year. So, as their life expectancy is going up, the general population's is going down. People will notice that they are living to be 160 when we are living to be 80. How much do you think that is driving us?

Farrell: I think most of it is. In fact, virtual immortality is something that I warned about in my very first book in this series of alternative books. He summed it up very adequately. If you have that kind of lifespan, you are able to absorb and pass on much more information. We have to recycle all of human knowledge every 20 years or so. If you are living to be 160, that necessity of recycling expands, and you don't have as short of a period to do it, and you have a longer period per individual lifespan to learn things.

The spiritual condition that you are in in that state of virtual immortality can go one of two ways: You have the possibility of a saint who is able to do whatever it is that they are doing for many more years, and by the same token, you have the possibility of Adolf Hitler or Joseph Stalin or Chairman Mao doing evil for that amount of time.

Fitts: Imagine Netanyahu at 150.

Farrell: Exactly. I think it acts as a magnifier of your innate spiritual tendencies. So, if you are already inclined to materialism and evil, that is going to be magnified, just like in that man's quotation.

Fitts: I was just recording with Thomas Meyer on Ahriman. I can't imagine 160 years of channeling Ahriman.

Farrell: That is what we are faced with. St. John Chrysostom is the one who talked about this in relationship to ancestral sin. He said that death is what gives us the possibility for repentance. In other words, there is a spiritual connection to this virtual immortality, and that is why – in my opinion – you see so many of these people who think it's really good also involved in some of the most evil things imaginable. They think it's their ticket to do more of it.

Fitts: We are getting a culture of people who are not self-aware.

Story #17: Asian Space Programs Are Shifting Global Geopolitics.

There is no doubt about it. If you look at the speed at which the Asian space programs are moving, it's remarkable and dazzling.

Farrell: It is remarkable and dazzling, but it's a big problem for Mr. 'Globaloney', particularly if you think of Mr. 'Globaloney' in terms of the Anglo-American deep state.

Fitts: But they created China this time. They put the money in and transferred the intellectual capital in.

Farrell: They created China, but do they control China? I don't think they do.

Fitts: I don't know.

Farrell: It's like the Molotov-Ribbentrop Pact (non-aggressive pact between Nazi Germany and the Soviet Union). You are enabling each other, but you both know that at some point, you are going to turn against each other. That is

what the China deals back in the 1970's were all about. They both knew that they were making a bargain for the short- and mid-term, but that it wasn't going to last.

Fitts: There is no way Mr. Global is not going to bring China to heel. So the question is: How do they do it?

Farrell: Good question. Part of it has to be in space, and part of it I think we are already seeing. We are already seeing what I believe is weather warfare going on in China with the floods and the disruption of the economy.

Fitts: Tack on the food supply. China's weakness is food and water and keeping everybody employed.

Farrell: The other thing that Mr. 'Globaloney' certainly knows is that China's demographics are in a very dangerous spot now because the population is getting progressively older and it's not being replaced.

Fitts: When I did the pension fund **Wrap Up**, at that point the U.S. had 25 times more retirement capital in our pension and retirement systems than they did. Essentially, they had no retirement savings system whatsoever other than the family.

Farrell: And their population is getting older. So, in the next 10-20 years, they will be hit with the demographic crunch. It is going to put a severe shock on their economy.

You couple that demographic problem with the weather warfare, the food supply, and the automation, and China's not looking as good.

Fitts: If the family has to support the elderly, then the youths need to work. But if you automate and there are no jobs, how do you deal with that?

Farrell: Look at the thousands of miles of high-speed rail that China has built, and couple that with the demographic prices that they are going to be facing. So, how do they maintain that very expensive infrastructure in that kind of situation?

China is not looking too good over the long-term. If Mr. 'Globaloney' 'plays his cards', there are any number of ways they can exacerbate the situation for the Chinese.

Fitts: Do you think the Silk Road will continue?

Farrell: No, I don't. If it does, it is going to be profoundly modified from what Mr. Xi wants. He wants it to be his imperialism ticket, and ultimately, I don't think that when you put Russia and Germany and France into the mix, that will not survive in its current form. They just won't let it.

Fitts: Let's turn to **Food & Health.**

I haven't put anything in here about the injections, but before we start on **Story #18**, I want to talk a bit about the COVID-19 injections because this is a very significant threat facing everybody listening or reading this.

I want to walk through what my understanding is of what is occurring with the injections, and this comes primarily from the Doctors for COVID Ethics, which is a group of mostly European and U.K. scientists and doctors who meet once a week. They have a website, and they publish their research.

They've been doing Notices of Liability to the European Medicines Agency. They did it to the entire European Parliament when they were considering passports. They sent individually – office by office, person by person – Notices of Liability for crimes against humanity. They delivered a Notice of Liability to all of the German doctors.

They continue to do amazing things, and they have a very good website. They are extremely careful. Their whole position is: What do we know that is fact that we have the research and backing to say?

Obviously, the questions about these injections are brought up. Everybody has more questions than they have answers. I want to walk through what we know:

We know that the population has herd immunity, and there is no reason for

vaccinations.

We know that there are low-cost and longtime usage pharmaceutical therapies that are highly effective such as ivermectin and hydroxychloroquine, so there is no reason for an injection – let alone one on an emergency authorization.

We know that these were rushed out without the proper trials – no animal trials. The last time they did animal trials with a coronavirus vaccine, all the animals died. So, there is nowhere near the number of trials and testing that you need.

Farrell: There has been absolutely no long-term intergenerational study of the effects of these vaccines. None.

Fitts: 4. We also know that we don't know what the ingredients are.

We know that the process by which these injections are being given do not meet any basic standard of informed consent, with rare exception.

So, you have a mystery potion being injected on the theory that you need it when, in fact, it's impossible that anybody needs it considering the medical facts. So there is no need, and based on no need, we are being given a mystery potion.

Here is what we know it does:

We know the spike proteins tear away at the vascular wall and create blood clots, and then those blood clots – whether they show up in the heart or the brain or different places – create heart disease or neurological damage, much of which is rather frightening to watch.

I would point out that this is extremely expensive as well. When you take the breadwinner of a family and destroy their ability to work and saddle them with a long-term disease for which no one knows a cure, you are talking about a family losing \$2 to \$5 million over a lifetime. This is a bankruptcy event. You are talking about financially bankrupting and destroying whole families.

The amazing thing about all of this is the spike proteins go into the brain where the coronavirus can't go. So, why do we need something that goes into the brain when the coronavirus doesn't go there?

We know that it also doesn't go into the vascular system. It goes into the lungs, but the spike proteins can't get in the lungs because they are in the vascular system and the brain.

It's like me putting the seeds on your front lawn when they are needed on the back lawn. So whatever this is about, it has nothing to do with SARS- CoV-2 that I can tell.

Then there are serious issues. I won't try to explain them, but there is a new article going up on the Doctors for COVID Ethics website that basically says the way the antibodies inspire you, they make you react in the wrong way. You are fighting the wrong fight in the wrong way, and it could make it worse when new strains come.

Every year when the flu comes around, you could have lost your ability to fight that flu. So, there is a revving up of your immunity system in a way that makes you more vulnerable to the next virus, not less.

Then we get to the worst problem, which is the concern of lipid toxicity. We saw this come out on the Japanese. There was a FOIA of a Japanese study. On the Doctors for COVID Ethics website, you can learn more about this. You have toxicity going into certain organs, including the female reproductive organs. It looks like it is likely that we are talking about creating infertility.

Here is the magic trick to this: If this is correct, they knew it. This is not something that you don't know before you start. It appears that there is no way that they intentionally are forcing injections in very aggressive ways that are not needed unless you are trying to sterilize the population.

So, we have to seriously ask the question: Is the goal of this vaccination program to dramatically lower the birth rate?

Farrell: Yes, I think it is. I don't see how you can avoid that conclusion, especially when you factor in people like Bill Gates being involved with all of this. He is a depopulation person, and he is a eugenicist from the get-go. I don't see it being anything else.

I've seen reports of preadolescent girls who have received injections, and they start bleeding from their vaginas. So how is this not known and understood?

I've seen studies suggesting that this could create prion disease, bovine spongiform encephalopathy, and mad cow. There are all sorts of studies out there about these things, and you can't tell me that these studies were done overnight.

Fitts: Here is the other thing: If you look at what we know-what we don't know is much greater than what we know.

If you look at the reporting systems for vaccine injury, the pressure on doctors and healthcare practitioners to not report vaccine injury is so strong that it tells me the hospitals are terrified and the medical malpractice insurance is terrified. If you look at the informed consent rule, this kind of liability is not protected. These are massive violations of informed consent laws and disclosure laws.

Farrell: Right, and it's not just hospitals and healthcare businesses that are implicated in it; the media is as well.

Fitts: I'm still trying to get my 'head around' this. I still think they are trying to download an operating system that they can use for the financial system. So, I think there is more going on than what I'm talking about here.

If sterilization – whether it's temporary or permanent – is a goal here, I don't see how mind control can persuade people that it's not a problem.

Farrell: I don't either. I said this in the last quarterly **Wrap Up:** We are just on the cusp of the beginning of adverse reactions. In five to ten years, it is going to look like a wasteland in terms of the reactions to these things, particularly in people of childbearing age.

If it can affect female fertility, it can also affect male fertility. Sooner or later, when parents find out why they can't have babies and doctors start asking questions like, "Did you take the COVID vaccine?" that will be it. So, I do think that this is a depopulation/sterilization agenda, too. I don't have any doubts about that.

Fitts: We talked about this before. I told you about the Kiwi Dairy Company. I think it's New Zealand, but it could be Australia. It is the a2 Milk company, and they were traded off on their earnings report because their Chinese competitor who makes infant formula lowered their earnings projection, saying, "Because of the vaccinations, women would not be able to have kids."

They seemed to imply on the report that it was a 'delay', and not permanent. But I really think that everybody listening or reading this who owns shares in a consumer product company that makes money from babies ought to call investor relations and start asking questions because under the securities law, if this is going to lower their sales and earnings, they are required to disclose that. I think there is an absolute way to hold people accountable through the securities law for this.

Farrell: I totally agree.

Let's stop and think: Even if these vaccines are causing female infertility that is temporary, how long is 'temporary'? Females, after a certain age, can't bear children. So, is this a way of blocking that?

Fitts: Remember, they are now proposing boosters every six months. So if it's temporary for six months, but you get a booster every six months, that looks rather permanent to me.

Farrell: Since we are talking about possibilities of adverse reactions here, given the fact that there was no intergenerational long-term testing of the effects of these vaccines, is it possible that we might see an uptick in birth defects? I think so.

Fitts: Absolutely. We know that breastfeeding mothers, after vaccinations, have had their babies die. This is heartbreaking.

One of the things I've seen is mothers with children who are vaccine injured hold themselves responsible and blame themselves for what has happened.

On *The Solari Report*, we have forms that you can link to from the homepage.

The first form that I did was the Family Financial Disclosure Form for COVID-19 Injections. Let's say you have somebody in the family who wants to take it. Basically, the form walks through and forces them (the potential vaccinated) to do due diligence and disclosure. It explains about their healthcare insurance, worker's compensation, disability insurance, and life insurance the time it takes to take care of them if they are vaccine injured, and how they are going to guarantee that their decision to get a COVID-19 injection is not going to translate into the bankruptcy of the family.

You see these people who cannot work because they've been so damaged. They have neurological damage and shaking. Worker's compensation won't cover it even though their employer had mandated the injection, and their healthcare insurance won't pay. So, they have no coverage, and they can't work. It's quite amazing.

The Family Financial Disclosure Form is to help you in a situation where you are trying to force someone in the family to do the proper due diligence, and take responsibility for their actions so that one spouse's stupidity does not translate into the other spouse having to spend 10,000 hours for the rest of their life taking care of them.

The second one was a disclosure form for employers and schools. It's the same thing: Employer mandate says that the healthcare insurance doesn't cover it, and the worker's compensation doesn't cover it. So, this is to hold the employer responsible to either provide those resources or admit that they are not going to before you take the injection.

I've been told by people that they have been able to use it to back up their employer and their school. It works the same way for a school.

The newest one is a Notice and Declaration of Parental Authority Requirement of Disclosure and Safety of Medical Treatments. So, if you are concerned that a school may try to get your child to consent to something without your permission, this is a requirement you put the school on notice that they cannot do that. This is meant to defend you and defend your child going into school this coming year. I think that this is particularly important if the FDA gives a full authorization.

Beneath those three forms is the Take Action Crowdfund. What we've been doing is listing and supporting litigators who are going to the courts and fighting. When you get all the evidence and the expert witnesses, and present it in court, that is part of the trench warfare that is really pushing back, and these groups have done a great job.

We have also listed some of the journalists who are supporting it. There is a quote from me, "Why have more assets, if you don't have an army to protect them?"

I keep telling people that they are planning on taking everything, so you might as well put some money into a fight fund.

That's it on the injections. I think the pressure to get the vaccine rate higher has caused them to change their quota from 70% to 80%. If you look at what they say the percentage uptake is, I think they are totally lying.

Farrell: I do, too. Otherwise, they wouldn't be having these vaccine lotteries and cash giveaways.

Fitts: It's frightening.

Farrell: They are desperate to get people to take these injections, and those things are the sure sign to me that people are backing off and aren't going to do it.

Fitts: I know you've read some of the stories. It's just horrible.

I should also mention that in *Top Videos*, we have some of the best videos, like the three women who couldn't stop shaking. We have their interview with Del Bigtree, which is a life-changing interview.

Story #18: The War on Meat.

The war on meat is part of climate change; F35s are not a problem, but 'cow farts' are.

Farrell: And now they want us to eat insects and Bill Gates' synthetic meats. I have to tell you that I'm glad you did the injection story because who knows what they are putting into that synthetic meat.

Fitts: I can't imagine. I think it's frightening.

Farrell: If they are willing to talk about using GMOs as a vaccine delivery system, they are certainly capable of using meat or synthetic meat as a vaccine delivery system. Who knows what they are going to be putting into that meat.

Fitts: I stopped buying meat at most grocery stores a while ago. It's one thing to buy a whole chicken, but if you are buying hamburger, I think we have reached a sufficiently out-of-control society that you have no idea what's in there.

We did a great interview with Sally Fallon Morrell on synthetic food, and now Pete Kennedy is doing a series of interviews on the *War on Meat* because it's all part of me trying to encourage people to buy food locally, which takes us to **Story #19**.

Story #19: Local Food Demand Grows.

Local food demand is explosive.

Farrell: It is, and it wouldn't be explosive if people could trust their government regulatory agencies, which they can't.

Fitts: The government regulatory agencies were what destroyed the local food system anyway.

Farrell: I've stopped buying any American produce because I simply don't trust it anymore. If I see a little farmer on a street corner selling his pumpkins or whatever, I'll go there. But I'm like you: I will not buy ground beef anymore. I haven't bought ground beef in years.

Fitts: Rogue Food just had a conference in Tennessee, and we were a sponsor.

Now they're going to have one at Polyface Farms. Franklin Sanders is going to go because the Silver & Gold Calculator is a sponsor. Then Claire Viadro who is an editor, and hopefully, Pete Kennedy from Florida, will go. Pete Kennedy hosts our *Food Series*. They are all going to be at Joel Salatin's Polyface Farm in Virginia in August. We are going to encourage everybody to go.

Many people made great connections at the last one. I always tell people, "Find the Weston Price groups and the foodies in your local area because they are there. They are the ones who have been building a local food system, and there is a lot that has been happening over the last 20 years."

Now, finally, everyone is realizing, "I can't trust Mr. Global."

Farrell: I want to add the dialogue that I did in my Members area with Peter about his local group.

Fitts: That is a fantastic interview.

Farrell: They are doing many things with food, so I would suggest that my members watch that interview if they haven't already. That's the sort of strategic local thinking that people need to start doing.

Fitts: They are doing what I call 'circles'. He is doing a circle in a very deeply intelligent way. It's somewhat like, "What can we do today with the people we have here? Let's just start here and see where it goes."

The way that he is doing it can build a whole new world. He is a remarkable person.

If you're not a member of Giza Death Star, it's very easy. Go to the Giza Death Star website and subscribe-go to the Members area. You will not regret it.

Story #20: Happy, Healthy, & Free: We Find the Hero Doctors and Take Responsibility for Our Health.

I have to tell you that we have seen some doctors and scientists stand up in the bravest and most courageous way. We do a hero every week, and it has been

unbelievable. I am meeting some of the finest people I've ever met in my life. I love them! They are so committed to science and truth.

Farrell: Real science, not 'bought and paid for' science.

Fitts: The ironic thing is when it's finance, I can say, "Oh, that's ridiculous." I can look at something, and have no idea whether it's ridiculous or not. But, of course, they do because they are profoundly experienced and knowledgeable about that area. I barely made it through high school biology, and I'm suffering as a result.

Farrell: That would be me.

Fitts: I can't recommend enough American Frontline Doctors and Doctors for COVID Ethics. Those are two of the groups. When you think evil has overrun the world, you realize that there are such great powerful people among us; we just have to find each other.

Farrell: I would aver that this business with COVID – the test case for what we are seeing happening with the plan/ 'scamdemic' narrative – was GMOs and the way they got that through; it's almost a textbook repeat.

I keep harping on the lack of long-term intergenerational testing with these vaccines. That's what we saw happen with the GMOs. Then, of course, the studies came out showing lower crop yields per acre over time with GMOs and increased expense and so on. We are seeing the same thing here.

Fitts: I've seen many really fine doctors and scientists make dire predictions about what the impact of the injections will be four to eighteen months out. I don't know what to think because I've seen so many times when we expected something dire to happen, and yet the grace in the universe interceded and it didn't.

I am hopeful that the dire predictions are not true, but it is also inconceivable to me that you aren't causing a weakening of immune systems and an increase in toxicity from these. That's the best case.

So, there will be more chronic disease, more inflammation, and more ‘dumbing down’. It could just be adverse events among 10% or so of the population, or it could be what some people are saying about years out. It could be very, very bad if they’re right.

Farrell: If it’s only one percent of the vaccinated population, it will be dire.

Fitts: Why do you say that?

Farrell: In this country alone, I think they are estimating now that you have between 150 and 170 million people who have been vaccinated. So, if one percent of that starts having adverse reactions, that is as large as a major city. The financial fallout from that alone is bad, but we are already seeing adverse reactions, and they are not even reporting them all. This is the other problem that you pointed out.

I think we are just at the beginning of this. I think that in 5-10 years, you will see all sorts of weirdness as a result of it, and it could be as little as 18 months, like many of them have predicted. I’m in the dire camp on this one. They are experimenting with something they don’t know. I don’t care how well-informed Mr. ‘Globaloney’ was beforehand, but they don’t know all of what they are tinkering around with and how it will combine and recombine, and where it will go. They don’t know; no one knows.

Fitts: I remember one scientist saying to me something about junky RNA bits. I said, “What does that mean?”

He said, “It means that there is no decent quality control. They are just going fast and being sloppy.”

Farrell: Imagine that – sloppiness with human DNA and RNA-sloppiness! You are tinkering with humanity itself. If nothing else, that invokes some big spiritual problems and penalties.

Fitts: Injecting aborted fetal tissue-it’s clear that the abortion policies are pushing that because the pharmaceutical companies need supply. So, we are watching a process of killing more and more babies to create injections. The

description is that you are basically birthing babies and killing them. That is what late-term abortion is about.

Farrell: In turn, you are exposing a significant segment of the population to all of the dangers of prion diseases as a result. Think of what cannibalism does to populations that practice it; you literally go ‘nuts’.

I think we are only on the cusp of things here, and it will get much, much worse. I hope that if it does get worse, the people behind us will be held accountable before the law.

Fitts: My prediction is my old hologram: You will have some go to the light and some go to the dark. I’m seeing that the people going to the light are gathering and finding each other for the first time in my lifetime in a really powerful way. This is the most positive development I’ve seen in my entire life. That’s why it’s very important to not try to get along with the dark. Let go and find your tribe because there are great things happening.

I told you that in 1998 I said, “I think these guys are going to depopulate down to 500 million. Can I live in a world and be happy when that is going on?”

It took me a while to figure that one out. I had to study spiritual warfare until I came to the conclusion that I could live in a world like that. It wasn’t that I wanted to, but I wasn’t given much of a choice.

Next up is **Unanswered Questions**. We are going to do these fast because we have talked about these many, many times. The **Unanswered Questions** don’t change that much.

Farrell: No, but you have plenty of additional information in your questions and articles that you linked to here.

Fitts: We put links in, but we don’t have to touch on all of the links because we want to get to **Take Action** and **Inspiration** after that.

Unanswered Questions.

I have to brag about the *News Trends & Stories* team. They worked very hard on this, and this time we decided to put some of our favorite links in. It makes it look longer, but if you go to the website, you can access those links and access the top videos, which are also great.

If you haven't accessed the web presentation, it's great.

Question #1: Mind Control: How important is mind control to what is happening?

There are many friends I have who think I overestimate the mind control, but I think it's unbelievably important.

Farrell: I do, too. The reason I think it's unbelievably important is that when people think of mind control, they are primarily thinking of the hard technologies. I think of the soft techniques. There is no better example than of this media campaign that has been ratcheted up beyond all belief with this COVID thing. It is everywhere in this country. It's on the national media and the local media all the time.

Fitts: When I drive around, I try to listen to Dutch talk radio to help me learn Dutch. When they say 'COVID', they say 'COVID' in all languages, and it's amazing how many times I hear the word 'COVID'. I can't believe it.

Farrell: It's constant, and it's all in support of the official narrative. There is no attempt on the local/national media that I listen to- I listen to scores of it just to keep abreast of what they are saying- to deal with any of the alternative science. There is no attempt to mention the doctors you've pointed out or the organizations you've pointed out. None whatsoever. That's mind manipulation.

Fitts: Right, there is no serious discussion of science.

I have to mention that C.J. Hopkins did a great interview with the Planet Lockdown team. They did it with OVAL Media and James Patrick. Hopkins is the person who invented the term 'Covidian Cult'.

Farrell: That's what it is; it's a cult.

Fitts: We also put a link to an old video where somebody was taking a picture of themselves and caught their TV with a subliminal message that says, “Kill.” It’s quite interesting.

Then, of course, the Requiem for QAnon was a great discussion that you and I did.

Question #2: Invisible Weaponry. How important are invisible and secret weaponry and technology to the replacement of global currency systems with crypto control systems?

Farrell: I go back to what I’ve said over and over again: It is perhaps the ‘elephant in the room’. The reason is that these alternative technologies that we are talking about – energy technologies like fusion – are very important to the surveillance system. They have to maintain tight control over those technologies.

Let me tell you why: Think of your standard hot fusion tokamak reactor, like they are building in France. Think of the ITER Reactor. Everybody is forgetting one important question: What happens if that plasma containment were to suddenly break down? For example, what happens if the electric power supply to that tokamak magnet and the ITER fusion reactor suddenly turned off? What happens to that plasma? It’s no longer contained; you have a big explosion on your hands, and I mean big.

It’s crucial for them to have surveillance on everything to roll this out. Just with fusion, you don’t want cyber-attacks against it or power outages happening. You’ve a building redundancy and you have to surveil everybody and anything connected with it. That is only one small example. So, it’s crucially important to the structure that they are trying to build out. They have to have it.

Fitts: You would think if you were taking on this much risk, you would behave a little differently.

Question #3: Invisible Technology. How are invisible technologies being used to engineer civil wars, turn people against each other, and engage in

disaster capitalism?

Farrell: I think immensely. Only with the weather warfare manipulation I think that is occurring, it's hugely important. They are trying to set everybody against everybody.

Fitts: I had an interesting conversation on the website when I was interviewing Sherri Tenpenny. She has very strong feelings as a Christian against homosexuality, and expressed them towards the end of the interview. I didn't respond because that was not the goal of the interview; the interview was almost over. But I didn't want to go there because I'm a bit of a Libertarian.

If you look at what my focus is, I'm very interested in changing those things that impact everybody. Missing money is one of those things; it's \$65,000 per person. I don't have bandwidth for this little group versus that little group.

Those issues are important. I'm not saying they're not important, I'm just saying that I believe if you fix the things that harm us all, it's much easier to work out the other issues. So that's my focus. I don't care about it; I'm just going to focus on the ones that impact us all.

There was a back and forth between a couple of subscribers and me on that. I just said, "I'm just not going there."

I have watched divide & conquer destroy my society. We have the ability to just not go there.

Question #4: Missing Money. Where did Mr. Global invest the \$21 trillion and the \$24+ trillion in bailouts?

We have another up to \$96 trillion, but we don't know if it's undocumentable or unsupported.

Farrell: You know my answer: I think that a large amount of this money has gone to fund covert operations – things like this plan/ 'scamdemic' – but I think the vast majority of it has gone into secret technology research. That's the only thing that can explain the massive amounts of money that we're talking about.

Fitts: Right, and I think to do that, you had to build a whole underground world of underground bases and underground transportation systems.

Farrell: Right, you had to build an infrastructure to support it.

You remember Mark McCandlish who sadly passed away. Do you remember the presentation he did at the 2015 Secret Space Program? Do you remember him talking about the eight-foot long quartz crystals that he claimed was part of this alien reproduction vehicle? I remember thinking at the time, “How expensive would it be to synthesize and grow an eight-foot long slab of quartz crystal and do it with the purity and latticework that you needed to make that work?” That would be enormously expensive.

People keep asking, “Why the hidden system of finance?” The answer is the things that they were trying to do was enormously expensive, and they had to keep it secret. They couldn’t come out with a tax plan for 30 years to tax Americans trillions of dollars. They had to come up with another way to fund it.

Fitts: I did a great interview with Amy Benjamin a couple of years ago on secrecy. If you look at what it takes to do a certain function – like a certain laboratory for secret weaponry – it’s a dollar to do it, but if you do it in a way that keeps it secret, it can be \$10 or \$100. Secrecy is unbelievably expensive. You have to build an entirely independent infrastructure, and you need extraordinary surveillance, etc.

It is prohibitively expensive to do everything on a secret basis.

Farrell: If people who are members of my website want to know the size of installations and the cost, review the interview I did with Tino Von Struckmann who went to Germany and visited those installations and took pictures of those installations in Lower Silesia where they tested the bell.

It was four hours long. I could not believe the sheer size of these things. You look at them and the amount of electrical cabling facilities that were constructed, the cost must have been enormous.

Fitts: When did they build those?

Farrell: In the 1940's, and we are talking about an area that is about 100 square kilometers. I had no idea that it was that big. It's huge. These installations are immense, and the cost alone would have been astronomical.

Fitts: Remember, it was Operation Paperclip that brought all those scientists over here. Our underground base network basically evolved out of what they achieved during World War II.

Farrell: The secrecy alone is increasingly expensive.

Fitts: I did a review of all the locations where there ever has been a report of an underground base, and I tried to estimate where I thought they were. I came up with 130 sites where you probably have an underground base.

Farrell: I can believe it.

Fitts: That's a wild guess, but I think the underground installations are very significant in size and expense. You're essentially talking about a separate civilization. The other question I have is: Are many of the young people who they've been bringing across the border disappearing into those bases? They need a work force.

Farrell: I told you in **Part I** of the **Wrap Up** about my state having legislation to consider preventing the buyouts of land that are being bought by people who want to farm marijuana.

As part of that story on the news, they were reporting that many people were being placed into these farms coming across the border as illegals, and they are basically working in slave-like conditions. I think that you are talking about a vast underground infrastructure, and who knows?

The Nazis used slave labor to build those tunnels and facilities. Who is to say that we haven't as a cost-cutting measure?

Fitts: Question #5: Reality TV & Paid Protestors. Who and what do

you think is the command structure? Who are these guys reporting to, and who is funding this?

This is a very professionally funded and managed operation.

Farrell: I can think of a certain Hungarian fellow whose surname is a palindrome. He is certainly financing it, and that tells me you have Mr. 'Globaloney' financing most of this.

Fitts: But there is no way that these people run around and do what they are doing without the CIA and the Department of Homeland Security controlling what they do and where they go. They are all on smartphones, so they are tracking them the entire way. This is like a human Pokémon thing.

Farrell: I think the exact same thing.

Fitts: They are having this January 6th Commission. The Republicans tried to kill it. They keep trying to come up with this idea of domestic terrorism. It seems to keep falling flat.

My concern is that they are going to use it to steal assets.

Farrell: They've already used it to steal an election, so why not steal a few assets? I think that this is the reason it keeps falling flat. You have these state audits that are now beginning to put some teeth into the stolen narrative.

Fitts: Do you think there is a possibility that they actually could?

In other words, I'm assuming that the audits will be able to prove election fraud. The question is: What can they do with that?

Farrell: That is the question. I don't know what they can do with it, but one thing that I think is already coming out of it is this attempt to federalize elections and so on is dead. It's not going to 'fly' because of those audits.

What I would like to see as a result of them is to make sure that the states step up and do their due diligence and manage their elections like they are supposed

to under the Constitution. But I think this whole insurrection thing is not going to ‘fly’. There are too many Americans – and I’m one of them – who think that the election was stolen. I don’t see how it’s going to happen.

Fitts: Question #6: FASAB 56: How important is FASAB 56 to what is happening?

Farrell: I think it’s extremely important. How can it not be? If you are taking the Federal budget black, that applies to everything. This is the same Federal government that wants to federalize the elections? No thank you, not on my watch.

Fitts: We’ve seen a remarkable development in the last twelve to 18 months of something called the ‘special acquisition company’ where, magically, billions and billions of dollars are poured into blind pools. Then the blind pools merge with a space company, and then voila! What a miracle: The space company has gone public without having to go through the disclosure process.

Farrell: And it’s all by coincidence, too. I have bridges to sell in Manhattan!

Fitts: One of the links here is *Monopoly – Follow the Money*, which was done by this great Dutch researcher who figured out that BlackRock and Vanguard own 5% of everything. It was quite amusing.

Question #7: Poisoning of Populations. Why is there a great poisoning underway in multiple areas?

We talked plenty about this already in *The Great Poisoning*, but I want to point out – speaking of nuclear risk issues – that Japan continues to dump contaminated wastewater into the Pacific. One of the challenges with the deterioration in the governance system is that we are responsible, as a society, to manage all sorts of nuclear waste and other dangerous material. You cannot afford to not have excellence in your engineering if you are going to handle this material.

Farrell: And that excellence in engineering has to be maintained. This is not an infrastructure that you can just build and let sit there. That is the biggest farce

in this infrastructure bill that we've been talking about for the last few months. No one is talking about nuclear waste. Our nuclear waste facilities in this country are a wreck.

Fitts: I'm assuming the infrastructure is: Buy everybody into vaccine mandates. It has nothing to do with building infrastructure; it's the SDR loans. Here they come.

Farrell: Let me tell you about infrastructure for a moment that just 'steams my clams'. Do you know the interstate section after you cross the river here when you came to visit me?. Do you remember how old and outdated that was? Well, they are finally redoing that whole interchange just across the river. They are tearing up highways and they are tearing down bridges. But do you know how long it is going to take for them to finish it?

I am from South Dakota, so this just makes me laugh because there, they do something, and they have to do it fast because of the winters. It is going to take them ten years; ten years! And we are being told that they are building bridge pylons. You can see them- I pass it every day. Some of them won't be completed for two or three years. So, we will have bridge pylons out there that are going to be deteriorating before they put the bridge up.

I am not kidding you. So, I'm 'smelling' kickbacks and all that goes with it.

Fitts: I think that the kickback system has reached a level of dysfunction that we can't manage in modern society.

Question #8: What are the COVID-19 Injection Goals?

What I can't figure out is: Is the primary goal an operating system, or is the primary goal sterilization?

Farrell: I think it's both. I can't see anything else. From Mr. 'Globaloney's' standpoint, they don't need all of these excess eaters. They learned their lesson with the Gulags in the concentration camps, so now they will do it slowly.

At the same time, they want everybody who is left over to have the operating

system. So, I suspect Round Two is going to be targeting the non-vaxxed after they get rid of their excess eaters. That is what I suspect. I know that sounds 'loopy', but there it is.

Fitts: How are those of us who don't want to download Mr. Global's operating system or be sterilized going to organize to prevent this?

Farrell: I would say to take a cue from Peter's (Kennedy) dialogue that I did on my website. That would be number one. Number two, get to know your neighbors. Just sit down and go through your neighbors, and make a list of those you can really trust and who you can't. There are certain people who I will trust all the way, but it's a very narrow circle. There are certain people who I will trust up to a certain point, and that is a much wider circle.

Get to know your neighbors. If nothing else, your neighborhood is going to be crucially important.

A few years ago, I started waving to my neighbors when I was taking the dog out and they were passing up and down the street. Now everybody is used to 'the guy who waves'.

A couple of weeks ago, I was outside with Shiloh, and a neighbor came down the street. I looked up and waved. He stopped his car, rolled down his window, and introduced himself. We had a nice little conversation about neighborhood problems. "What are we going to do about this? What are we going to do about that?"

There are simple little things you can do just like that, and sooner or later, it's going to help you out.

Fitts: I love living in places where you can do that. In Hickory Valley, we all wave to our neighbors. Where I am in the Netherlands, we all wave. I just think it's a wonderful ethic.

Farrell: It's a wonderful ethic, and it helps introduce you to people. I've gotten to know all of my neighbors since I started this waving thing. I know their names, and I know what they do. They know who I am and what I do.

That is what you need to start doing: Get off the computer screen, and build real human relationships.

Fitts: Question #9: High-tech Risks. What are the extreme risks generated by new technology?

Farrell: I'm with Martin Luther King here. Our technological savvy has grown way beyond our spiritual capacity to manage it. The technology, in a way, is driving everything. When you are dealing with so-called 'technocrats' who are incapable of any long-term strategic thought, much less moral thought, then you have a problem.

It's not really the technology that is the bad component here; it's the people managing it.

Fitts: Right. Spiritually and culturally we are not able to handle this technology.

Farrell: Culturally we are in the position where scientists think that if they can do it, then they should do it. We never stop to ask the question, "Should we be doing this?"

My answer is, "No, we shouldn't be with much of this stuff."

Fitts: One of the stories here is, *Scientists Create Early Embryos that Are Part Human, Part Monkey*.

Question #10: China and the Quad and the Risks of War. What are the risks of war?

Farrell: Sadly, I think that now the risks are very high for a variety of reasons. First, you have Mr. 'Globaloney' and his constant prodding of the Russian bear, which is just plain stupid.

If you stop and think about it, there really isn't any reason this country – not to mention Europe – has to assume this anti-Russian attitude. There is no good

reason for it. Our interests are aligned in so many ways that if we would just allow that on the table, it would diffuse many situations.

Fitts: Right, but if Russia and the United States come into alignment, you are going to have a blossoming of the Christian impulse, and that is exactly what Mr. Global doesn't want.

Farrell: Add to that India and its sudden about-face regarding Pakistan, and stationing more troops on the border with China. Add to that the Japanese diplomatic moves largely under Shinzo Abe over the last few years. I don't see tensions weakening anytime soon.

China is committed to Iran, and on and on we could go.

Fitts: Question #11: Re-engineering US Government & Global Taxation and Military. How to move it global?

If you want to take the civil service or the operations functions of the U.S. government and the military and the taxation, and move it global, how would you do it? They are clearly moving in that direction. The question is: How are they doing it?

Part of it is they are trying to debase the brand.

I don't know if you saw the RT story, *BLM Flags to Fly at US Embassies*. Then they tried to argue that the President shouldn't have the nuclear football because it should be in a committee. They probably didn't tell us that Kissinger was going to be on the committee.

So, you have all of these moves to globalize. How are they going to try to do this?

Farrell: I think the crucial thing there is the nuclear football committee. They have to assert control, particularly with the USA looking like it's cracking up. I believe that is one reason for this whole committee idea in the first place. The other thing about the committee is that if Russia or China or India, or whoever has nuclear weapons realizes that they are dealing with an American nuclear

football that no one knows who has command of it, you are less likely to make some provocative moves on the world stage. I think this is another reason for the football talk.

Fitts: So, they want the command center to be a secret.

Farrell: Yes, they want the command structure to be secret, and I wouldn't be a bit surprised if this was a play to take the American nuclear arsenal out of the control structure of America and globalize it.

Fitts: That's how you globalize; you globalize the money and you globalize the bombs.

Question #12: Land & Real Estate. What will happen to land and real estate as a result of changes underway? What about the existing energy model? Will energy delivered by wireless technology at low cost be implemented soon?

Big changes are happening in real estate.

Farrell: I think there is a play to acquire American farmland. I think there is a play, as you pointed out, with the riots and the Opportunity Zones. They are going 'full-tilt' after the middle class, which includes farmers.

The bottom line is if they are going to bring in a global government, they have to own considerable amounts of land. They have to have control over it and own it.

Fitts: They need an asset, and it's not going to be oil, so what is it going to be? I believe it has to be food. If you look at the Anglo-American Alliance; when we did the *Solari Report on The Global Harvest*, the Anglo-American Alliance is a food juggernaut. You have Canada, New Zealand, Australia, and the United States.

It's interesting. Britain's self-sufficiency on food dropped a good deal when they entered the EU. Now after Brexit, I'm very interested to see if they revisited it and improved it.

Farrell: I think they probably will, but I think they have to do the food.

Regarding the secret committee with the nuclear football, you mentioned Henry Kissinger. Go back to 1972 or 1971 when he was still an advisor to President Nixon. He came out with that National Security Council Memorandum 200 where he specifically talks about food as a weapon.

Fitts: If you look at what's been happening in China and Asia, there is a food war going on. Biowarfare targets food.

One of the things Corey Lynn did was write a special with our sponsorship on the new lab in Kansas. Did you see that? It is truly frightening.

Farrell: Where is the lab located? If it's where I think it is, it will be one of those 'you-know-what' moments.

Fitts: The article is, *USDA Hitting Food Supply Chain with Cattle Surveillance and a Level-4 Animal Disease Laboratory*. This is a very good article. She's great at deep-diving these things. It's in Manhattan, Kansas, which is right next to the university.

Farrell: I knew it! Do you know what else is there? Fort Riley, home of the Spanish Flu outbreak.

Fitts: Here is what is scary: Look at the chart with this article. Do you see the ten states with the most cattle? They have moved this bio-lab right into the heart of the heartland where all of the cattle are. They are right in the center of 60% of the inventory.

Farrell: Holy cow! (No pun intended)

Fitts: Look at this article if you get a chance because, at the same time that they are trying to do this RFID chip to make it easy to surveil all of the cattle, they are putting in a biowarfare lab. Is this to kill all the cattle?

Farrell: It's to get rid of all the cattle that they don't have the operating

system installed into.

Fitts: Right, and then we all have to buy their synthetic meat.

Farrell: It's unreal.

Fitts: That is when I will become a vegetarian.

Farrell: I probably won't be far behind you. I'll have to learn to make vegetarian curry.

Fitts: Moving right along, this is the question that baffles me.

Question #13: Who is Mr. Global?: What is the governance structure on Planet Earth, and what are the risk issues that are driving Mr. Global's actions?

Can you believe that we live on a planet where the whole thing is a mystery?

Farrell: You know what my take on it is: Mr. 'Globaloney' is a network of people involved with the international corporations, central banks, and secret societies.

Fitts: We are primarily talking about intergenerational capital at a very high, very secret level.

Farrell: I have a member on my website who has been speculating on what he calls 'the trust', which is a long expression for an intergenerational capital foundation that goes back hundreds of years. It's a very interesting speculation that he comes up with.

The more I think about it, the more I believe that is what we are looking at. We are looking at a very, very intergenerational long-term commitment of money, of certain families, of certain institutions, the Vatican, secret societies, and so on.

Fitts: They are clearly very scared about population growth and the ability for

the environment to handle it, and the ability for the leadership to handle it. They are scared.

Farrell: They are scared for one very simple reason: We outnumber them by millions. That is the bottom line. The other part of the fear is they know that their tricks aren't working as effectively as they have in the past.

Fitts: Here's the thing: I've run into people who operate near or close to the top and are deeply frustrated by their inability to build constituencies for responsibility. It's sincere, and they are clearly frustrated by it.

The entire reason I was working on place-based economics was to build up bottom-up responsibility. The problem is that it gets in the way of secrecy.

There is a huge hypocrisy in this thing. You have a large number of enlightened leadership that would like to see bottom-up responsibility, but they can't afford the transparency that is required to do it to get it to work.

Farrell: They've built a whole system on secrecy for hundreds of years, and in a certain sense, it is 'running out of steam'.

Fitts: How do you get out of that secrecy in a way that is effective and can really work? It's not easy to do.

I remember being told – and it's probably true – that a large group of people tried to figure out how you could end much of the secrecy, and they couldn't figure out a way through the legal liabilities, and they gave up.

I think that getting out of the mess we're in is harder because it's not like you have a king who has dictatorial control.

Farrell: This is part of what I mean by 'owning the culture'. A component of that, in my opinion, involves the necessity of going back for centuries and looking at the evolution of Western jurisprudence to see where the missteps were made. The biggest blunder, in my opinion, was this whole notion of collective guilt, which in turn, feeds into the very earliest ways that the law was trying to deal with corporations. That law goes back to the Middle Ages.

Unless we are willing to confront the steps along the way, we will never get out of this secrecy culture. Part of it is a work for some good legal philosophers.

Fitts: You have to have a system where the law cannot be dominated by money and finance, and where finance cannot be allowed to become a much greater portion of the economy than is necessary.

Finance and money and the financial system have to be put ‘back in the box’, but we are going the opposite way. We are letting them completely take over and control and destroy. That’s the question: How do we get money and finance back to where it belongs as a servant of society as opposed to a harvester and a controller?

There is a new interview that *Planet Lockdown* did of Bishop Schneider. I don’t know if you’ve seen it. It’s fabulous. For fifteen minutes this man basically describes the whole last year and a half. It’s like, “Wow! A real bishop!”

Farrell: They are a rarity.

Fitts: Question #14: High Strangeness. Which is stranger – what is going on behind the veil of secrecy, or the overwhelming effort to pretend it is not going on and to create an official reality diverging steadily from reality?

Farrell: If you are asking me that question, I would say that it’s the overwhelming effort to pretend that it’s not happening.

Fitts: Remember the General telling Richard Dolan, “Trust me. You don’t want to know”?

Farrell: He’s probably right. We probably don’t want to know what reality is. I think it’s the pretend part of it; we are in a pretend culture everywhere. It’s no wonder that none of our solutions work because the pretense has to be ripped off before you can do anything.

Stop and think of the interview that I did with Peter (Kennedy). There is no

pretense there.

Fitts: It's a totally authentic conversation between two people about reality.

Farrell: There is not a bit of pretense. Unfortunately, most Americans are still living in this world of pretense that we are the shining city on the hill, and we are the exceptional nation. I think part of that is Americans have it in their mind that America is not subject to the law of all empires.

Fitts: I also think it's because they haven't ridden on a Chinese high-speed train. America has steadily fallen further and further behind. In many areas, we are a third world country.

Farrell: The infrastructure alone in this country is like a third world country. Compare it to Europe. We are dealing with an air traffic control system that is not up to date; we are dealing with electrical grids that are not up to date, and on and on this goes because we have to buy \$2 billion airplanes.

Fitts: We had a tremendous dust-up in Europe because four British Airways pilots suddenly died. They refused to say they were vaccinated, but you know there is a warning on the CDC site that you are prone to blood clots when you fly. So injecting pilots with things that tear away your vascular walls and cause blood clots, and at the same time, flying causes blood clots, which is not a very good idea.

I can't tell you how many people have said to me, "I don't want to fly."

Farrell: These days I won't. You know me; I don't fly.

I have a friend who is a member of my website and is a pilot. He told me about listening to air traffic controllers in the last year. We are hearing all these strange stories about people's behavior after they have had these vaccines. The air traffic control conversations they have listened to; some of these controllers are literally out to lunch.

Stop and think about that. Then add to that, American Airlines is canceling flights because they are getting all sorts of sick calls from pilots and flight crews.

Fitts: They tried to say that it had nothing to do with the vaccinations, but I don't believe that.

Farrell: Of course not. I don't believe it for a moment. They are having all sorts of sick calls. Then on top of that, American Airlines wants to 'wokify' (as in the slang term Woke-issues of social inequity) their pilot staff. In addition to that, air traffic controllers are being 'wokified'. Pretty soon, we will have situations where airplanes are falling out of the sky simply due to incompetence. It's unbelievable.

I was warning about this when I was teaching college. If the educational standards in this country keep going the way that they are going, we will be a third world nation. We will not be able to make an airplane, much less repair an airplane or fly it from point A to B without incident. It's occurring all the time.

Fitts: It's scary. Speaking of scary, we have our next question.

Question #15: Demonic Intelligence. Given the tsunami of occult and demonic practices and symbols, how concerned should we be about the interaction between AI and interdimensional intelligence?

Farrell: I think we should be very concerned.

Fitts: In fact, I think that one of the reasons for AI is that the interdimensional intelligence wants to be able to manipulate from another dimension.

Farrell: I do, too. Elon Musk raised that point quite a few years ago. I think it's absolutely a possibility because, like it or not, digital systems are binary systems. That's kind of 'stinking thinking' coming from you-know-who. Human intelligence ultimately doesn't think in a binary way at all if you really get down to it.

I think there is a big danger of that.

Fitts: This relates to the next question.

Question #16: The War on the Divine. Are the Covid-19 injections an effort to remove the ‘God particle’?

We talked about the **War on God** in **Story #11**. There is plenty of speculation about whether the COVID-19 injections are designed to remove the ‘God particle’, but I think there are some real issues of this attack on the pineal gland and our spiritual capacity.

Farrell: I do, too. There does seem to be some sort of religious agenda to all of this.

Fitts: Could you ever have imagined the Pope pushing the mark of the beast?; we have the Pope pushing the mark of the beast (Covid vaccines). It’s mind-boggling to me.

Farrell: It’s mind-boggling that you would have any Pope saying that it’s okay to get COVID vaccines when they know that there is aborted fetal tissue cells in some of those vaccines. This is not the Roman Catholic Church that I remember as a child. It’s not Pious XII anymore.

Fitts: Question #17: Education. Is moving education online using COVID-19 a step to privatization and a corporate takeover of education? Or does it reflect a concern on how to manage and educate orphans if predictions about future deaths and disability related to the injections come true?

Farrell: The answer is, “D to all of the above.”

Fitts: One of the things that I think will be interesting in education is how all of these unbelievably expensive college infrastructures are going to survive.

Farrell: They won’t, especially when parents wake up and realize, “Why am I paying \$250,000 to get my child an education in ‘wokism’ at Harvard when I can spend \$20,000 and send them to local community college or have them privately tutored?”

I think you will see a huge underground education movement starting, and it's going to be one-on-one, face-to-face human contact classroom interaction.

Fitts: I want you to watch out for colleges going bankrupt because I'm looking to pick up a campus. Seriously, I'm looking for something that can be a university and a church and a library.

Think of the Library of Alexandria with a cathedral and a university.

Farrell: What you are talking about is essentially how Oxford used to be before it started getting all this 'wokism'. There is no substitute for it.

I'll keep my eyes open for a campus.

Fitts: I would have the center of it be the library. I would literally create a Library of Alexandria type of thing – all hardcopy.

Farrell: Do me a favor and insist that the faculty use the Chicago Manual style for footnotes.

Fitts: That is a good point. I will.

Question #18: Historical Plague Laws. There appears to be a 100-year cycle of plagues and plague laws used to centralize capital. Is it tied to currency or other cycles?

I discovered this wonderful chapter in *The Edge of the World* by Michael Pye where it turns out that there is a remarkable historical 100-year cycle. You have a plague, you use plague laws to centralize capital, and then you move the reserve currency. Here we go again.

Farrell: I got that book on your recommendation and I read that chapter. It's amazing. It's like the people behind the COVID plan/ 'scamdemic' read this book.

Fitts: I think this has been going on for centuries; I think this is an old playbook. What I'm dreaming of – and I'm going to say this to everybody and

keep sending this out – is I want some brilliant graduate PhD student in history or in economics to decide to make this their research thesis.

Farrell: Yes, and I would add my own ‘two cents’ to that: Start with Venice.

Fitts: Touché. I did tell you about my one meeting with a member of the old Venetian nobility. I have to say that I thought he was one of the most intelligent, enlightened people I’ve ever met. I thought he was extraordinary.

We were walking on a street in Venice. He was giving me a little tour. He turned to me, and said, “You know, there are only 27,000 of us from the old families left. We can’t live here because it’s like being Mickey Mouse in Disneyworld.”

On any given day, there are 150,000 American tourists. He looked so sad. He had been run out by American tourists; it’s not easy being Venetian nobility.

I remember thinking that we would be lucky if such a person was willing to govern us, but he had family responsibilities.

Question #19: Down Under. Why have the Australian and New Zealand lockdowns been so brutal? What does it have to do with Pine Gap and Antarctica?

I have to tell you that the Australian lockdowns have shocked me deeply.

Farrell: I’m in the ‘same boat’. I cannot understand why and what the rationale is. In fact, someone sent me a cartoon, and it was a map of Australia and the states in Australia. The states were not labeled ‘New South Wales’ and so on; they were labeled ‘Cell block A, Cell block B’. I thought, “Boy, that says it all.”

I can’t figure it out either, but it has nothing to do with COVID as far as I can tell. There is some other reason for it.

Fitts: They have a real problem managing. Australia is a huge country. It’s the size of the United States, and has 24 million people. If you look at Asia, there are millions of people who would love to move there. Many of them are

Chinese. How are you going to manage the politics of that? It's very dangerous.

I don't know if you've ever seen the TV program, *Pine Gap*. I don't recommend it, but it shows you the tensions of navigating between the American security system and the Chinese. Their borders are closed. If you are Australian, you can't get in and you can't get out. It's unbelievable.

I wonder about it because the strictest lockdowns were in Melbourne and Victoria – as close as you can get to Antarctica.

Pine Gap is clearly a very powerful and important installation, and I think it relates to Pine Gap in Antarctica, but I can't figure it out. I would never have guessed that this would be the strictest country.

Who thought Florida would be the bastion of freedom and Australia would be completely shut down?

Farrell: It baffles me because it's so out of character for Australia and the Australians I've known in my life. It's totally out of character.

I agree with you; there is another explanation for it. Antarctica may be it; I don't know. There is so much strangeness going on with that place. I don't know; I'm baffled by it.

Fitts: It's a population control. The question is: Are they worried about who's who?

Farrell: I don't know. The policy is coming from somewhere. I don't think that all of the decision-making is coming out of Canberra and no place else.

Fitts: Interestingly enough, Jason Bawden-Smith for many years has believed that Mr. Global lives in Australia – which is possible. That could be part of it.

Question #20: AI & Machine Enforcement. When are robotics and automation going to go up the S curve? Will the 'defund the police' movement turn out to be an install robot and drone police wave?

Farrell: I ‘doff my hat’ because I’m so glad you mentioned that. That is what I’ve been thinking – particularly with the drone business.

It makes a certain amount of sense to have that AI-robotized police force in certain cities where things have utterly broken down. I think that is by design; they are trying to push that.

I can tell you I don’t think it will ever ‘float’ here where I’m at.

Fitts: As soon as the Bolsheviks got in control, they defunded the police and emptied the prisons. It’s an old tactic.

Question #21: The Climate Change Op. Can the COVID-19 to Climate Change bait and switch really work? Why has Biden appointed a climate change czar who has the carbon footprint of a Panzer division?

Someone on our *News Trends & Stories* team came up with that expression, and I was laughing for days.

Question # 22: When will the energy cost of crypto and blockchain systems, as well as F-35 and military activities, become widely appreciated?

I don’t know what to say. This one is so bad. They will try to tear us apart with the carbon credit thing.

We are doing this **Wrap Up** on the CBDC’s, and the next **Wrap Up** will be on the vaccine passports. Then I have to deep dive into climate change.

Farrell: It’s an op, and it’s been an op from the get-go.

I get so frustrated with it because I was alive in the 1970’s when they had Earth Day in all the schools. Do you remember that? We were ‘spoon fed’ all day long about how the world was going to freeze in the next 10 years. “There’s a coming ice age, and there is nothing that we can do about it. It’s all due to ‘cow farts’.”

Then magically, overnight it changed to global warming, and we are all going to

burn to death because of ‘cow farts’. Now it’s ‘climate change’, which is the most absurd overgeneralization.

Fitts: The climate is always changing.

Farrell: The climate is always changing – “Because of cow ‘farts!’” You could not make up a more nonsensical narrative!

Fitts: One of the funniest times I’ve ever had was with this fabulous German scientist who Ulrike Granögger introduced me to. We were in Umbria in Italy, and we had this charming, wonderful lunch in a beautiful little restaurant. This man turned out to be the world’s leading expert on the carbon usage of all military activities including F-35s.

He was a genius. He made comparisons with the cows, like one F-35 an hour was like one million cows.

Farrell: It’s absurd!

Fitts: This is why the City of London wanted to get rid of the German scientists or control them or own them.

Farrell: Because they put a big dent in the narrative. Leave it to the Germans!

Fitts: Instead, we have Kerry running around in his private plane lecturing us on why we have to cut back.

Farrell: The hypocrisy of these people astounds me. I don’t know where to begin. It’s such nonsense.

If we are talking about climate change, then quit ‘monkeying around’ with the ‘damned’ ionosphere.

Fitts: If you look at what they are doing to the climate, it’s unbelievable.

Farrell: It’s not HAARP, it’s cow ‘farts’.

Fitts: I read a book by Annie Jacobsen, who wrote the book on Operation Paperclip. Much of the time I read her books because there are many good ‘nuggets’ in them. The one that she did on DARPA (Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency) had a whole history of nuclear testing. The environmental impact of what they’ve done with nuclear testing is frightening. It’s almost a miracle that we are all alive.

When you read what they’ve done with nuclear testing and think instead that they are going to say that it’s ‘cow farts’, it’s like in the Ellis Medavoy interviews where he talks about the big blackout that the whole East Coast experienced. It took down the energy, and they explained it by saying that a deer ate a wire. It’s somewhat like that.

Question #23: Sun Cycles. What is happening to the sun? Are we entering into a period of diminished sun spot activity?

If you look at the history of the stock market and the economy with sun spots, it’s a very real correlation. Ben Davidson and some of the other people who follow this really believe that we are going into a period of diminished activity. This means there is an economic issue of how you will support a population this big in that situation.

Farrell: I’m going to go even further ‘off the end of the twig’ here.

I do think that they are tinkering with the sun.

Fitts: That is possible. Remember when they sent a nuclear bomb out and had a nuclear explosion on the moon? There has been ‘funny business’ going on with the sun, and I don’t understand what it is.

Farrell: The Earth’s magnetosphere touches the sun. So if you are playing around with the ionosphere, which is like playing around with the magnetosphere, and if you are building enormously powerful magnets in fusion reactors or large hadron colliders or what have you, you will affect the Earth’s magnetosphere. These systems are open systems, not closed systems.

I think there is a very real possibility that they are deliberately trying to create

magnetic resonance effects in the sun itself. I think the reason they are doing that is, as I said in those Secret Space Program talks that I did: If you can demonstrate an ability to engineer systems on a stellar scale, that will give whoever may be out there a little pause to think twice before messing around.

I think, quite literally, this is a possibility that may be going on.

Fitts: It's interesting because the latest *Star Wars* movie envisions societies that destroy planets.

Farrell: And suns. I think you are looking at that possibility here. I go to the fundamental precept about weather and weather warfare manipulation. Contrary to what you learn in school, weather systems are primarily electromagnetic in nature. So, if you can 'play around' with those systems, you can engineer systems on a planetary scale. Playing around with the weather ultimately means that you have to get a handle on the sun's influence on the weather.

Fitts: My understanding is that the magnetism in the field is diminishing.

Farrell: Yes, the Earth's magnetic field is diminishing, and many scientists believe that is a precursor to magnetic field polar shifts. So, the North Pole would become the South Pole, and the South Pole would become the North magnetic Pole.

Fitts: Skidmore (Mark) has been looking at the cycle of major disasters. He does a great deal with disaster economics. There is this cycle of every 10,000 or so years where there is a major pole shift.

Farrell: The North Pole has been 'wandering' and 'weakening' over the last few years. I think that it's an open system tied to solar activity somehow.

Fitts: If you are in Australia, could one explanation of their lockdown be concern about the poles shifting?

Farrell: Yes. If the magnetic pole shifts, then basic systems have to be completely reengineered. Think of your little pocket compass if suddenly, the North Pole is down.

Fitts: If you thought you were in danger of something like that happening, would you come up with a COVID-19 pandemic to get everybody to dramatically reduce the people flying around in the sky or moving around on the planet?

Farrell: Yes.

Fitts: Question #24: Geophysical Risks. Does Earth have a ‘Three-Body Problem’? Why is there a pattern of civilization destruction 10,000 years ago?

I finished reading *The Three-Body Problem*. Do you know the book?

Farrell: I’ve heard about the book, but I have not read it. Can you describe what he is calling the ‘Three-Body Problem’? I think people would be interested to know that.

Fitts: I put a short video in the book review that I did of it. It’s when you have a relationship between your planet and related planets such that you cannot predict instability. You cannot predict the behavior of the planets and their relationship to each other in a way that really can threaten the viability of your society.

This is one of the most famous science fiction books to come from China. It’s the first Asian novel to win the Hugo Award for best novel.

Interestingly enough, the person who translated it is also a Hugo Award winner. I have to tell you that it is one of the most deeply depressing books I’ve ever read.

Farrell: Why is that?

Fitts: Because you are looking at a society that is so insecure since its future is so uncertain, they are trying to find a way to deal with this effectively so that they don’t keep getting wiped every such-and-such years.

You wonder, given our pattern of every 10,000 years, is this really about something we are dealing with?

We haven't found a way to build a society that can endure through these cycles.

Farrell: I think so, to a certain degree. The reason I think that is that I go back to those Babylonian and Egyptian texts about astrology. What they will tell you is that their astrological science was based on observations taken over thousands of years. In other words, you have a claim right there to an empirical science or an empirical basis for what they were calling astrology.

It's very interesting that the kind of astrology they practiced was not the kind of astrology that you get in the little books in the grocery store aisle where they talk about individual predictions. Most of ancient astrology would be what a modern astrologer would call a 'mundane horoscope'.

In other words, they were horoscopes cast for the King, but the King – in their thinking – was the representative of a body of people. In other words, you are dealing with a statistical aggregate rather than an individual person as such for their predictions.

The way that ancient astrology texts read is very similar to what this person is getting at with *The Three-Body Problem*. How do we construct a durable society that can endure these types of cyclical catastrophes that seem to occur?

Fitts: If you thought you were in danger of one of these soon, wouldn't that explain the desire to dramatically reduce the fertility rate?

Farrell: It could, yes. In other words, if you thought that you were facing this kind of event, you would justify all sorts of insane actions as a means of policy to try to get through it. My problem with that kind of thinking – and many people who hold that view – is that you are basically 'cutting your own throat'. Some of those people you are trying to get rid of might be the very people who have the solution to the problem. This is the problem with it.

Fitts: Secrecy always lowers the learning speed. There you go.

I always said, “Tell everybody the truth. If it scares some to death, better the people you keep are the ones who can deal with it.”

Question #25: The Vision Thing. What are the supporting facts and arguments for optimism?

Farrell: I think we’ve covered this plenty in what we’ve said. It’s looking like Mr. ‘Globaloney’ is making egregious mistakes. His narratives are not working as smoothly as they would like. They are still a long way off from putting into place their unipolar world. In fact, there is enough mitigating against that even happening right now.

I’m very optimistic over the long term that none of this is going to work for the very simple reason that it’s anti-human.

Fitts: It’s more than anti-human; it’s anti-life.

Farrell: Right, and I think that there is a built-in mechanism in the universe that is self-correcting whenever humanity gets these highfalutin ideas. I’m very serious about this.

Fitts: I know, we need to get rid of the hubris.

Question #26: The Road Ahead. What is most on the minds of members of Giza Death Star and the Solari Report subscribers? What can we do this year to help improve the learning speeds in our shared intelligence networks?

Farrell: What is on most of my members’ minds is: What do we do about this? I think that even more so in the last three months, that has somewhat clarified itself to: How do we deal with all of the lies? How do we pierce through that veil?

Fitts: One of the things that I loved about the conversation with Peter (Kennedy) was that you were listening to two people who were not on the ‘couch’ being entertained by QAnon. They realized that the next Presidential campaign was not going to help. There is nobody in the pro-centralization team

that could help, but we could help ourselves.

Farrell: I'm so glad that you want to talk about QAnon because I want to talk about Martin Luther.

Fitts: Good! I was talking about Martin Luther in connection with starting a university.

Farrell: During the Reformation, he had these radical sects that were all expecting the end. "It's right around the corner, so let's all pack ourselves into the Mulhouse in Germany and live the apostolic property-less life."

Of course, Luther was having none of it. His attitude was a famous quotation that I will mangle: His response to all this expectation of the apocalypse and the end was, "Well, if that's the case, then I am going to be busy about planting a tree."

In other words, "Turn off the fear porn, and get busy and do something positive."

Fitts: I would say it this way, "Speak life into your situation".

There is an old story of Saint Frances in the middle of winter sitting in front of an almond tree. He says, "God, show me your face," and the almond tree blossomed.

So, get busy speaking life into your situation.

Farrell: He took that business about preaching the gospel to all creatures very literally.

Fitts: One of my favorite moments was when Caroline Casey had a radio show in Washington. When Senator Byrd was filibustering to try to stop the Iraq War, he threw up his hands and said, "I might as well be speaking to the ocean."

Caroline Casey said, "Senator Byrd, what a great idea!"

Let's go to our last section.

Take Action & Inspiration.

We have listed numerous **Take Actions**, and have listed our heroes for the year. We put plenty of information about local finance here.

I have to tell you that the *News Trends & Stories* team keeps getting better.

I want to do a sharescreen and show you our favorite video in the **Take Action & Inspiration** section. Have you seen *Leadership from a Dancing Guy* yet?

Farrell: No.

Fitts: We are going to watch this. *Leadership from a Dancing Guy*:

If you've learned a lot about leadership and making a movement, then let's watch a movement happen start to finish in under three minutes and dissect some lessons.

First, of course, a leader needs the guts to stand alone and look ridiculous, but what he is doing is so simple, it's almost instructional. This is key. You must be easy to follow.

Now here comes the first follower with a crucial role: He publicly shows everyone else how to follow. Notice how the leader embraces him as an equal. So it's not about the leader anymore; it's about them - plural.

Notice how he is calling out to his friends to join in. It takes guts to be a first follower. You stand out, and you brave ridicule yourself. Being a first follower is an underappreciated form of leadership. The first follower transforms a lone nut into a leader. If the leader is the flint, the first follower is the spark that really makes the fire.

Now here is the second follower: This is the turning point. It's proof that the first has done well. Now it's not a lone nut, and it's not two nuts.

Three is a crowd, and a crowd is news. A movement must be public. Make sure that outsiders see more than just the leader. Everyone needs to see the followers because new followers emulate the followers, not the leader.

Now come two more people, and then three more immediately. Now we've got momentum. This is the tipping point, and now we have a movement. As more people join in, it's no longer risky. If they were on the fence before, there is no reason not to join in now. They won't stand out, they won't be ridiculed, and they will be part of the 'in' crowd if they hurry.

Over the next minute, you will see the rest who prefer to stay part of the crowd because eventually, they would be ridiculed for not joining.

Ladies and gentlemen, that is how a movement is made. So let's recap what we've learned: If you are a version of the shirtless dancing guy, all alone, remember the importance of nurturing your first few followers as equals, making everything clearly about the movement, not you. Be public. Be easy to follow. But the biggest lesson here – did you catch it? Leadership is over- glorified.

Yes, it started with the shirtless guy, and he will get all of the credit, but you saw what really happened. It was the first follower that transformed the lone nut into a leader. There is no movement without the first follower.

See, we are told that we all need to be leaders, but that would be really ineffective. The best way to make a movement if you really care is to courageously follow and show others how to follow.

When you find a lone nut doing something great, have the guts to be the first person to stand up and join in.

Farrell: Wow! All of that in three minutes!

Fitts: Isn't that great!

Farrell: That's all that needs to be done, really. Just get out there and do it.

Fitts: I keep telling people that it only takes 5-10%, especially if they are all using cash.

Farrell: Exactly.

Fitts: Joseph, as always, this has been a deeply gratifying experience.

Farrell: Thank you for having me back. I hope that it has been.

Fitts: Do you have any other thoughts, other than I miss you?

Farrell: I was thinking about that today. When we use to do these in the kitchen, and it was different and somehow more immediate.

I don't have any final thoughts other than to suggest that people go to my website and look at the dialogue with Peter (Kennedy) and what his groups that he is a part of are doing. They've thought this out very well.

Fitts: In the **1st Quarter Wrap Up** we focused on the *Circles*. We are bringing up <http://Connect.Solari.com>, and are prototyping it. It's an open source social media platform, but it means that *Solari Report* subscribers can start circles for their places.

We had a meeting with all of the Swiss subscribers. We appoint a leader, and then the people in that area can join. So, we have about four going. We are just testing and prototyping. We hope that by the end of the summer, all of the subscribers will be invited in and can start joining in.

I want people to meet in person because I don't trust the online systems, but I finally realized that as a logistical matter, they couldn't do it without this kind of support. So, this is a way to find each other and find out how to get going, but then get going place by place.

Farrell: Speaking of missing me, will you ever be able to come back to this country?

Fitts: I hope so. My assessment right now is that I'm concerned that if I went back, I would have trouble going back to Europe. My concern is I want to make sure that I am as productive as possible day-to-day-to-day. Right now, I am phenomenally productive here.

I started to deal with physical harassment again in the United States, and I'm just not in the mood to deal with it. So, my concern would be getting back here.

Farrell: I know that many people here are missing you. I'm sure that your members are missing the *Solari* luncheons and so on.

Fitts: We are going to start doing some, even if I can't be there. We have a couple of people now in the Memphis area on the *Solari Team*. I want to have one in Memphis so they can meet each other.

The most fun that people have is not meeting me, but meeting each other and finding other people in their places. So, we will start picking up on the events if we can. I think there is nothing more fun than when people meet each other.

Farrell: Right, and then they can take action.

Fitts: One action that we need is to give you a break. Thank you, Joseph, this has been great!

Farrell: Thank you for having me back on. We will see you in three months.

Fitts: We will be doing the passports next. This one is CBDC's (Central Bank Digital Currency). Have you read the *Going Direct* yet?

Farrell: I have not received it.

Fitts: We haven't shipped it yet. We will ship it from the printer either very soon. We have a printer in the United States because it's a real struggle to get these mailed. We mailed the *Injection Fraud* to Australia. It's been a year, and they still haven't gotten through.

I won't say where, but we found a business where we could FedEx a whole box, and they turned around and mailed them internally. This was how they finally got through.

To every subscriber in Australia and New Zealand, there is a warehouse somewhere where they are sitting, and another one may come through.

Farrell: Talk about censorship!

Fitts: It's unbelievable. We shipped *Injection Fraud* from the Netherlands. We mailed them one by one, so each one was mailed individually from the Netherlands to the United States. After three months, not one had arrived. So we did a new print, FedEx'd the boxes to the U.S., and mailed them individually from the U.S. After they started to arrive, the next day the original copies arrived.

Somebody had put them in a NATO warehouse, is what I concluded.

Farrell: Probably so. I did get two copies, and they were within two or three days of each other.

Fitts: They finally let them out because we were doing a remailing. It's spiritual warfare.

Farrell: It is.

Fitts: It tells me that they are effective.

Farrell: They wouldn't bother censoring you if it wasn't effective. You only take flack if you're over the target.

Fitts: So, we will mail this to you from the United States. If you want more than one, let me or Nita (*Solari* team) know. You can have as many as you want. We are doing a massive printing.

Farrell: I will do that. I gave a stack of extra copies of things of yours to some friends of mine.

Fitts: Would you like a box of *The State of Our Currency* and a box of this?

Farrell: I don't have enough people for that, but maybe a few extra copies. I don't know that many people around here.

Fitts: I will send you a couple. Do you want *The State of Our Currency* and this?

Farrell: Yes.

Fitts: Anything else?

Farrell: No, I have a couple of friends that I give away extra copies to, and I'm hoping that they are reading them.

Fitts: It's amusing because the finance people get them, and they devour them. It's amazing to watch. But if you're not a financial person, maybe not as much.

Farrell: I gave copies of some financial information, but I also gave copies of *The Injection Fraud*. I'm hoping that they are circulating and stirring thought.

Fitts: We'll see what happens. Thank you, Joseph. Have a great day.

Farrell: Thank you much.

Fitts: Ladies and gentlemen, thank you for joining us on *The Solari Report*.
