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2nd Quarter 2023 Wrap Up: News Trends & Stories Part II with Dr. Joseph Farrell



Catherine Austin Fitts: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the 2nd Quarter 2023 Wrap Up. This is Catherine Austin Fitts and Dr. Joseph Farrell. We had a great chat earlier – a long chat – on the **Top 20 Stories** and **Bizarro World.**

Today we will take it down to the personal level and say, "All of these doings at the geopolitical and financial level, what does it mean to me? What do I do about it?"

We are also going to cover the **Unanswered Questions**, and you will notice that the **Unanswered Questions** keep getting longer. It's the idea that as you go at this, you may get smarter, but you get more questions. We are also going to talk about **Inspiration** and **Heroes** when we get into **Pillar VI**.

Our discussion is divided into the six pillars of the **Building Wealth System**, and that is *Solari's* framework and curriculum to help you understand the culture, the habit, and the tactics that are successful in this environment. I'm always telling people, "You don't need an investment strategy; you need a war strategy.

We are going to go through the six pillars and talk about what this means to you. I'm going to share the screen. I would encourage you to check out the web presentation. Pillar I: Your Free and Inspired Life.

Basically, we are saying that you have to organize your life around your purpose, where you want to go, and what is in your heart to do. Everything, including your time and your financial resources, all organize around supporting you achieving your purpose and goals in life.

You have to take responsibility to define what that is, what your purpose is, and where you want to go. I'll 'kick this off' by saying that I had a wonderful subscriber say, "If there are no real elections, no one can have a free and inspired life."

So my question to you is: Do you agree with that?

Dr. Joseph P. Farrell: No.

Fitts: Neither do I. I'm glad that you said no since I don't agree either.

Farrell: The idea that you have to live under a particular system of government in order to have a relatively good quality of life is absurd.

Fitts: Any Italian could tell you that.

Farrell: Yes, and any Russian could tell you that. We've been so long under the American system that we equate the two. To a certain extent, in recent years, we have been under this narrative spell that it's impossible without free and fair elections. I'm increasingly of the opinion that I don't really care about what Washington DC is going to do; I'm going to do what I'm going to do.

Fitts: Good candidates in position in Federal, state, and local government anywhere in the world always increases the quality of life. The higher of quality the people you have in leadership, the better off you are.

Farrell: Absolutely. That is why if you are the 'praying sort', you always pray for wise and Godly leaders. We certainly don't have that now.

Fitts: I will say this: I work with a group of state legislators and other people in government who are fantastic.

Farrell: We are going through some sort of period, but I don't couple the system of government with my happiness. Can government influence my happiness? Sure. When 'push comes to shove', if the government tells me that I have to wear a mask and stand six feet away from somebody else and get 'quackcinated', I say, "No."

Fitts: My feeling is that Leonardo da Vinci did not wait for good government to have a free and inspired life, and we can't afford to wait either.

I do think that if you look at what is going on in the world, when we turn to

some of the actions and resources, a great talk from Russell Brand is significant; I love Russel Brand. I don't know if you saw it, but he said, "We need to look into our hearts," and he had a great rant about what is going on. He talked about the importance of connecting on an intimate level with other people.

Farrell: I would definitely agree with that. I'm probably guiltier of that than most because I'm a fairly solitary person. Most of my human contact now is through the internet. I miss the actual physical presence of close friends. I'm very guilty of that.

Fitts: One thing that I keep telling everybody is that if you are going to have a free and inspired life, you have to have a free and inspired mind, and you have to get technology into balance, and you have to get the mind control out of your mind as much as possible.

I keep saying this, but I will continue to say it. Everybody assumes, "Mind controlled people are other people; not me." That's not true. We have all ingested huge amounts of this stuff.

Farrell: It's very important that people understand that mind control comes in two forms: It is the hard, technological sort, and then it is the manipulation through technique, propaganda, neurolinguistics programming, and all of that. I want to recommend the book that I mentioned in **Part I**, *One Idea to Rule Them All*.

Fitts: My favorite book on that topic is your book.

Farrell: Thank you. I wish that I had this book or at least known about it when I was writing mine.

Once you see and know the soft techniques of it, I think that people will be more comprehending of what we are talking about when we talk about mind manipulation.

Fitts: There are so many techniques.

Farrell: There are, and we all succumb to them. Like it or not, they've been

more or less in our face with the advent of wokery and the constant pushing of messages – not only in commercials, but in movies.

It began very subtle. This is what I don't think people appreciate; the wokery was very subtle. It's been there for a number of decades. It's now to the point that it has lost its subtlety.

If you look at older movies or television programs, you will see it once you know what you are looking for; it's very true.

Fitts: What do you think that getting corporations to take suicidal acts to promote woke products like Bud Light is all about? You have companies violating their fiduciary obligation to shareholders.

Farrell: It boggles my mind. The only thing that I can think of is that this is a process that began in the churches. The churches were infiltrated first by all this nonsense. I know that sounds 'nuts', but it is true.

Fitts: I agree with you. Do you know why? I can't tell you how many successful churches with large congregations that were financially secure were torn apart by this stuff, and it destroyed their finances and bankrupted their churches and split the congregation. It was a plan; it was a plan to destroy those churches.

Farrell: The fallout from Vatican II is the bellwether – when the Roman Catholic Church suddenly decided that it wasn't going to be 'Catholic' anymore. What happened was that people just quit going to church; the churches are empty.

You go to a traditional Latin mass church, and they are usually full. And it happened across the board. Traditional Lutheran churches are full, and the modernist ones aren't. On and on we could go.

What I am getting to here is I think that the same tactic of infiltration and then patiently waiting until a person gets to a position of management where they could influence decisions and policy within corporations happened. This is what happened to Bud Light.

In other words, I don't think that it was some nasty plot of the board of Anheuser-Busch or the CEO; it was a decision taken at a lower level that caught the entire corporation. What Bud Light did not do that could have saved their 'butts' (pardon my French) was once that happened, they needed to come out and get in front of it immediately and say, "We are sorry. We apologize," and make a point of apologizing, particularly to the very customer base they offended by that action.

That is what they did not do, and that is why they are suffering. That is what I think.

Fitts: They did a follow-up ad that somebody put on Twitter. It was a minutelong ad about everybody at a picnic, and it made every white man out to be stupid. It was idiocrasy; white people are idiocrasy. It was very offensive.

Basically, the ad said, "Our customers are stupid people. They are fools."

Farrell: What they needed to do was the exact opposite. As a brand name and as a fiduciary responsibility, I think they have permanently hurt themselves. Disney is another case in point. So, I think from that standpoint, people need to be aware that I have three S's: Shun, shame, and parallel structure.

When you start getting that kind of behavior from a corporation or anyone in your life, I shun. If they are 'off the charts' degenerates like the Biden family, then shame them. These people do not deserve to be in the positions of power or responsibility, and they should be ashamed to go out in public. They do not deserve to be treated with respect. Courtesy, yes, respect, no. There is a difference, and that is the other thing that we have to get through our heads; courtesy is one thing; respect is another.

Finally, we need to start building parallel structures. If you can't find a beer that suits your cultural taste, make your own.

Fitts: Exactly.

One of my favorite stories, and we've talked about it before but I ran it again in

'Free and Inspired Life'. There was a college in Ohio where the alums got together and put up scholarships. If you would agree to live without a smartphone for four years, they would pay for your college tuition. It is very popular, and apparently it is doing very, very well and the youths are happy.

Farrell: 'Fancy that'! That is my commercial for 'don't get a smartphone'; I don't want one.

The last place I want to talk to somebody on the phone is when I'm standing in the grocery line.

Fitts: We have four Unanswered Questions in the 'Free and Inspired Life'. You pick. Which questions would you like to address? We have a total of 50 Unanswered Questions in Part II, but we will not do all of them, but I encourage everybody to read through them.

Farrell: I think the most interesting is **Question #2**.

Question #2: Personal Tragedy: How do we balance the needs of those around us experiencing personal tragedy with the importance of maintaining our inspiration and forward motion?

Fitts: This one is important.

Farrell: This one is very important. My answer is to tithe. In other words, if your next-door neighbor or across-the-street neighbor or whatever is in a financial bind, make that your tithe. Give to that person directly.

I've said it before and I'll say it again: Quit living in the grand abstractions. We are called to love our neighbor, not humanity. The incarnation is about the Son of God; it's not about 'the divine'.

All of these grand abstractions that we live in are not human. They are useful philosophically, and they can help us culturally and so on, but they are not sources of action.

Fitts: Let me ask you a tough question: You try to talk your family out of

taking the injection, and you don't, and then they do. Now they are asking you to help them because they are in trouble. What do you do?

Farrell: It depends on the attitude. If they are wanting help and are in a situation where they are needing help because they didn't follow advice, I don't think that means you withhold help, but I do think it does allow you the license to say, "I told you so."

In other words, I think there has to be a bit of recognition that you were right and they were wrong.

Fitts: In the *Family Financial Disclosure Form,* we set it up so that one person in a family is saying to someone else, "Here is the due diligence you have to do, and here is the healthcare and life insurance and disability insurance that you have to arrange. Basically, if you are going to do something stupid, you don't get to suddenly demand my time and money because you made a mistake."

I always like to get people to take those actions to protect family and friends before they do something tragic as opposed to after.

Farrell: I think there has to be an effort – or at least an understanding. Everybody has to weigh that according to their circumstance. It's not an easy 'one-shot-fits-all' type of thing. You just have to evaluate it. But I do think that in terms of balancing things, that kind of personal help is your time; make it your time.

Fitts: One of the sermons that most helped me in my life was at the worst moment in the 1990's when everything looked hopeless and horrible. I got a wonderful sermon from the co-pastor at church who persuaded me that it's okay to be happy and live in joy despite all the horrible things going on around me. You don't have an obligation to be miserable just because evil is afoot; you can find joy and can celebrate, and it's okay to do it.

That is why I try to keep a state of amusement despite the most horrible things going on.

Farrell: You have to look at that as itself a tithe. If the world is falling apart

and everything is 'gloom and doom', then to a certain extent, you are falling away from your own obligation and duty when you go along with it. This is not to say that there aren't real evils and real suffering and that we don't have those things happening. I'm not saying that. But when you give in to what the rest of the world is doing and adopt its response and its attitude, that is when it becomes a problem. That is worshipping something else other than God; you are giving your tithe to that rather than to God. I totally agree.

Fitts: So Pillar I was 'Free and Inspired Life.' We started with a quote from Wim Hof. Last year when we did the 2021 Annual Wrap Up, we said that 50 subscribers who had been harmed by the pandemic – whether it was the injection or COVID or the lockdowns – we will give a free copy of the Wim Hof method because we think it can help. We gave out 200 copies, and it's because we got 200 emails. Those are the hardest 200 emails I've had to read in my life. What had happened to people was so gut-wrenching horrible. It knocked me back, yet here they were ready to get back up and go back in. It was very inspiring.

We just kept sending out more Wim Hof books.

Pillar II: Navigation Tools.

When I first created *The Solari Report*, I was doing the *Solari Investment Advisory Company*, and I found out that all my clients didn't have good maps. I said, "I'll do *The Solari Report*. Instead of explaining this 50 times every week, I will explain it once. I will record an audio."

I'm always trying to help our subscribers, and you are too, to help understand, "Here is the official reality, and here is reality." You call it the 'narrative'.

If you are going to be successful in this world, you have to understand them both and be able to navigate a world where many decisions need to be based on reality, but your 'chatter' at the cocktail party needs to be based on the official reality.

I am constantly thinking for a quarter or for a year and saying, "What can we do that will provide people with the best maps?"

Last year, we did a great interview with you called, *Who Is Mr. Global?* I don't know if you remember this, but when I first started looking into who Mr. Global was, I was on Kris Millegan's interview, the CIA drug trafficking. You used to get these horrible fights between people who would say, "It's the Vatican," and another group would say, "No, it's the Mason," and yet another group would say, "It's the Jews."

According to each one of these groups, their target ran the world and was the source of all evil. I kept saying, "I grew up in Philadelphia. All three of those groups were collaborating together to bring in the drugs and run everything." It's a big planet.

It was a two-hour interview with you. I hung up and realized that we had not even gotten down to the level of, "It's the Vatican, it's the Masons, it's the Jews."

I thought, "Wow! That was quite a high level!"

I think that you try very hard to give people good maps of what is going on and help them understand how incredibly different reality is from the official narrative.

Farrell: The reality is that when you talk about elites or the world oligarchs or whatever you want to call them; the reality is that world is multipolar. It is not only the Vatican; it is not only the Jews or the Khazarians or whatever term you want to use for them. It's not only the Israelis or the Masons or the secret societies, and on and on we could go. Pick your group: Nazis, communists, whatever.

They have all been involved in this, and they all are involved in it. It is a multipolar conspiratorial world.

You mentioned under 'targeting', the question: Are specific religious groups being targeted? You mentioned this in **Part I**. Yes, I think they are being targeted, and I think that Christians are at the top of the list, but so are any religions that have influenced traditional cultures. That includes Islam and

Judaism.

Fitts: Any devout religion is a target.

Farrell: What do we do? My advice to a pastor or a rabbi or an imam or what have you, do not register your religious group, your church, your synagogue, or whatever as a 501(c)(3). Pay your taxes, and retain the ability to comment and criticize the government at every step. Christianity has lost its muscle in this country because they bought into Lyndon Johnson's swindle, and he even boasted about it.

We would have a much more muscular Christianity in this country if they weren't worried about preserving their property and their organization.

You have the question about divine intelligence. I think that particularly in the West and particularly in this country, we have the subliminal push to worship technology and the government as substitutes for God.

Fitts: Really?

Farrell: Yes, I do.

You have to remember burning incense to Caesar. What was that act really signifying? The Christians didn't do that because they understood that act was not simply worshipping Caesar; that is not what the act symbolized. The act symbolized the glorification and worship of the genius of Roman administration.

In other words, when that act was done, you were worshipping the state and its ability to take the place of God. I think Americans have a subliminal inclination to do that. We have to get out of that. This government and all of its wonderful social programs is not a substitute for God, and that is what it has become.

Fitts: Here is the thing: Who is your governor? My governor is God, not the government. I report to God, not the Bushes and the Clintons. I should maybe say, "Who is your governor? Is it God or the tax authorities?"

One of my favorite links I found in 2023 was, Why Do Demons Hate Gregorian Chants and Flee When They Are Sung or Played? I love Gregorian chants, and I've been collecting Gregorian chants for many, many decades.

There was a great music store at the corner of 74th and Lexington near my apartment on 75th Street. I used to go in, and the person who worked there was a Gregorian chant expert and knew chants around the world. Every week I would go in and say, "What do I want to buy?" and he would pick out one for me to buy. I discovered Gregorian chants and chanting at that time, and I love it.

It doesn't me at all if it drives demons out.

Farrell: There is a kind of music that I definitely think is and should be associated with the divine, and there is a kind of music that I definitely think should be associated with the diabolical. Absolutely.

Fitts: At the end of 2022, we did a backcasting, and published it in January 2023 where nine *Solari* hosts got together and said, "It's 2030, freedom reigns, Schwab is in a depression, hidden away at his home in the Alps, and we are going to tell you the story of how it happened."

So, each person did their rendition. The food person did food, and another person did European culture, and another person did science, and so we all went in our 'lane' and told how we succeeded. I'll tell you, it put us in the best mood. It was unbelievable. We started with freedom succeeding and worked backwards. You can listen to it at *Solari*.

Anybody can do this; you can do it for your world, you can do it for your business, and it's a way of starting success, and it is very inspiring. You come up with great ideas.

The other thing I wanted to stress is how we organize our *Wrap Ups*. I'm a great believer that you can follow the news, but it's much easier to first learn the primary trends. Then if you understand the primary trends but it requires going deep in them, the news always makes sense.

It's like having a coat rack for all the coats. So, what we try to do in every *Wrap Up* is go deep on one primary trend. The hope is that after many quarters of going deep on a primary trend one quarter at a time, you start to collect a great deal of knowledge about many of the important primary trends. Then it's much easier and faster to follow the news. That is how I've always done it, and I think that is how you've always done it. You read books, and if you read books about the primary trends, then everything turns out. It takes a while to kick over into that system, but everything starts making much more sense.

Unanswered Question #6 addresses that somebody is trying to kill us.

Question #6: Targeting & Protection: Are the depopulation (sterilization, euthanasia, poisoning) efforts focused on Christians or other religious groups? Does this explain the real targeting of communities with a high percentage of Christians? Does this explain the effort to shut down and bankrupt churches or get them financially dependent on government? How do we use prayer and spiritual tools to protect ourselves, our families, and our communities from sterilization, euthanasia and poisoning?

So, how do you adjust to living in a world where someone is trying to kill you? We are in a war, and somebody is trying to kill us. How do you adjust to a world where you are not safe and you are having to navigate a dangerous world?

Farrell: My answer has always been prayer for protection. I literally make it a point – and this is because it's part of the old 'catholic' Christian tradition. By 'catholic', I mean traditional Roman Catholicism or Eastern Orthodoxy, or even Anglicanism at a certain point in its history. They would have little prayer offices that were praying for certain events.

If you went on a trip, there were prayers in the prayer books that you prayed to take a trip. It was things like that.

I follow that tradition in the sense that I always say a prayer if I travel anywhere. If I go outside to grocery shop, I will say a little prayer for protection, not only of me, but for my little dog while she is at home. In other words, if you are the praying sort, make it a custom to vest little things like this that are daily occurrences. Make it a habit to vest these daily occurrences with Godly habits

and with God.

In the liturgical churches, you say prayers when the priest is vesting, and certain prayers are said with each piece of cloth. Do the same thing when you are dressing. Ephesians talks about 'the helmet of salvation' and 'the girdle of truth'. Those are items of clothing. Literally, they are telling you to pray when you are doing these things.

Fitts: I love to pray. I'll pray when I'm driving; I'll pray when I'm cleaning the house; I will pray any time. Any time that you could be listening to a podcast, you can also be praying.

Farrell: My point is this: How do you survive in a world that is out to kill you? Pray for protection.

Fitts: And pray for intelligence.

Farrell: Yes, pray for the guidance and wisdom and things to negotiate through this crazy world. I've started the habit of praying for courage. We are in a world that wants to kill us, and they may do it. It may be required of us to do that. I'm a good, old-fashioned coward. So. if that happens to be my lot in life, then I hope I will have the courage to go through with it.

These people are wicked, they are evil, they are insane, and we need to realize that. For those who are not the praying sort, I go back to what you mentioned about Dr. William Tiller. If you're not the praying sort, then 'by golly' you need to get busy with the Tiller method and write your formal intention and agree on it. That's all liturgical prayer is; it's nothing but a written out formal intention.

Fitts: Let's turn to Pillar III. 'Freedom' was Pillar I, 'Navigation Tools' was Pillar II. So, first you need to know where you're going, which is your 'Free and Inspired Life'. Number two, you must have good maps. And the third pillar is that you need great risk management.

Pillar III: Risk Management.

We have already started to get into this. One of the stories we posted in

'Navigation Tools' was the report that one of the side effects of vaccines is a deterioration in a person's sanity or their mind. We see reports of more traffic fatalities. People are more in a trance, which could be the phones or it could be EMF. It's not necessarily only the vaccines.

You do see a deterioration in behavior, and it could be from physical things like the **Great Poisoning**. When I was heavy metals toxic, and to a certain extent, I still am, it was very hard to think. So, it could be the toxicity as well.

It could be physical, but it could also be spiritual or demonic possession or influence. It could be psychological – breaking down from the stress. There are many things that can affect a person's quality of behavior in this environment.

One of the things that most concerns me is not other people's behavior, but the weaponization of mental health. You have all these doctors' offices trying to get everybody to have their children do a mental health survey. This is very dangerous. You do not want to take any of those kinds of things; you don't want to do any surveys; you don't want to be analyzed for mental health. This could be weaponized against you, and your children can be taken away.

Do not let your children answer any of these surveys or participate in any of this; it is all very, very dangerous.

Farrell: Yes, I agree.

Fitts: Also navigating this environment where people are and reacting against stress or deterioration of mind or mind control requires much more patience. I keep watching people who are very, very patient with other people, and I'm trying to learn how to be more patient. It's hard.

Farrell: It is very hard.

Fitts: Do you have any tricks?

Farrell: Not really! There is always primal scream therapy.

Fitts: I could never get into that.

Farrell: I couldn't either, but every now and then, you get so frustrated that you just have to go into the bathroom, shut the door, and let it go. It does get so crazy.

There is so much here under **Risk Management**. You have so many **Unanswered Questions** under this pillar that I have notes all over the place.

Fitts: I should mention that under 'Risk Management', we go from Unanswered Question #8 down to Unanswered Question #35. So, that's 27 Unanswered Questions. You pick the ones you want to cover.

Farrell: I like number 12:

Question #12: High-tech Risks: What are the extreme risks generated by new technology: mRNA gene therapy, high-tech fires, the push for immortality, DNA editing, 5G+ mind control and assassinations, and the interbreeding of humans with other species? What else? What should we do to learn more about weather warfare, interdimensionality, time travel, and geophysical risks? Could we get an Project Blue Beam (create an artificial SecondComing) in 2023? Do we have the capacity to create our own telepathic portals for global "travel"?

Let's just focus on 'interbreeding with other species'. That is really the 'erasure of boundaries'. If you put it into the context of 'wokery', we have men raiding women's bathrooms and women's sports, and vice-versa. You know me, I'm a big anti-woman's ordination person. That was another one of those wokery moments.

What is going on, in my opinion, is the collapse or erasure of boundaries. When boundaries are erased, what ultimately is the result? The ultimate result is entropy.

In other words, this is a cosmological phenomenon that I'm trying to get across in the disguise of a merely cultural or political one. I hope people latch onto that; it is a cosmological nihilistic phenomenon that is masquerading as a cultural and political one.

Once you see that, then you see the spiritual reality behind it all. I think that so many people have been fooled into thinking that this is merely political and cultural; it's not; it's not at all.

Fitts: They are tearing our fields apart.

Farrell: What is the point of having so-called 'transgendered' men participate in women's sports?

Fitts: You destroy the field.

Farrell: That is precisely what is going on.

Fitts: And you take a whole generation of women and destroy their hope in the future.

Farrell: You are destroying femaleness, and you are destroying maleness; you are erasing all boundaries. Once that very basic boundary goes, all the others go with it.

Fitts: Where it takes you is the government can control the children.

Farrell: That too.

Fitts: They want to destroy the family so they can control the children. Then they can control the genes that come into the world.

Farrell: Look at what they are doing: They are erasing the boundary between childhood and adulthood. Think of it in terms of this erasure of boundaries and borders. This is what is going on, and it is cosmological in nature.

On and on we could go, but these things have had a long time to percolate. I can't fathom why people don't see the cosmological nature of it. You and I have discussed this nihilism agenda in many of the recent *Quarterly Wrap Ups* we've done, and I don't think that people have 'latched' onto that.

Fitts: I think that they are trying to protect themselves by pretending that they

can ignore it.

Farrell: I agree with you, and I think that is definitely part of it.

Fitts: The other thing is that it is hard to fathom. I can fathom the people at the top because I've worked at the top, but it's hard to comprehend the psychopathy that we are dealing with.

Farrell: It is.

Fitts: It is also hard to understand our culpability with it. If you look at our culpability legally, financially, and politically, we have been culpable. We talked about it in **Part I**. I watched Elizabeth Vargas act like 320,000 dead Ukraine soldiers was a video game and it was nothing. "Who cares?" It's frightening.

Any other **Unanswered Questions** in this section that you would like to talk about?

Farrell: There is another one that I think is very important:

Question #22: Non-State Actors: To what extent are we dealing with multiple non-state actors controlling nuclear bombs and invisible weaponry? Will the principles established by the Treaty of Westphalia (1648) regarding sovereign monopoly on force completely disintegrate?

I believe I mentioned my Yevgeny Prigozhin speculation scenario that this whole thing was to get the Wagner group in Belorussia so there would be troops on the ground to control the Russian nuclear weapons that had been deployed there.

I think the danger of non-state actors in possession of weapons like that is extremely high. I go back to something that we mentioned in the *Wrap Up* before last. It was after the last Presidential election.

Do you remember Nancy Pelosi coming out with her criticism of the nuclear football (mobile hub carried by a military aide when the President is traveling), and she wanted to put the nuclear football under the control of a committee?

She didn't want Trump starting a nuclear war with Russia. That was her excuse.

I think she didn't want 'dementia Joe' in control of the nuclear football. I strongly suspect that, given the fact that we are dealing with a President who is simply a cardboard cutout and someone else is in control, they are also in control of that nuclear football.

Effectively, that means we are dealing with a private, non-elected something or other that has no oversight.

Fitts: That's what FASAB 56 was about; they control the money, and they control the nuclear codes.

Farrell: I think the danger is quite high that the American nuclear arsenal is not even under the public command structure anymore, and I strongly suspect that part of Russia is. This means that we can start thinking of companies like BlackRock, and so on that also have the potential to assume that type of power.

That bothers me immensely in a culture where you can start talking about 320,000 casualties (deaths) as if they are a mere statistic. When you can have – at least in this country – a political leadership that is so 'nuts' that they don't even realize the consequences of a nuclear war anymore, but at least the Russians still do, and the Chinese and the Indians still do, thank goodness. But I don't think that our political class in this country have any idea what they are talking about.

I think it's unfortunately a very high chance that we are dealing with private non-state actors now who have access to these things.

Fitts: I will say this: The drama that we just watched with the Wagner group is what happens; you create a mercenary army, and they need funding. If they don't get their funding, then they go to war. It's dangerous. I think a mercenary army is the stupidest thing I've ever heard.

I did two book reviews of Sean McFate's books on mercenary armies. I recommend both of his books. This thing about tearing up the Treaty of Westphalia is so much more. This will push us into medieval violence, and it already has. That is without discussing who exactly is doing the school

shootings.

Do you have any other questions under **Risk Management**?

Farrell: I would love to spend time with all of them. The Anglosphere question (Unanswered Question #29) is an important one. The Missing Money question (Unanswered Question #31) is another one.

Fitts: I would like to mention that Jeroen van Straaten wrote a big update on the *Missing Money* website, and it has all been updated and refreshed with updated chronologies and everything. I did a new interview with Mark Skidmore to summarize the *Missing Money* story and why it's so relevant, and we moved many of the missing money pieces all into that one website at www.MissingMoney.Solari.com. So it's a comprehensive collection if you want to learn about the missing money.

Farrell: Your question here about the **Missing Money** is very interesting, especially the part: How important was Afghanistan and the Middle East army operations to laundering the missing money after 9/11 and then the financial crisis?

I think that it was crucially and critically important. I think that this hidden system of finance absolutely requires the physical movement of actual physical financial instruments – be they bonds, securities, cash, whatever – as well as physical assets.

In other words, this is not a make-believe economy, and this is not a make-believe financial system. And they need places like the Middle East or Afghanistan where they are close to the 'pipelines' of the drug trade and where they are in geographical positions of the world that are 'not part of most people's radar'. I absolutely think the analog system, in spite of all this hype and talk of digital currencies or central bank digital currencies, is something that they know is critically important.

Fitts: Right, it is to them; they want real. They give us the simulation, and they want real.

I continue to believe the sovereign immunity of the BIS (Bank for International Settlements) and their extension of that to systemically important banks, insurance companies, and payment systems is absolutely critical to this two-tiered system. Whatever the breakaway civilizations are, the BIS is one of the 'toggle points' between us and them. There is no doubt about it.

Farrell: Thank you, Agustin Carstens.

Fitts: I have a link to it here. You and I had this fantastic conversation about, *Who Is Mr. Global?* That was a fun conversation because there are so many things going on on this planet and so many things that make no sense. As you know, I think the economy is open, not closed. It's the only way I can explain it.

Farrell: Absolutely, I think it's open. But let me toss something out about Mr. Global for a moment: I wonder who is on everyone's Mr. Global list.

In other words, if everyone listening to or reading this right now were to take out a legal pad and write down 25 names they think are the big names in Mr. 'Globaloney's' cabal, what 25 names would people come up with?

You and I can probably name at least 5 if not 10, but I'm wondering who everyone else would put on their list of Mr. 'Globaloney'.

Fitts: Do you know who they would write down? They would put down many of the chew toys.

Farrell: I think so, too. But after listings by the 25 individuals, I would want them to write down 25 corporations or foundations that they think are at the center of this cabal. I wonder what sort of response we would get. We are doing a kind of survey there. I wonder what kind of survey results we would find and how that survey would differ from, not only people and their ages, but where in the world they are situated.

Fitts: I think it's much easier to do the corporations and foundations than the individuals because anybody at the top of Mr. Global's structure, with rare exception, is going to be invisible; you don't know them, and don't know their names.

Farrell: My list would probably be much different than most people, and I'm sure that yours would be, too. My list would include many old family names. Let's put it that way.

Fitts: It's the intergenerational capital that is represented.

Farrell: Yes, and I know that you have had personal experience with some of those old families. I wrote *The Financial Vipers of Venice*, and I can think of quite a few names that are still around and still have plenty of 'juice' from that period of history.

Fitts: I have to warn you that I've only known one member of the Venetian black nobility, and he was one of the most enlightened and impressive people I've ever met.

Farrell: I can believe that. I think these families are much more involved in contemporary affairs. I have a friend in Indonesia who you and I have talked with, and we have both been interviewed by him, Bernard Grover. Bernard has this – I don't know what else to call it – 'royalist scenario' in his head. As a matter of fact, the 'royalist scenario' is also a scenario that another friend of mine and I entertain.

But I'm watching these royals, and it's interesting to see what they are doing. It's just bizarre.

We had the coronation of King Charles.

Fitts: That was strange.

Farrell: That was very strange. We've had the reemergence of all this royalist symbolism in Russia – the guards in the Kremlin are wearing the guard uniforms of the Imperial Guard of the late 19th century. It's like the czar's personal regimen. It's so strange.

So, I think with Mr. 'Globaloney', we tend to think of the Klaus Schwab's and the Bill Gates' and the George Soros', but these are the middle echelon

managers or something else.

Fitts: Have you ever read, *The Making of the Representative of Planet 8* by Dori Lessing?

Farrell: I have heard of her, but I have never read her books.

Fitts: When I was in college, I had an English professor. If you were in his classes, he reserved the right to give you a special request. It was something you had to do. If you got a special request, you had to do it. If you didn't do it, you flunked the course. If you did it and did a great job, it didn't affect your course, but you still had to do it.

The special request I got was to read every book that Doris Lessing ever wrote and write a three-page report. So I did. The problem, if you lived in Millbrook, New York, was how in the world to get a copy of all of Doris Lessing's books. But I did. *The Making of the Representative for Planet 8* is about a small planet with a temperate climate. People live very happily there and enjoy life. It was colonized by the galactic empire, Canopus. It was populated with a new species that was created from the stock of four different species on other planets.

Everything was going nicely, and then suddenly, the galactic empire showed up and said, "Okay, you have to build a big wall around the middle of the planet because it turns out that another Ice Age is coming."

They gave all sorts of instructions to the leadership, which made the people of this planet do the most ridiculous things and change their lives. Things got worse and worse approaching the ice age.

Finally at the end, the leadership is raptured up into galactic spaceships by the empire who takes them away because nobody can survive on the planet. This is a way of getting people to cope with this period on the planet.

I hate to say it, but the more that time goes by, I feel like I'm living in a Doris Lessing novel.

Farrell: You and I have discussed this many times in various contexts. They

are acting like they are under some sort of scheduled time constraint.

Fitts: It's what you said at the 2015 Secret Space conference; they are under treaty obligations.

Farrell: They are up to something. I tend to think that if they have 'crawled into bed' with some sort of off-planet entities, they have 'crawled into bed' with the wrong ones.

Fitts: Here is the thing: I believe they did globalization when they did it because they wanted to build a multi-planetary civilization. Then the question is: Why? Why are they in so big of a hurry?

You would be in such a hurry because you don't want to 'bet the ranch' on one planet. That is why you would be in a hurry.

Farrell: That is possible.

Fitts: If I were them, that is what I would do: I would build a multi-planet civilization. The reality is that if you bring Asia into the first world, you have a much better chance of getting there fast.

I hate to sound like an investment banker, but it's just a capacity issue.

Farrell: I definitely want to talk about one of the questions there. You're not going to like the one that I'm going to talk about, though.

Fitts: Really?

Farrell: I don't think you're going to like it.

Fitts: I always like it.

IV. Living Equity.

Living equity is all those things that are the assets we have that are not priced and traded and owned, even though Mr. Global clearly wants to price and trade

and own them; it's the living equity. It's the animals and the planets and the environment; it's us and our family and children.

I always say that the important thing in building wealth is to integrate your living equity and your financial equity. All financial wealth comes from life; it comes from our education and developing skills and taking time and doing this, etc.

You want to build your living equity and use it to build financial equity that you use to support and further make your living equity powerful. There is a very important integrated strategy that we are trying to teach people.

One thing that I wanted to point out is we did a fabulous interview with Ulrike Granögger about how control and freedom happen one person at a time. Then we realized that if you look at CBDC, it is integrating with the digital mind control and surveillance, and they are literally trying to harvest the energetic body of the human being. That is an interview I would really encourage people to listen to.

If you look at the three lines they have used to control, which are surveillance and telecommunications, the financial 'nuts and bolts', and covert operations, they are integrating that into one system. You cannot understand it unless you understand our etheric bodies (layers of energy that surrounds our bodies) or energetic bodies – whatever you want to call it – and our shared intelligence and how they want to play and manipulate with those. So, that is one I really recommend.

We have **Unanswered Questions #36** through **#47**. So where do you want to dive in?

Farrell: I would love to dive into all of them, but all I'm going to say with **Question #36** two words, and I want people to 'latch' onto them because I have a feeling that we will be returning to these in the future.

Fitts: We have to read Question #36 first.

Farrell: Question #36: Sun Cycles and Geophysical Risks: What is happening to the sun? Are we entering into a period of diminished sun spot

activity? What would that mean for our weather and economy? Are we experiencing a new cooling cycle and at risk of a new ice age? Why is Gates talking about blotting out the sun? Is the risk of a coronal mass ejection (CME) real? Does Earth have a 'Three-Body Problem'? Why was there a pattern of civilization destruction 10,000 years ago? As the planet enters a cooling cycle, it looks like Mr. Global is unwilling to share what he knows about geophysical risks with the general public. Is Mr. Global 'playing around' with stellar physics to show someone 'out there' what we can do?

The two words that I will 'throw out' there are 'solar engineering'. I think it's possible, and I think it's been going on. What I'm thinking about now is a new twist to it.

Fitts: Are they worried about a new cooling cycle? Is that what they are worried about?

Farrell: No. I'm going to just 'toss' this out there and let people 'scratch and sniff' around this one. This is the one that my mom used to say was about dirt scratching and laying eggs.

Back in May of 1999, something very unusual happened with the sun. Do you know what it was?

Fitts: You're not talking about the nuclear explosion, are you? I think that was to the moon, wasn't it?

Farrell: Yes, the nuclear explosion was sent to the moon. You can actually find this on NASA's website. In May of 1999, for about two days, the solar wind shut down.

Fitts: I remember this.

Farrell: That means the model of the sun as being a big chained up hydrogen bomb constantly going off and being restrained by the sheer force of gravity is not correct.

That is a 'whopper'. You have to cogitate about that. So, I'm going to toss out

there 'solar engineering'.

Fitts: So you think that somebody turned it off.

Farrell: Yes.

Fitts: What year was that?

Farrell: That was 1999. I realize that in **Unanswered Questions**, we 'crawl right to the end of the twig' of speculation. But if that is the case, then who was it that turned it off? That is the \$64,000 question.

Fitts: It's hard to imagine it's anyone on Earth. There is no way to know, but I don't think there is any way it came from Earth.

Farrell: Not entirely. If you are dealing with CERN; magnets that are several times more powerful than the local magnetic field of the Earth, then it stands to reason those magnetic fields might have a planetary effect on the magnetosphere. Since the magnetosphere of this planet touches that of the sun, it is entirely feasible, theoretically, that you would get resonance effects on the sun of what you are doing here.

Fitts: If that was the case, are you saying that it was accidental?

Farrell: Who knows? I'm not saying that. I'm just saying your idea that we are living in an open system is credible. You know me; I've been pushing open system physics for as long as I've been studying it.

Fitts: If you look at the thing in the ring, that is an open system. I'm referring to the book, *The Ringmakerss of Saturn*, by Norman Bergrun. When the Voyager passed the rings, it saw a 70-mile-long spaceship made of plasma docking in the rings. That is when the explosion of financial fraud began.

Farrell: Yes, and there is yet another twist on the Norman Bergrun thing that I think is going to occur to you once the new book is out.

Fitts: Great! Okay.

Farrell: I wish I could say more publicly.

Fitts: No, don't say a word. We will wait until the book comes out.

Farrell: I have scribbled all sorts of notes on your outline, but the question that really 'popped out' at me was #44.

Question #44: Is Air Travel Safe? What is the Status of remote control, pilot heart attacks, 5G concerns, software control, and low-grade bio warfare?

This is why I don't think you will like me talking about this since you are going to have to fly back to Europe.

You know me; I hate to fly. I don't fly. In fact, since the heart attack, it's probably not a very wise thing for me to fly anyway. But I haven't flown since I flew back from England when I finished my doctorate. That was the last time I flew, and it was a conscious decision back in 1987.

Ever since these 'quackcines', I have heard from people on my website- from friends of friends-telling me that they know people who are acting mighty peculiarly. I have had some people email me actual audio – and in a couple of cases video – of air traffic control to pilot conversations since the 'quackcines' came out.

As you know, there have been incidents of pilots who have been vaccinated having medical emergencies. In some cases, there have been pilots or copilots – whoever is flying the plane – having incidents of brain fog.

I think that since these 'quackcinations' – which is what I've been calling them ever since Operation Warp Speed and what they were doing became apparent – the risk of air traffic safety has climbed.

Fitts: I totally agree.

Farrell: I have heard some of the most absurd conversations between pilots and air traffic control, and I mentioned this in the last quarterly *Wrap Up*. What

bothers me is we have recently had –since the last Wrap Up – more incidents of pilots on the taxiways around airports taxiing at the wrong time and so on.

Fitts: I played a wonderful video for you of an Australian student. The pilot fainted, and the student is on his first lesson. He has no idea how to land a plane, and the air traffic controller talks him down, and it works; they succeeded. The air traffic controller is fabulous. As the student is landing the plane, he says, "I hope they're not going to charge me for this."

The air traffic controller said, "Don't worry. If they do, I will pay for it."

Farrell: Let's take it a step further:. If this was the impact on the air travel industry, imagine the impact on trucking, on oceanic shipping, and on the highways. Just driving around here where I live, I'm amazed at some of the stunts I see people pulling. Even bad driving happened before the 'quackcinations', but now it's 'off the chart'. I don't even like travelling anymore.

There is a reason I do my little prayer rituals before I travel to the grocery store. You never know what you will see. It's 'off the chart whack-a-doodle'. Put someone in charge of an airbus? No thank you.

Fitts: I think it has seriously impaired safety, but I still do it. If you look at what I do for my business, it's no different than getting on the internet that is full of mind control and all this other things, but I still use it.

We build our business on a certain infrastructure, and then as the infrastructure changes in terms of risk, it's hard to pull out.

Farrell: I understand that. I'm not saying, "Don't fly." I'm only saying that travel now is becoming much riskier because of these dangerous 'quackcines'.

Fitts: I travel much less than I used to because it's not worth the risk. I need to go back and forth between Europe and the United States, but there are many other places I would be going. I just don't need the hassle.

Farrell: I'm the same way. I don't travel nearly as much as I used to, but now I wouldn't even be inclined to drive a long-distance trip like I used to because of

all the 'wackiness' I see.

Fitts: Oh, I would! You're not going to get me out of long-distance road-tripping. I love it!

Farrell: I do, too. That's the problem for me.

Fitts: Here's the thing: Long-distance road-tripping in Europe is safer than it is in the United States except when you are in Germany. Get out of the fast lane in Germany.

When I first got there, I got a tiny car because, where I live, a tiny car was fine. I had a tiny Peugeot. The first time I drove to Switzerland, all these huge BMWs and Mercedes went by at '200' miles an hour, and they 'blow you off the road' and don't care. The Germans are ruthless.

Farrell: Get them on their Autobahn. I know what you're talking about!

Fitts: I had to get a bigger car because I got tired of being 'blown off the road' by the big BMWs. The Germans are unbelievable.

Farrell: 'No speed limit' Germany! That's the truth.

Fitts: Do you have any other **Unanswered Questions** you would like to cover?

Farrell: No, we're good, although I do have a response to **Question #47**.

Question #47: Deprogramming: How do we help the people tricked and harmed by the many lies and frauds in recent years to forgive themselves and move forward in a positive manner? How do we protect ourselves from adult fairy tales and hope porn?

All I can say to that is to turn off the 'propatainment' media and support the actors who are not doing woke shows. Support Jim Caviezel and his movie, *The Sound of Freedom*, and people like that.

Fitts: The other thing is to do a time budget. Look seriously at your time budget, and then save time by deleting from your life anything that is draining you.

Farrell: I started watching a series starring Sylvester Stallone, which is set in the city that I live in. It was quite a good and interesting series. I can look at it and say, "Oh, I know where that is." It's a fun series, and it's not woke.

As far as I'm concerned, start supporting the actors and actresses who are not pandering to this nonsense. Give them a 'shout-out'. So I give a shout-out to Jim Caviezel and Sylvester Stallone.

Fitts: Jim Caviezel is fabulous. I'm going to give this away: His movie is showing now and he is the *Hero of the Week*.

V. Financial Equity.

I have a great quote from Peter Lynch that I use all the time, "Know what you own, and why you own it."

One of the things we've been doing is fighting the worst kinds of scams, particularly precious metals scams. People are getting on the internet and are being put into fear, and are immediately cashing out what they have, and then going into other things. This is the worst nightmare of what you can do.

Please never make investment decisions from a space of fear; never go to fear. Anyone who puts you in fear, you should remove from your life. If you want to do precious metals, find reputable dealers and price things out in the market. Get multiple quotes from multiple dealers; price things out at the market.

The other thing is get a good, well-managed, well-governed bank or credit union. That is the 'train tracks' of your transactions.

We have many great links and there is plenty of information in the *Building Wealth* curriculum about all the different things you can do to either build financial wealth or protect your financial wealth. CBDCs and the financial transaction controls are out to basically steal everything is what I believe.

In the **Financial Equity** area, we have three **Unanswered Questions**. These are our last three. Do you have any that you want to look at?

Farrell: No, but I do want to remind people that on your website you have a gold & silver price converter.

Fitts: Yes, *The Silver & Gold Payment Calculator*. It's very hard to organize a community currency. I said, "Just do it. Take out your gold and silver and start doing it. You don't have to organize anything; you don't need bylaws; you don't need an organization; you don't need a board; you don't need a bank. Just do it. *The Silver & Gold Calculator* is meant to help you do that."

I did a Financial Rebellion 31: Where to Stash Your Cash in 2022 episode last year. People always say, "I don't know where to put my money." There are over 30 ways of how to be diversified. There are plenty of places to put your cash.

The thing to remember now is to stay real; just stay real and get as resilient as you can; keep it real.

Farrell: One of your articles listed here is, *I Want to Stop CBDCs. What Should I Do?*

I received those baseball caps you sent me that says, 'Make Cash Great Again'.

Fitts: Do you wear them?

Farrell: Oh, absolutely I do. The first time I wore that was at my grocery store. Everybody thought I was wearing one of the Trump's 'Make American Great Again' hats.

Fitts: Really?

Farrell: I saw people looking at it – because it's orange, but they were looking at it.

I picked the cashier line. There is a cashier at the grocery store where I like to

shop, and I always go into his line because he is relatively efficient about getting people through quickly. You know me; I hate to wait in line.

So I got in his line, and I always pay cash. He turned to me and told me the amount that I owed him. He looked at my hat, and read it so that the message was sinking in. Then I handed him cash. He didn't say anything. There was absolutely no exchange of words on the hat, but it was very clear from his facial expression and his demeanor that the message registered, and, "Oh, this is why this 'jackass' is always in my line, handing me all this money and making me count the change back."

Incidentally, speaking of counting the change back, I've noticed as I've been going around town that more and more stores are training their cashiers, particularly the youths, how to count back change. It's slow but sure.

Use Cash: The more you use it, the more the central banksters are going to hate it, and they won't be able to get away with this central bank digital currency social programming and all those other things they want to introduce with it.

Fitts: I had a great dinner with an activist who was talking about if they thought protests worked. I said, "I think that there is such a thing as an effective protest, and there is such a thing as an ineffective protest."

They said, "Give me an example of an effective protest."

I said, "There is a group in France who organized 50 people who went to the grocery store, filled their carts to the brim with food, got in the checkout line, and then informed the store that they would only pay with cash. If they didn't take cash, they would all walk out and leave those 50 carts full of things right there."

It's so French!

Farrell: I was about to say that is a very French thing to do! I love it! That's great!

Fitts: I think the more fun and playful we can be, the better.

Farrell: "Oh, you don't take cash?" Just leave. That's too good!

That means that they have to reshelf all those groceries.

Fitts: Moving on to the next pillar:

VI. Turtle Forth.

Turtling is about never quitting and continuous learning and believing that when one door closes another opens up. You just move forward creating that momentum. I remember being told many times by my attorneys, "It's hopeless."

I would say, "No, I'm not going along." Then I would go to bed. I would wake up, and suddenly, some miracle would happen, and a door would open. It was because I refused to quit.

So, I'm a great believer that you never know what happens if you simply refuse to quit. Of course, there is a picture of the 'Make Cash Great Again' hat. So, I'll do a screenshare and show everybody. If you are a subscriber, we have a link at the top of the website called 'Merchandise' and you can go get the hat.

Farrell: I wear that any time I know I'm going to spend money.

Fitts: They're really nice. I like them.

Farrell: They are a nice hat. I like the fact that you made them orange.

Fitts: Orange is my favorite color.

Farrell: I didn't know that.

Fitts: It's a healing color.

Farrell: In any case, I like it because it's a nice diversion from all the Trumpery of Trump. And I like the message. It gives people the opportunity to ask, "What

does 'Make Cash Great Again' all about?" So, you can actually strike up a conversation, too. I've had that happen a couple of times.

Fitts: There are millions of things we can all do, but the first thing that we can all do is make our own life more resilient. So food, energy, and anything that you can do in your life locally to stop feeding the beast, but also to make yourself more protected, is great.

I want to highlight that we are big on heroes here, and we had many heroes this quarter. One of the heroes was Dr. Arne Burkhardt, one of the Doctors for Covid Ethics. There was a touching memorial service for him. He was one of the great heroes of the pandemic, no doubt about it. His contribution to defining it, 'nailing' it, and providing evidence for the danger of mRNA technology was incredible.

There were so many great scientists at Doctors for Covid Ethics, but until Arne Burkhardt did his autopsies and came forward with his findings, they were confident in their opinion, but they weren't on solid ground. He put them all on rock-solid ground. From then on, it went out like a 'bolt of lightning' because everybody was 100% 'bet your life on it' certain. He did that for us, and it was incredible.

Farrell: Yes, that is great. He's my favorite curmudgeon's curmudgeon.

Fitts: He's another Oxford grad.

Farrell: I didn't realize that.

Fitts: Yes, he is one of your fellow alums. And I don't mean Oxford, Mississippi; I mean Oxford.

Here is the *Backcasting 2030* that we did and published in January.

I want to dwell a little on some of the heroes because we had a rich collection of heroes. One was Ilana Rachel Daniel who was originally American and now she lives in Israel. She was the Israeli who did one of the first rants in Israel, calling Netanyahu and all those 'bastards' out on the lockdowns. She did an interview with Blackbox in Amsterdam, and it went electric. It was one of their biggest interviews ever. They had her up for their commemoration, and she stayed with us. It was wonderful.

Then, of course, we have Sasha Latypova who, with Katherine Watt, has 'nailed' the involvement of the DOD and the fact that it was really a bioweapon. She did an interview with Kennedy, and it was great to see them integrate their pieces together.

Patricia McCullough is a wonderful judge in Pennsylvania. I saw her and listened to her speak when I was in Pennsylvania in April. She is in the Superior Court running for the Supreme Court. She gave 'chapter and verse' of how, if we don't have Constitutional judges, we are 'sunk'. God bless Trump! That was one of his good things.

Andrew Bridgen, MP – we all love the MP from England who provided the fact that somebody from 10 Downing Street called and said, "What do you want? We'll give it to you as long as you do what we say."

Peter Flaherty is the person who showed up at the Buffett annual meeting and outed where the money was going. That was funny!

Dr. Martin Schwab was the lawyer who represented Sucharit Bhakdi. He did a fabulous job.

One of my all-time favorite heroes is Tina Turner, who died this quarter. She was just a remarkable person and a remarkable performance artist.

Farrell: She really was.

Fitts: What a woman! What a great woman! She grew up not that far from where I am in Tennessee.

Then, of course, we have Dr. Burkhardt. We also have Pete Kennedy, who did our *Food Series* for several years. He stopped because he had too much going on, and he was tired. But at www.Food.Solari.com it never gets old, and it has great content.

The next hero is going to be Dr. Antonietta M. Gatti, the researcher from Italy. Then Robert Duper and Jeroen van Straaten will be heroes later on for their Secret Space Program and Breakthrough Energy conferences, which you alluded

to in Part I.

They have produced so many fantastic videos, which are as timely today as they were then. I hinted to them that they were going to be the heroes, at which point they said, "Can you delay it a week? We've got to clean up our website."

So, I'm hoping those websites will be all cleaned up and easy to access because they are a 'treasure chest', and they did such a fabulous job.

Farrell: I have to agree, they did.

Fitts: And they had to deal with so much sabotage.

The *Take Action* crowdfund continues to grow, and we continue to send money to different groups, particularly people who are going into courts and litigating. That is very much appreciated.

I want to raise more money for CHD (Children's Health Defense) Europe, which I am involved with, because they are doing a great service to help some of the lawyers and lawsuits in Europe. What a difference those lawsuits make.

We end with a cartoon I've used many times. I love it. It's from Bob Moran. Jeremy Nell now does our cartoons, and we have them throughout the web presentation, but here is the one I love. The child says, "What happens in the end?" and the dad responds, "We win."

The one thing we haven't talked about, which I want to talk about before we close is you saying, "The pandemic was a prototype, and it was wildly successful. They got the lessons learned. They are working on incorporating them." If you look at all the plans they are wanting to do, whether it's biodefense, bioweapons, pandemics, or war, I don't know what the next wave will be. It's like a war where there is a wave, then you take a break, then there is another wave, and then you take another break, and on and on, but they are working on multiple waves.

There is the UFO false flag. They are working on multiple waves. I have no idea what the next one will be, but if you look at the time and money that is going

into the bioweapon and biodefense game or the WHO and the pandemic, another wave is coming. There is no doubt about it. The questions are: When? And how do we make sure that we are fine despite that wave?

Farrell: It depends, of course, on what the wave is. My guess is that they are going to try another COVID-like plan/ 'scamdemic'.

Fitts: They have been trying to interest investors to building vaccine manufacturing capability worldwide and promising them huge returns. That is my understanding.

I call it 'Putin 19' or maybe 'Putin 24' because they are telling people that these vaccines will protect you against bioweapons. I think they are going to blame it on the Russians. If they said, "Take a COVID 23 vaccine," everybody will say no. How do they scare you into taking the vaccine? They can call it a bioweapon, and Putin 24 is how they do it. "It's a Russian bioweapon, and we are protecting you from the Russian bioweapon."

Farrell: I agree. I think something like that is 'in the cards'. That also allows them to accomplish another major objective, and that is to escalate the situation with Russia. I get the impression they are going to try to do that.

My answer is that we have to do exactly what we did with COVID and just say no.

You told the story about SARS where they were threatening people with mass injections back then. We will have to make it very clear that this is not only a, "No," but it's a, "No, over my dead body."

Fitts: I think that is why they are trying so hard to 'pull in the guns'.

Farrell: Absolutely, and the thing that is interesting now is I think that more and more people are finally waking up to the fact that all of this is about getting the guns. The school shootings are all about getting the guns. I think the problem is that this is a card that they've played so many times. Every time they play it now, people go out and buy more and more guns. So, it is creating the exact opposite problem.

The problem is you have a certain segment of this society that agrees with President 'Bai-den Dzho' (as I like to call him), which is that if you are going to go against the US government, you'd better have some F-16's.

The problem with that view, Mr. President (or 'Mr. Alleged President, as I like to say) is that you cannot control any territory without boots on the ground, and boots on the ground means boots on the ground. In plain and simple terms, that means infantry. It's not tanks and artillery, but good, old-fashioned infantry. This is the problem.

Admiral Yamamoto, during or prior to World War II, made the statement to the effect that no one is going to be stupid enough to invade the United States because there is a rifle behind every blade of grass. That is the problem.

The only thing that mitigates against that is we have become so pacified and afraid to fight. But the other thing about that part of the story is that under Obama, you had those two incidents with the ranchers in Nevada, and then in Oregon, where the government tried to tell them what to do. The ranchers met them with their guns, and the local Indians showed up with their guns, and then the sheriffs showed up with their guns. It was over before it began.

I hate to talk in those terms, but we must understand this is where we're at.

Fitts: If somebody is trying to kill you, you have the right to self-defense.

Farrell: And they are trying to kill us; that is the 'bottom line'. I've told people over and over again there is only one language that these people really understand.

Fitts: I wrote an article called, *The 2nd Amendment and the 2024 Presidential Election*. I wrote it for Bobby Kennedy because I wanted him to read it and understand people in the rural areas.

Farrell: It's a non-starter; you cannot rely on police to protect you.

Fitts: My sheriff is 20-45 minutes away.

Farrell: You're not going to call 911 and get the police there in time to protect you from a criminal.

Fitts: You're not going to have time to call.

Farrell: Precisely. Like it or not, the 2nd Amendment is there to protect us, also from the government.

Fitts: I'll ask you to estimate what you think the percentage is that those school shootings are being done by the government? Do you think it's 100%? 99%?

Farrell: I would give it at least 95%. The reason is that the pattern is always the same. Certain political parties immediately jump on the bandwagon, "Oh, we've got to have gun laws and regulations," and if it weren't always the same sort of 'troubled young boys' on SSRI drugs, which the government, in turn, has prescribed for many problems that they have created, then I would say that the chances are very low. But it's the same pattern again, over and over again.

I don't believe this government on anything they have said since the Philadelphia convention of 1787. I am that much of an anti-Federalist. We were told back then that this was a coup d'état, and that is what it's been. John Kennedy's assassination proved it, as far as I'm concerned. So I don't believe them.

Fitts: I must tell you that I am unbelievably shocked at the people who fell for the vaccine story and trusted the government.

Farrell: I'm not. I'm willing to wager that the only reason the people who bought into the narrative bought into it was that Trump gave his backing to it. I think that had it been any other person in office at that time, it would not have gone over the way it did. He had a certain amount of trust built up amongst the center and political right in this country that otherwise would not have existed if he had not been there. They 'played him' like Nero played his fiddle.

Fitts: But he had to know how dangerous these were. Anyone who knew

anything, knows that it takes 12 years to safety trial a vaccination. As Kennedy has pointed out, they were not real safety trials because they never did them the way they did every other pharmaceutical.

Farrell: I'm not letting him 'off the hook'; I'm totally in agreement with you.

Fitts: You're right about that. I had not thought about that, but I think that many people were persuaded to do it because of Trump.

Farrell: He had established a type of magnetism with a certain part of the electorate with his decisions on human trafficking and the Supreme Court and so on. So, he had a certain momentum. Then he did the business with China and North Korea, so that gave him a bit more.

Fitts: Don't forget that he dropped out of the WHO and the Paris Agreement.

Farrell: He dropped out of the WHO. Then along came the plan/ 'scamdemic', and he jumped out ahead of it and looked like he was handling this one, too. But yet, when you get into the particulars of how he handled it, he caved to Fauci and Birx and everything. Then I go back to something else: When Trump came out and bragged about having reduced the cost of prescription drugs, at that time, everyone was asking him, "How did you get them to do that?" and he would never say what the quid pro quo was.

I think the plan/ 'scamdemic' and the 'quackcines' were it; I think that was the quid pro quo.

As far as I'm concerned, no, I'm not voting for this man again. No way.

Fitts: That absolutely could be. I cannot explain his popularity.

Farrell: I can't either. We may be looking at yet another media-manufactured narrative here with Trump and his polls.

Fitts: I hope that because of Kennedy and some of the Republicans who have jumped in, we are going to start a real conversation, and they can bring a lot of transparency.

Farrell: I hope so, too.

Fitts: I think that transparency can change everything; it's all about transparency. Anything that you can do to contribute to the transparency is good.

I would love for transparency to happen in general, but the campaign is when people pay attention, and that is when they talk about these issues.

There is one more thing that I want to do before we close, but before we do that, looking at the 3rd Quarter and the rest of the year, talk to us: What should we keep our eyes on? If we are going to keep our 'eye on the ball' on the skyline and the Scud missiles coming in, what should we watch for

Farrell: Obviously, I think people need to keep an eye on the business between Russia and Ukraine, and particularly on things that may look like unusual deaths or sudden deaths of Western leaders. In other words, I think we have to start thinking in terms of Russia 'taking the gloves off' regarding covert activity. This will be known to the intelligence services of the West, but not necessarily by the public.

Fitts: We recently saw a member of the JPMorgan Chase board die in a car crash. And there was another death at JPMorgan Chase.

Farrell: I would not be at all surprised to see some of this happening. So look for patterns in that.

I tend to think we are going to see increasing bilateral currency deals, not necessarily to create a reserve currency replacement for the dollar, but as regional alternatives to it. I think that will be happening.

Fitts: Everyone wants resiliency away from the dollar – whatever they can do.

Farrell: I think that is going to increase. This business of the governor of Okinawa prefecture in Japan just fascinates the 'daylights' out of me.

Fitts: It's a bit like Sequoia splitting up into three parts. You have to decentralize to decentralize. People are decentralizing because they need to get the work done and be productive.

Farrell: I think that is going to increase.

Domestically, I think the chances are very good that you are going to see some changes of government, maybe not in the next quarter. But certainly the processes to change the governments in Germany and France are going to accelerate in this next quarter. In this country, I think they are trying to pressure Joe Biden to drop out. I think that all this business with Hunter Biden and the constant little escalations each and every day on that story are part of trying to pressure him to withdraw.

I have terrible misgivings that they are going to allow him to run. The problem they have in doing that, on the Democratic part of the equation, is they don't have anybody else of sufficient stature that can stop Bobby Kennedy, Jr. I don't see Gavin Newsome as standing a chance.

Fitts: No, he doesn't stand a chance.

Farrell: Not against Bobby.

Fitts: I think that it's a long time between now and November 24th, and plenty of things can happen. One of the things that most struck me in this quarter was when Obama gave an interview. I forget if it was with CBS or who it was with, but he looked scared.

He was talking about Ukraine and Russia, and he looked scared because their strategy has failed. The Ukrainian offense is a joke, and it has failed.

From watching Obama, they don't know how to get out of this.

Farrell: They don't; they are confronted with so many different problems now because of this. Anybody with 'half a brain' would have realized from the get-go that the West's narrative about Ukraine 'doing well' or even possibly being able to win this war was absolute nonsense. There is no way that that is going to

happen.

With Russia, you are dealing with the world's premier nuclear power.

Fitts: And I would like to point out that they are the world's premier satellite power.

We're going to talk about car accidents. Remember, Putin's driver (when Putin was not in the car) had a very serious accident. Was he killed?

Farrell: Yes, he was.

Fitts: If they take the 'gloves off', their satellite power can cause car accidents and flight accidents.

Farrell: You're not dealing with a 3rd world country here.

Fitts: We're not dealing with 'men in sandals'. For many, many years, all of our defeats have been 'men in sandals' and now we are talking about being defeated by someone else.

Farrell: Now we are talking about the real thing. This is a narrative that any way you 'slice it', you have the Biden family involvement in Ukraine and very obviously – from my point of view – indictable criminality. You have the whole GMO issue in Ukraine. You have the human trafficking, the biolabs, and the narrative they've created in the media that Ukraine is actually doing well.

Ukraine has never done well in this whole thing, and it has been used as a 'cat's paw' (and this is going to come back to bite the West and particularly the Anglosphere) by Washington and London to accomplish their objectives.

Fitts: I think they have great plans in Ukraine, and I think they've been intentionally clearing the people out.

Farrell: I totally agree with you there, too, but I'm not saying that the other is exclusive of this. That has always been the other objective.

If they aren't able to accomplish their objective with Russia, this has been a fallback objective. Clear out the Ukrainians, then they go in and literally take over the country themselves. I suspect another group behind this as well.

Zelensky is the symbol of what is going on.

Fitts: Yes because he will go along with anything. When you go along with anything, this is what you get.

Farrell: They are scared, and I did not see the Obama interview, but my point is they are scared because this whole thing could 'blow up in their faces' and end up exposing them.

Fitts: There is the child trafficking as well.

Farrell: If I'm not mistaken Obama's interview appeared after Professor Sergey Radchenko's article in *Russia Today* where he is talking about the nuclear escalation.

If he is scared, it is because he is intelligent enough to know that he is on the list. They are 'scared to death'.

Fitts: He looked scared and shaky.

Farrell: I would be, too, if I suspected there are Russian Spetsnaz teams after me; I would definitely be scared.

You don't want to go to bed at night thinking, "I could be on the Spetsnaz target list for tomorrow." That's not something you want to do.

Fitts: In closing, I want to bring something up because I am in the Philadelphia area. On the 4^t, we are going to the Liberty Bell area. In the United States, we are going into the July 4th weekend, which is a big weekend for many people because they have two days, then they have Monday off, and Tuesday is July 4th.

I wanted to remind everybody, particularly the subscribers who are in Asia and

Europe, that I would read the opening line from the Preamble to the Declaration of Independence:

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.

Farrell: The part of the Declaration of Independence that I always prefer, even to the Preamble, is from the long chain of abuses.

Fitts: I know it and love it well.

When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

Then it goes into 'We hold these truths to be self-evident..."

And it continues:

But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.

There you go!
